OVERVIEW

Step aboard WADDLE WE DO, a distinctive Horizon FD90 that blends forward-thinking design, artisanal finishes, and an extensive list of owner-specified enhancements. From the first moment, it's evident this luxury motor yacht was shaped for sophisticated living and effortless hosting, delivering the refinement of a custom build with the versatility of a modern superyacht.

The generous aft deck sets the tone with an inviting open-air dining area for up to six around a bespoke table. To port, a complete outdoor bar holds court with a dropdown TV above for game days or movie nights. Just aft, an oversized sunpad with deep storage invites lounging between swims or while tied up in port. Discreet overhead lighting and an upgraded audio package create a relaxed, polished mood ideal for evenings at anchor. Wide walkaround decks, shielded by optional wind doors, provide smooth passage forward and up to the flybridge and skylounge.

Inside, the expansive main salon is framed by full-height windows that bathe the space in natural light. Custom loose furnishings, a tailored bar, and a formal dining area aft evoke the ambiance of a chic coastal residence. Forward, the open galley has been reimagined as a country-style kitchen, with premium appliances, an extended walk-in pantry, additional refrigeration, and a casual dining nook plus a dedicated office area—perfect for long-range cruising, liveaboard comfort, or charter use.

Below, a versatile guest arrangement delivers flexibility for family and friends. Two mirrored VIP suites forward offer equal comfort and privacy, while the full-beam owner's suite on the lower deck serves as a serene retreat. Expect personalized cabinetry, dual walk-in closets, an oversized bath with rain shower, elevated stone surfaces, and upgraded AV—five-star details that elevate every night at sea. A thoughtfully placed walk-in laundry with extra

storage complements the accommodations and streamlines life aboard.

Aft, the crew quarters are refined for privacy, service flow, and efficiency, accommodating up to four in two cabins with a shared head. A proper crew mess and an additional storage/laundry room keep operations smooth, while enhanced insulation and a service-minded layout quiet the ride and improve discretion. Just beyond, the fixed swim platform and spacious gear garage are ready for dive equipment, bikes, Seabobs, e-foils, and all the toys needed for on-the-water adventures.

Above, the enclosed skylounge—extended an additional three feet during build—has been transformed into a multifunctional living space. Custom lounge seating, a dedicated entertainment hub, and a dayhead make this an all-weather haven that elegantly blurs leisure and utility. Aft on the bridge deck, customization continues with tender and jetski storage paired with a social zone: a custom L-shaped settee with adjustable table, a full wet bar, icemaker, and a premium BBQ—tailor-made for al fresco meals and golden-hour cocktails.

Forward, the bow becomes a resort-style escape. A large sunpad with adjustable backrests and an intimate seating area with a cocktail table invite relaxation and conversation. To starboard, a five-person jacuzzi is purposefully positioned to provide added privacy whether at anchor or in the marina. Custom shade solutions and upgraded outdoor upholstery ensure durability and comfort in any climate.

Every inch of WADDLE WE DO showcases an elevated attention to detail—from hand-selected materials to the carefully orchestrated flow of each space and the technical ease of service behind the scenes. For those seeking a Horizon FD90 that lives like a bespoke home on the water, this skylounge motor yacht—equal parts flybridge yacht, superyacht, and bluewater cruiser—delivers on every count.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Interior

The interior is designed for easy living and welcoming entertaining. In the main salon and dining area, panoramic glass sliding doors open to the aft deck and use an inflatable seal system to keep water out and reduce sound, while floor to ceiling windows and wall to wall plush carpet set a calm, refined tone. An oversized L shaped sofa pairs with a coffee table and a matching loveseat, and a media center anchors the space with a sixty five inch Samsung TV, a Bose Lifestyle entertainment system, and Apple TV. A convenient day head serves guests, a formal dining table comfortably seats up to six, and a custom liquor cabinet keeps favorite bottles secure underway.

Forward, the galley becomes a relaxed country kitchen with a hi low privacy screen overlooking the dining room, quartz countertops, and a built in dinette for casual meals. A working desk set beside a large view window creates a bright workstation, while a skylight with motorized blinds adds natural light on demand. A custom walk in pantry with additional freezer drawers supports long passages and effortless provisioning.

Up in the bridge skylounge, an L shaped settee with a hi low table makes a flexible lounge and dining space opposite a media center with a forty three inch Samsung TV. Fresh air and sky pour in through a sliding glass skylight, and a second day head keeps this level self sufficient. The helm station features two captain's chairs for comfortable passages, and panoramic glass sliding doors aft—again with an inflatable seal system—lead to the bridge deck while keeping water and noise at bay.

Guest accommodations are quiet and restorative. The full beam owner's suite offers a double door entry, a king size bed, and a media center with a fifty inch Samsung TV, a Bose sound bar, and Apple TV. Storage is abundant

with two oversized walk-in closets, and the en suite features a dual vanity layout and a large walk-in shower. In the guest hallway, an additional walk-in laundry room provides easy access for all cabins. Two VIP staterooms mirror one another, each with a queen size bed, its own en suite bathroom with shower, independent air conditioning zones, and a media center with a Samsung TV and a Fusion speaker system.

Propulsion & steering

Power comes from two CAT C18 ACERT engines rated at 1,136 horsepower each, managed through Glendinning EEC3 engine controls for smooth response. Precision low speed handling is effortless with an ABT bow thruster rated at fifty-five horsepower and an ABT stern thruster rated at forty-five horsepower. Long range comfort is ensured by ABT TRAC digital stabilizers with Zero Speed capability for stability both underway and at anchor. Fuel is carried in two aluminum main tanks of 1,330 gallons each, supplemented by three FRP fuel tanks of 820 gallons apiece. Steering is by Teleflex SeaStar gear, with a Garmin GHP Smart Autopilot Pump V2 assisting confident course-keeping. A custom port wing helm station at the bridge deck level provides full controls for close-quarters maneuvering.

Communication & navigation equipment

Navigation and situational awareness are comprehensive, beginning with a digital monitoring system built around three Sybology MBB300C units. The helm presents four Garmin GPSMAP multifunction displays with Garmin GRID 20 control, backed by a Garmin GMR radar and a Garmin Reactor 40 Hydraulic Corepack autopilot with Smart Pump. Position is provided by two Garmin GPS 19x NMEA 2000 receivers. Speed, temperature, and wind are tracked by a Garmin gWind transducer and an Airman UST850 ultrasonic smart transducer,

while depth readings come from a Garmin GSD 25 paired with an Airman M265LH. Weather updates arrive via a Garmin GXM53 XM receiver. Communications include two Garmin VHF 215 sets with two fist mic relocation kits and two Shakespeare Galaxy 5225 XT eight foot antennas. A Ritchie Supersport SS 1002 compass, an AXIS P3905 R MK II CCD camera, and a FLIR MD 625 NTSC 30 Hz night vision unit round out the package.

Safety & fire protection

Safety systems include a Delta T fire and ventilation solution, a Maretron fire detection system, and an engine room Seafire H Series fire extinguishing installation. A Fire Boy control and detection system adds redundancy, and an eight person life raft provides emergency capacity.

Electrical equipment

Electrical power is robust and yacht ready, with two Onan generators rated at 29 kW, 120/240 VAC, sixty hertz, single phase. Shore connections are handled by two Glendinning Cablemaster systems, a CM 8 2/4 at 100 A and twenty four volts, and a CM 7 2/4 at fifty amps. A full exterior light package enhances visibility and ambiance, while Underwater Light UL TI Matte 80 LED fixtures illuminate the sea below.

Mechanical equipment

Climate control is reliable and quiet, centered on a Marine Air MCGX216 PLC air compressor and three Dometic chilled water MarineAir units. The fresh water system is equally thorough, with Headhunter M5 230V/60Hz AC and X Caliber twenty four volt DC pressure pumps feeding a Headhunter WX 200 PS pressure tank. Water autonomy is supported by a Dometic

SeaXchange and Spot Zero XZ 1800/2000Z water maker combination, while hot water comes from a Torrid MV 30/220V heater and circulates via a GroundFOS Comfort 15 14 B PM pump rated for fifty/sixty hertz at 230 volts. Shoreside water connects through a Jabsco PAR 44411 1045 short water inlet. Bilge and deck wash systems are designed for cleanliness and safety. A CEM LBR 2 24 wash system, plumbed throughout the boat and including anchor rode sprayers, serves the decks and swim platform using twenty liters per cycle at twenty four volts DC. Five high level alarms monitor the bilges, with manual pumps—BOSWORTH at fifteen gallons per minute and JABSCO at twenty two gallons per minute—backed by an electric Rule 16A pump delivering 3,700 gallons per hour at twenty four volts.

Waste handling is straightforward and compliant, with an FRP holding tank of two hundred gallons and an FRP sump tank of one hundred gallons. Greywater moves via a Rule 16A 3700 pump and FRP box, and levels are tracked by Maretron and Headhunter indicators. Treatment is managed by a Headhunter TW HMX 6001LP (one phase/sixty hertz) system, while a Headhunter Tortuga 115V/230V/60Hz pump serves the holding tank. In the engine room, stainless overhead storage and sturdy work benches keep tools and spares organized.

Exterior

Outdoors, the aft deck is finished in teak and features a transom sunbed with abundant storage, a hi low dining table seating six, a drop down Samsung TV, a Fusion speaker system, and a full wet/service bar. Wind doors on both port and starboard add protection, and a custom MarQuipt boarding ladder stows neatly in its own concealed locker.

The bridge deck aft continues the teak theme with a full service wet bar, an L shaped settee complemented by added barstools, and two sun loungers beneath custom removable sunshade sails. Cooking is handled by an Aritex twenty four inch propane BBQ station. Tender handling is simplified by a

davit rated to 1,500 pounds, and the area is wired with a Fusion speaker system for effortless entertaining.

Forward on the foredeck, teak underfoot leads to an Ottawa 38 Jet five person spa jacuzzi supported by a dedicated 350 gallon spa water storage tank and pump. An L shaped settee, custom removable sunshade sails, and an oversized sun pad with adjustable backrests create a true lounge, while hot and cold water showers and a Fusion speaker system complete the experience. All exterior doors are fitted with custom made bug screens.

At the waterline, the garage and swim platform area features teak decking and an expanded platform for easy water access. A hydraulic storage garage swallows water toys, there is direct access to the crew quarters, and a custom Besenzoni retractable rotating passerelle streamlines boarding. On deck, ground tackle is robust with two Maxwell VWC 3500 windlasses, two Maxwell AA560 chain counters, and two Maxwell VC 2500 twenty four volt rope capstans.

Galley & laundry equipment

The galley and pantry are equipped for serious cooking and easy service, with a KitchenAid KBSD618ESS refrigerator paired to a Pellick C Series HC24RB33L refrigerator and a DW 180I0XN4 EF freezer. Cleanup is handled by a Miele G 6875 SCVISF dishwasher, while cooking essentials include an LG Studio LSCG307ST cooktop, a Miele H6281 BP oven, and a Bosch HDD80050UC downdraft range hood. Waste management is tidy with a KitchenAid KTTS505ESS trash compactor and an Insinkerator Contractor 333 disposal, and mornings start right with a built in Miele CVA6405SS coffee machine.

In the crew mess, laundry is managed by a Miele WWB020 WCS W1 washer and TWB120WP T1 dryer. A Bosch B11CB50SSS refrigerator, a Kenyon B41711 cooktop, and a Bosch HMVP053U microwave keep the team fueled.

Additional equipment includes a U Line ULN CO29W 03A refrigerator on the boat deck, an Aritex twenty four inch BBQ on the bridge deck aft, a Vitrifrigo C130RXD4 F1 refrigerator on the aft deck, and a Raritan 87B 515 1 S/S ice maker on the aft deck.

Overview

Welcome aboard WADDLE WE DO, a Horizon FD90 that blends an inventive layout, fine craftsmanship, and extensive owner driven customization to make life on the water feel natural and enjoyable. From the aft deck's open air dining and relaxed sun lounging to the bright salon and country style kitchen forward, the yacht is tailored for luxurious living and easy entertaining. Wide side decks with wind doors connect seamlessly to the flybridge and enclosed skylounge, where an aft extension of three feet creates a multifunctional retreat with custom lounge seating, an entertainment zone, a day head, and direct access to a social bridge deck anchored by a full wet bar, ice maker, and high end BBQ. Forward, the bow becomes a resort like hideaway with a large sun pad and adjustable backrests, an intimate seating area, and a five person jacuzzi set to starboard for privacy in marinas and at anchor. Everywhere you look, materials are hand selected and the flow between spaces is carefully considered for comfort, service, and long range cruising.

This is the only Horizon FD90 built with an oversized forward country kitchen and a true walk in pantry designed for extended passages. The guest layout is refreshingly practical, with a unique three stateroom arrangement featuring two mirrored Queen VIPs and a full beam owner's suite with double door entry, two walk in closets, a dual vanity en suite, and an oversized rain shower. Day heads are positioned on both the main deck and the skylounge level. Storage has been thoughtfully added on every deck for owner and crew efficiency, and the transom garage is large enough for bikes, dive gear, and water toys. Ride quality and comfort benefit from upgraded ABT TRAC 20x

Zero Speed stabilization fins, while a Headhunter waste treatment system and a Dometic water maker with Spot Zero combo unit simplify life on long cruises. Two walk-in laundry rooms—one in the guest area and one for the crew—keep turnarounds quick and quiet.

Recent care underlines its turn-key status: CAT engine and generator servicing was completed in August 2025; the entire Racor system was disassembled and cleaned in August 2025; a full bottom job with two coats of antifouling and PropSpeed on all running gear was completed in April 2025; and all hydraulic hoses for the passerelle were replaced in July 2025. For owners seeking a refined skylounge motor yacht that straddles the categories of flybridge yacht, superyacht, bluewater cruiser, and charter-ready family yacht, WADDLE WE DO offers an inviting, capable platform that makes it easy to say yes to the next voyage.

Audiovisual

Connectivity is future-proofed with a Starlink antenna neatly concealed within the dome, keeping high-speed internet unobtrusive and always ready.
