OVERVIEW

The 2020 Riva Argo Kiyomizu is a captivating synthesis of heritage, power, and design finesse. With assertive exterior lines, sun-washed interiors, and a versatile arrangement, she is equally at home on an intimate getaway or a chic gathering at sea. Created by one of the most venerated names in luxury yachting, Kiyomizu stands as a living tribute to the enduring Riva lineage—built not merely to cruise, but to be unforgettable.

From any viewpoint, Kiyomizu radiates presence. Her sleek, low-slung profile is highlighted by a luminous white hull offset with bold black detailing, an expression of Riva's audacious yet impeccably refined design language. Flowing contours, sweeping glass, and a sculpted superstructure achieve a poised equilibrium between athletic intent and classic elegance worthy of a performance motor yacht.

Step indoors and the space is immediately awash with natural light. The salon is framed by full-height glazing that dissolves the threshold between interior and ocean, yielding an airy, open ambience that shifts with the day's changing light. The arrangement is tailored for repose and socializing alike, with a generous lounge aft, a formal dining area amidships, and seamless flow to the aft deck through sliding glass doors—an ideal stage for a luxury motor yacht designed for stylish entertaining.

Exceptional for her class, Kiyomizu presents a full-beam owner's suite on the main deck with sweeping views, a private en-suite featuring a walk-in shower, and a dedicated walk-in wardrobe. Below, the guest domain is thoughtfully composed with a full-beam VIP suite with a double bed and en-suite, a forward VIP with a double bed and en-suite, and a portside twin that converts to a double—perfect for family or additional guests—delivering the versatility expected of a modern planing motor yacht.

All guest cabins enjoy en-suite bathrooms and share the same elevated

finishes, serene palette, and generous headroom found throughout, underscoring the yacht's quiet luxury and sophisticated craftsmanship. Powered by twin MTU 12V 2000 M96L engines, KİYOMIZU glides effortlessly at a 21-knot cruise and can reach up to 26 knots. Stabilizers enhance comfort both underway and at anchor, while her planing hull provides the reactivity and poise for which Riva is renowned. Whether you are island-hopping or stretching out for longer passages, she delivers exhilarating performance without sacrificing composure—hallmarks of a refined performance cruiser. KİYOMIZU has been kept in impeccable condition and thoughtfully upgraded by a meticulous owner and captain, offering a turnkey experience that embodies the elegance, innovation, and seakeeping that define a true Riva.

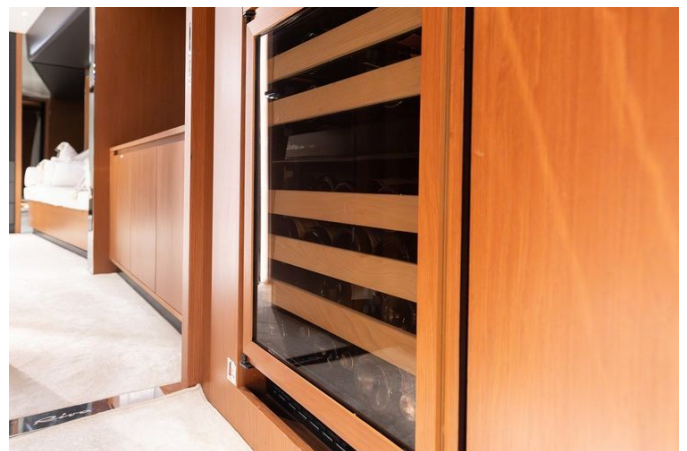

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Key features

Engineered for absolute poise at sea, this yacht marries zero-speed fin stabilizers with two Seakeeper gyros, enhanced by soundproofing in the fin area for whisper-quiet comfort. Long-range independence comes courtesy of the Seafary Versatile watermaker, while a premium interior and exterior sound system, underwater lights, and KVH SAT TV throughout elevate every moment on board. Precision maneuvering is assured with bow and stern thrusters and a starboard aft helm station, all complemented by a US premium accessory package. Entertaining is effortless with a high/low dining table on the aft deck accompanied by two sofas and an additional high/low dining table on the bow, with manual awnings on carbon fiber poles providing adaptable shade throughout. A premium A/V control package serves the salon and master cabin, electric black-out blinds outfit the cabins excluding the crew area and bathrooms, and electric curtains grace the main deck and lower deck, excluding black-out blinds, the bridge, galley, hallway, crew area, and bathrooms. Rounding out the experience, a Williams jet tender expands on-water fun, and a dedicated wine cellar keeps your favorite vintages at the ready.

Short description

The 2020 Riva Argo KIYOMIZU is a striking fusion of heritage, performance, and design sophistication, her bold exterior styling, sun-soaked interiors, and dynamic layout making her equally suited to intimate cruising or stylish entertaining. Built by one of the most respected names in yachting, she stands as a testament to the enduring legacy of Riva, crafted not merely to cruise, but to be remembered. From every angle KIYOMIZU exudes presence, her sleek,

low-profile silhouette highlighted by a gleaming white hull with bold black accents—flowing lines, expansive glazing, and a sculpted superstructure striking a perfect balance between sporty aggression and classic elegance. Step inside and you are immediately immersed in natural light: the salon is framed by full-height glass that dissolves the boundary between interior and sea, creating an airy, open ambiance that evolves with every hour, while a spacious lounge aft and a formal dining area amidships connect seamlessly to the aft deck through sliding glass doors. Rare for her size, KIYOMIZU offers a full-beam master suite on the main deck with panoramic views, a private en-suite with walk-in shower, and a walk-in wardrobe; below deck, guest accommodations comprise a full-beam VIP suite with a full-sized bed and en-suite, a forward VIP stateroom with a full-sized bed en-suite, and a twin cabin to port that converts to a full, ideal for guests or children. All guest cabins feature en-suite bathrooms and share the same refined styling and generous headroom found throughout the yacht. Powered by twin MTU 12V 2000 M96L engines, she cruises effortlessly at 21 knots and reaches up to 26 knots, with stabilizers ensuring comfort both at anchor and underway, while her planing hull delivers the agility and responsiveness for which Riva is renowned; whether island-hopping or covering longer distances, she offers exhilarating performance without compromising on comfort. KIYOMIZU has been maintained impeccably and upgraded by a diligent owner and captain.

Upgrades

This yacht has been thoughtfully enhanced with a Starlink Maritime plus Starlink RV system for seamless connectivity at sea, complemented by a Creston control system that orchestrates audio and video across multiple zones with integrated control of lightning and climate. Security and situational awareness are elevated by a Ghost Security System, an enterprise grade Wi-Fi network, and real-time view cameras with 24/7 recording, while a Weather

Station installation and a battery backup to the entire system add confidence and resilience to every voyage. Comfort and convenience are refined through a custom stainless steel sofa frame bolted into the deck with top of the line upholstery, a coffee and tea station set up for effortless hospitality, and a wheelhouse power sockets installment for practical utility. Navigation and helm technology benefit from a SIMRAD screens upgrade from EVO3 to EVO3S, and the flybridge is superbly provisioned with a stainless steel Scotsman icemaker and three stainless steel Isotherm fridges. For alfresco dining, custom made privacy and wind/sun shades cocoon the aft dining area, and an additional wine cellar near the helm station keeps favorite vintages within easy reach. Adventurers will appreciate a dive compressor and four tanks installment in the garage, ensuring readiness for underwater exploration at a moment's notice.

Recent services

A meticulous program of upgrades and maintenance underscores this yacht's turn-key readiness. On September 9, 2024, the shore power converters were serviced, followed on September 10 by service to the Miele washer and dryer. On September 11, fresh bottom paint was applied and Prospeed was laid on the running gear. The stabilizer heat exchanger was rebuilt on September 16, while the stabilizer fins were serviced on September 17, the same day a ceramic coating was applied across exterior surfaces.

October 1, 2024 brought generator service at 350 hours alongside a comprehensive watermaker service, and on October 15 the air-conditioning units were professionally split between the engine room and control room to optimize climate management. The watermaker block was replaced on November 6, 2024.

The Williams tender received full service on January 27, 2025, and the Sea Keeper was serviced on January 29. An engine battery charger replacement

was completed on February 3, 2025, followed by another generator service on March 27, 2025.

Illumination and ventilation enhancements continued into spring, with main deck step lights replaced on April 3, 2025, and the galley extraction fan replaced on April 23. Bottom paint touch-ups and new zincs were completed on June 5, 2025. On June 14, the A/C chillers' pipe insulation was renewed and ventilation and drain hoses were replaced. The yacht's main engines received their 1,000-hour service on June 23, 2025. On June 24, both the swim platform and stern passarelle were serviced and the A/C chillers were descaled, and by June 25 the full teak package had been refinished.

Reliability was further elevated on July 25, 2025, with the starboard generator heat exchanger replaced, the fuel tank professionally cleaned, and fuel level sensors inspected and cleaned. The same day, through-hull valves were replaced on the generators, hydraulic systems, watermaker, and AC units, completing a thorough cycle of preventative service designed to inspire absolute confidence at sea.

Full beam master cabin on deck

Commanding the main deck, the full-beam master cabin is conceived as a serene private suite, centered around a full bed complete with mattress, pillows, bedspread, and pillow covers, set within a storage bed featuring a bed lifting system and complemented by drawers beneath. The bed frame is finished in sole leather upholstery with polished stainless steel details, paired with a sole leather headboard and flanked by two lacquered nightstands with doors in sole leather and elegant glass tops. Underfoot, a carpeted floor with padding ensures hushed comfort, while cushions measuring 40 x 40 cm add tactile refinement. Ambient illumination is achieved through LED spotlights and an LED panel, beautifully offset by a lacquered ceiling, and supported by two focused reading lights for evening repose. Entertainment and connectivity

are assured with a Hi-Fi system and a 48-inch LED TV with an upgraded audio and video system, while an electric outlet is conveniently positioned for daily ease. Practical luxuries abound, including lacquered storage furniture on the forward starboard side with doors and drawers covered in leather, an additional storage unit with a door clad in leather, wooden bulkheads with a mirror area, and a wardrobe fitted with a mirror. A porthole housing with curtain and blackout curtain ensures privacy and light control, and thoughtful appointments such as a safe, a vanity unit with a lacquered top and a leather jewel case inside, and a custom vanity chair in the master cabin complete the space with sophistication and purpose.

Master bathroom

The master bathroom is meticulously appointed with refined bathroom accessories, including a toilet brush holder, a soap dispenser, a glass holder, and bathrobe hangers, all set against lacquered bulkheads and a lacquered ceiling that elevate the space. Practicality and comfort are ensured by an electric ceramic toilet and bidet, a black water tank level indicator integrated into the toilet control panel, an electric exhaust fan, and an electric outlet. Illumination is both functional and atmospheric with LED spotlights and an LED panel, complemented by a mirror and a porthole housing that lend light and depth. The shower unit showcases Corian and lacquered walls, enclosed by a glass door with a stainless steel frame for a crisp, contemporary finish. Thoughtful storage includes a small cabinet with a glossy lacquered door on the shower side, a small cabinet with a mirror door to portside, and a wooden unit beneath the wash basin with open space and a door, bringing order and elegance to every detail.

Full-beam VIP cabin lower deck

Spanning the yacht's beam, the VIP sanctuary on the lower deck features a full bed complete with mattress, pillows, bedspread, and pillow covers, set atop a storage base with a convenient bed lifting system. The bed frame is finished in sole leather upholstery with polished stainless steel details, while a carpeted floor with padding underneath enhances quiet comfort. Two 40 x 40 cm cushions and practical drawers beneath the bed add thoughtful utility. Power is close at hand via an electric outlet, and safety is assured with a discreetly placed fire extinguisher. A lacquered ceiling crowns the space, complemented by two lacquered nightstands with doors in sole leather and elegant glass tops. Opposite, lacquered TV furniture with a stainless steel frame and mirrors anchors the entertainment suite, illuminated by LED spotlights and an LED panel, and served by a 41" LED TV with an upgraded audio and video system and a mini hi-fi CD/DVD with Bluetooth. Natural light filters through a porthole dressed with a curtain and a blackout curtain for privacy and restful sleep, while two focused reading lights provide perfect illumination when desired.

Port cabin lower deck

This refined port-side retreat presents twin beds that effortlessly slide together to form a full bed, complete with mattress, pillows, bedspread, pillow covers, and integrated storage, all set atop drawers beneath the berth. The bed frame is dressed in sole leather upholstery with polished stainless-steel detailing, while a carpeted floor with padding underfoot enhances comfort. Two 40 x 40 cm cushions add a tailored accent, and convenience is assured with an electric outlet and a readily accessible fire extinguisher. A lacquered ceiling crowns the space, complemented by two lacquered nightstands with doors in sole leather and glass tops, and a lacquered TV unit framed in stainless steel with mirrored surfaces. Illumination comes from LED spotlights and an LED panel, supported

by two reading lights for evening ease. Entertainment is elevated by a 41" LED TV paired with an upgraded audio and video system and a mini Hi-Fi CD/DVD and BLUETOOTH unit. Natural light filters through a porthole dressed with both a curtain and a blackout curtain for perfect ambiance control.

Port cabin bathroom

Thoughtfully appointed, the port cabin bathroom features a Corian floor and a Corian sink with mixer tap set above a wooden unit under the wash basin, complemented by a glossy lacquered small cabinet. Sleek lacquered bulkheads and a lacquered ceiling are illuminated by LED spotlights and an LED panel, with a mirror enhancing the sense of space. Convenience and comfort are assured by an electric ceramic toilet and bidet, an electric outlet, and an electric exhaust fan. The shower unit echoes the refined finishes with lacquered walls and ceiling, enclosed by a glass door with a stainless steel frame, while a black water tank level indicator is integrated into the toilet control panel for effortless monitoring.

Forward VIP cabin lower deck

The forward VIP cabin on the lower deck is conceived as a serene retreat, featuring a full bed convertible to twins with mattress, pillows, bedspread, pillow covers, and a storage bed with a bed lifting system, complemented by a double bed with matching mattress, pillows, bedspread, and pillow covers. The bed frame is upholstered in sole leather with polished stainless steel details, and practical elegance continues with drawers under the bed, an electric outlet, and a discreet fire extinguisher. Atmosphere is refined by a lacquered ceiling, wooden bulkheads with mirror inserts, and coordinated wooden furniture, while two lacquered nightstands with doors in sole leather and glass tops flank the sleeping area alongside two reading lights. Comfort underfoot is

assured by a carpeted floor with padding underneath, and soft accents include two 40 x 40 cm cushions. Entertainment is elevated by a Samsung 41-inch TV paired with an upgraded audio and video system, plus a mini hi-fi CD/DVD with Bluetooth, all set against thoughtfully layered illumination from LED spotlights and an LED panel. Storage is generous with two wardrobes each fitted with a mirror and courtesy light, and natural light is managed by a porthole housing with curtain and blackout curtain to suit every mood.

Cockpit

The cockpit is appointed with two electrically sliding sofas, each fitted with upholstered cushions and practical drawers, creating a welcoming retreat. At its center, a dining table with an automatic up-and-down system transitions effortlessly between lounging and dining heights, complemented by a removable upholstered cushion for the table and a dedicated table cover for protection. Underfoot, a fiberglass sole laid in teak lends timeless elegance, while an aft guardrail in glass and stainless steel adds a refined, secure perimeter. Access is managed by two stern gates in glass and stainless steel with a manual blocking system, and the ambience is enhanced by integrated LED spotlights. Entertainment comes courtesy of two watertight loudspeakers connected to the stereo in the lounge, while day-to-day practicality is ensured with two stern sofa covers. Safety is thoughtfully addressed with an extinguisher for the garage featuring a fire port accessible from the cockpit.

Flybridge

The flybridge invites with bespoke lounging and refined command. A custom stainless-steel sofa frame is bolted into the deck and finished with top-of-the-line upholstery, paired with a custom free-standing leather sofa and a coffee table, while two custom stools elevate the flybridge bar area. Practical

luxuries abound with an extra outlet, an ice maker, and three refrigerators, complemented by a cabinet with an electrically opening top equipped with a sink, a 24V refrigerator, generous storage, an electric grill, and a table. Underfoot, a fiberglass floor laid in teak extends beneath a varnished fiberglass hardtop, creating an elegant, enduring setting.

At the helm, a second varnished fiberglass control station with an up-down system for the forward display integrates an upholstered steering wheel, full instrumentation, a compass, and alarm lights, protected by a control station cover; the pilot and guest seats are accompanied by matching covers.

Navigation and communication are comprehensive, featuring a Colour LCD Plotter/GPS, an automatic pilot with rudder angle indicator interfaced with the plotter/GPS, and an adjustable searchlight controlled from both the helm station and the upper bridge. A Class D VHF radio telephone with DSC and a separate antenna is supported by two VHF antennas, further complemented by one GPS antenna, a radar antenna, running and anchor lights, LED spotlights, and a horn. Effortless control comes via engine/inverter electronic controls and the E-Steer electro-hydraulic steering system, while a cover for the bar-side cabinet preserves finishes. For entertainment, two watertight loudspeakers connected to the lounge stereo deliver clear sound, and safety is assured with a fire extinguisher.

Helm station

Command and confidence converge at a varnished helm station crowned by a leather-covered steering wheel and complete engine instrumentation, supported by engine/inverter electronic controls, fuel and reverse gear levers, a compass, and comprehensive alarms. Navigation is elevated by a black box integrated system (radar, plotter, GPS, echo-sounder, monitoring) presented on a 16-inch LCD/LED monitor with an AIS system, complemented by an automatic pilot with rudder angle indicator interfaced with the plotter/GPS, a

dedicated rudder angle indicator, and an echo-sounder function. Communication remains crystal clear through a Class D VHF radiotelephone with DSC and a separate antenna, while situational awareness is further enhanced by an acoustic alarm for water in the bilge and a readily accessible fire extinguisher. Precision handling comes effortlessly via the E-Steer electro-hydraulic steering system, an electric bow thruster control panel with joystick, and a trim stabilizers (interceptors) control panel. Thoughtful touches enrich every passage, from a lacquered ceiling washed with LED spotlights to a leather-covered pilot seat with electric controls, an electric outlet for convenient power, and a clock and barometer with hydro-thermometer for at-a-glance environmental insight. Practicality is woven into the layout with an Interactive Digital Manual on iPad and dual routes of movement: staircase access from the main deck with wooden steps featuring stainless steel details and a carpet floor, and a separate wheelhouse staircase access from the main deck with the same wooden steps, stainless steel detailing, and carpeted finish.

Salon

The salon welcomes with an inviting armchair and a plush ottoman set atop a custom wool rug that softens the warmth of the wooden floor. A suite of six 40 x 40 cm cushions adds tailored comfort, while thoughtful amenities such as an electric outlet and a refined Hi-Fi system enhance everyday ease. Overhead, a lacquered ceiling reflects the glow of LED spotlights and an LED panel, focusing attention on lacquered TV furniture detailed with a stainless steel frame and mirrors and a crisp 49-inch LED TV. Light management is effortless with a manual fabric curtain for the main entrance door and matching manual side fabric curtains, and practical storage furniture lines the starboard side to keep the space beautifully uncluttered.

Dining area

The dining area welcomes guests to an elegant eight-seater table set beneath a refined lacquered ceiling, with warm illumination provided by LED spotlights and a complementary LED panel. Along the bow, lacquered storage furniture is accented with sole leather upholstery panels, while plexiglass housings keep cutlery and pottery securely organized yet on display. Practical touches enhance comfort and functionality, from the conveniently placed electric outlet to the manual side fabric curtains that frame the space, all bordered by classic wooden bulkheads for a timeless, sophisticated finish.

Galley

Thoughtfully appointed for culinary creativity and effortless service, the galley features a side-by-side refrigerator/freezer and a 90 cm induction cooktop paired with an oven and an extraction hood, augmented by an additional microwave oven for swift preparation and an extractor hood with direct outboard discharge for efficient ventilation. Work surfaces are refined in Corian, including a seamless Corian worktop, a Corian sink with a mixer tap, and a durable Corian floor, while daily tasks are simplified by a dishwasher and a conveniently placed electric outlet. The ambiance is elevated by a lacquered ceiling, lacquered bulkheads, and lacquered furniture with matching wall units, all illuminated by LED spotlights and complementary LED strips.

Practical circulation is assured with an access door to the portside walkway and a hinged door in fine wood essence from the dining area, as well as a sliding door between the galley and the crew stair. Direct access to the crew area is provided via a staircase with carpeted treads and wooden edging, and onboard safety is enhanced by a readily accessible fire extinguisher.

Crew cabin (port side)

The port-side crew cabin is thoughtfully appointed with bed frame upholstery and a bunk bed providing two berths, each supplied with a mattress, pillow, and bedspread. Underfoot, carpeted flooring adds warmth, while a fabric-upholstered ceiling complements the wooden bulkheads and matching wooden furniture. Practical touches include an electric outlet, a fire extinguisher, LED spotlights, and two reading lights, together with a porthole housing dressed with a curtain for natural light and privacy. Entertainment is at hand with a mini hi-fi with Bluetooth, and stowage is provided by a wardrobe. For safety and peace of mind, an emergency exit is located on the ceiling in the port-side bathroom, and linens are complete with two sets of sheets and pillowcases.

Crew bathroom (port side)

Thoughtfully appointed for comfort and durability, the port-side crew bathroom pairs practicality with refined finishes. A Corian sink with a mixer tap is set above a wooden unit beneath the wash basin, while a lacquered ceiling, laminated bulkheads, and a floor with teak grating create a resilient marine environment. The electric ceramic toilet/bidet operates via a toilet control panel that also integrates the black-water tank level indicator, and ventilation is ensured by an electric exhaust fan. LED spotlights illuminate a well-placed mirror, everyday convenience is supported by an electric outlet, and a shower with a waterproof curtain completes the space, presented with a set of two towels.

Crew cabin (starboard side)

The starboard crew cabin is thoughtfully appointed with upholstered bed

frames and two bunk beds, each supplied with a mattress, pillow, and bedspread. Soft carpet underfoot and a ceiling upholstered in fabric enhance comfort, while LED spotlights and two dedicated reading lights provide tailored illumination. Practical touches include an electric outlet, a fire extinguisher for safety, a mirror, and a porthole housing with curtain for light and privacy. Entertainment is delivered by a mini hi fi with Bluetooth connectivity, and generous storage comes by way of a wardrobe, complemented by refined wooden bulkheads and matching wooden furniture. Two sets of sheets and pillowcases ensure effortless turnarounds.

Crew bathroom (starboard side)

Thoughtfully appointed for comfort and durability, the starboard crew bathroom features a Corian sink with mixer tap and a Corian wash basin, complemented by an electric ceramic toilet/bidet governed by a black water tank level indicator integrated in the toilet control panel. Ventilation is handled by an electric exhaust fan, while LED spotlights and a mirror create a bright, practical ambiance. Underfoot, a floor with teak grating provides secure footing, and the lacquered ceiling and laminated bulkheads ensure a refined, resilient finish. An electric outlet adds convenient power access, and a shower with a waterproof curtain completes this efficient, well designed space.

Crew dinette / utility area

Designed as a practical retreat for the crew, this dinette and utility area features an I-shaped sofa set against warm wooden bulkheads, with carpeted flooring enhancing comfort underfoot. A sleek cabinet integrates a cooking plate, refrigerator, and sink, complemented by a microwave oven for quick meal preparation. Overhead, a fabric-upholstered ceiling with LED spotlights sets a refined tone, while an electric exhaust fan ensures fresh ventilation.

Daily operations are streamlined by the inclusion of a washing machine and a dryer machine, rounding out a thoughtfully equipped space that elevates efficiency and relaxation at sea.

Engine room

Immaculately organized, the engine room offers direct access to the starboard side walkway and is comprehensively equipped for performance, safety, and ease of service. It features an A/C flushing system; two air intakes with mist separators; an auxiliary electric generator (29kW 120/240V 60Hz) complemented by a main electric generator (29kW 120/240V 60Hz); two change-over valves for emergency water pumping from the bilge; and two color CCTV cameras for constant monitoring. Thoughtful circulation and access are ensured by the door between the engine room and the engine control room, as well as the door connecting the main deck stairway to the engine control room, while a fiberglass stair provides convenient entry. Fuel delivery and filtration are optimized with two double Racor fuel filters for the engines, supported by an electric bilge pump and two electric ventilation fans. Practical details include a fire extinguisher, a fuel tank level indicator, a GRP fuel tank (87001t), LED lighting, and light-alloy anti-skid flooring, together with the main electrical panel and a portable lamp. Acoustic and structural integrity are enhanced by the soundproof, watertight fore bulkhead, and cooling efficiency is safeguarded with two water filters for the engine cooling system and two water filters for the generator cooling system.

Garage

Purpose-built to streamline every waterside moment, the garage features an electric winch for effortless tender lifting and launching, paired with an electro-hydraulic hatch that opens with smooth precision. Durable GRP

flooring with a non-slip surface provides secure footing, while a dedicated dive compressor with four automatic air filling nozzles stands ready for rapid turnaround between adventures. Stowed within is a Williams Jet tender, completing a meticulously organized and highly capable watersports hub.

Propulsion and control

Command comes effortlessly with electro-hydraulic power steering, while precise maneuvering is assured by a fifty-horsepower hydraulic bow thruster. The driveline is engineered for reliability with a stuffing box featuring a low-maintenance dripless shaft seal and a V-Drive transmission that optimizes performance and interior space. Underwater silenced exhausts preserve onboard serenity, ensuring a refined, discreet experience at every speed.

Stabilization systems

The yacht is equipped with two stabilizer fins that provide superior roll control both underway and at zero speed, complemented by trim stabilizers (interceptors) that refine running attitude and efficiency. Further enhancing comfort, two Seakeeper gyroscopic stabilizers dramatically reduce roll whether at anchor or in motion.

Fire extinguishing systems

Safety is fortified by emergency pull handles for engines and generators for diesel break that automatically engage with the fire protection system, an FM200 fire extinguishing system in the engine room with automatic shut down of engines and safety override, and a vigilant smoke detection alarm system, working in concert to provide rapid alerts and decisive response.

Air conditioning systems

Engineered for the world's hottest cruising grounds, the yacht's Supertropical air conditioning system delivers robust, efficient cooling and precise climate control throughout the interior, maintaining serene comfort and whisper-quiet operation even in intense heat and humidity.

Bilge system

Engineered for absolute confidence, the bilge system combines an electric pump dedicated to bilge drainage in the engine room with a suite of four electric pumps that deliver robust, redundant capacity across the vessel. For critical situations, an emergency bilge suction pipe in the engine room operates through the engine cooling pump, providing a direct and reliable means of rapid dewatering. Completing the arrangement, a multipurpose electric pump seamlessly manages bilge, grey water, and black water, streamlining service while maintaining pristine onboard conditions.

Electrical systems

Engineered for unwavering reliability and safety, the yacht's electrical architecture centers on 24V lighting throughout and robust, low-maintenance battery banks. A group of 24V auxiliary service batteries is supported by two automatic battery chargers, while a dedicated 24V automatic charger maintains the engine batteries. Propulsion and ship's systems draw on a 24V low water loss engine-start battery group, complemented by a main generator battery 12V low water loss and an auxiliary generator starting battery 12V low water loss. Control and protection are comprehensive, with manual and electric battery disconnecting switches serving both service and engine batteries, two manual battery disconnecting switches dedicated to the

generators, and both a mechanical battery parallel switch in the cockpit and an instant electric battery parallel switch at the main helm position.

Shore and onboard distribution are equally refined, with two Carling 100A switches managing the 240V shore supply through two 25kVA isolation transformers and a breaker box. A 120V electric outlet is safeguarded by 120V 6mA ground fault interrupters, while a ground connection for the sea water intake and railings and cathodic protection with anodes ensure thorough bonding and corrosion defense. Power continuity underway is assured by a 60Hz 120V 25kW inverter dedicated to the fridge and a 60Hz 120V 3kW inverter for services, delivering seamless AC performance across the yacht.

Sanitary and water systems

The yacht's sanitary and water systems are thoughtfully engineered for reliability, efficiency, and easy upkeep. Twin automatic electric pumps manage waste streams with seamless redundancy: one oversees black water tank pump-down yet is interchangeable with the grey water circuit, while the other serves the grey water discharge system and is likewise interchangeable with the black water tank. The black water tank (53511) is monitored by gauges indicating three-quarter and full levels and features a deck connection for straightforward pump-out, complemented by a grey water tank (53511). Fresh-water amenities include an electric WC system supplied by a fresh water pump rated 60 Hz, a generous fresh water tank (132011), and water heaters 50 lt. For robust seawater capability, independent sea water intakes with filters serve both the air conditioning and the general sea water system, while a sea water fire-fighting system with chain wash down adds crucial safety and utility. A three-way valve in the galley further refines control and convenience across the installation.

Hull, deck, and deckhouse

A sculpted fiberglass access stair framed by a stainless steel perimeter rail rises to the flybridge, while passage to the swimming platform is via fiberglass steps set over a teak-laid floor with discreet courtesy lighting. The expansive fiberglass platform features an integrated starboard-side stair, a teak surface, and an up-and-down system, complemented by a concealed stainless steel electro-hydraulic swimming ladder built into the platform and a stern shower with a hot-and-cold mixer tap. At the bow, relaxation is assured with a sofa upholstered in plush cushions and protected by a tailored cover, enhanced by two watertight loudspeakers connected to the salon audio system. Safe movement throughout is ensured by a perimeter guardrail, side GRP gates, and two stainless steel handrails on the stairs to the cockpit, with the stern cockpit and side walkways finished in rich teak.

Mooring and handling are effortless thanks to two 3000 W electric anchor winches with controls at the helm station, at the bow, and on the flybridge, working in concert with two polished stainless steel anchors of 90 kg each, each paired with galvanized steel chain measuring 120 m in length and 13 mm in diameter. At the stern, two 1700 W, 24 V electric warping winches, stainless steel fairleads at bow and stern, two stainless steel hawses—one per side—and a full complement of stainless steel deck accessories and hardware deliver precise control. The layout is completed by stainless steel cleats—four at the stern, two amidships, and four at the bow—together with a concealed stainless steel electro-hydraulic gangway with stanchions and teak flooring and two stainless steel stern mooring area covers. The electro-hydraulic fiberglass hatch grants access to a generous stern garage designed to house one tender and one jet ski.

Practicality and protection are built in, with two fire-fighting hoses stationed at bow and stern, a fresh water aft shore connection, two fresh water washdown outlets serving bow and stern, a freshwater intake in chromed brass, and two

chromed brass fuel intakes on the deck, one on each side. Ventilation is refined with two stainless steel air intake covers, while the hull benefits from a durable antifouling coating that underscores long-term performance and ease of maintenance.

Hatches and windows

Thoughtfully appointed for seamless access and abundant natural light, the foredeck features an access hatch to the anchor chain locker, two access hatches to the bow deckhouse lockers, each with a stainless steel ladder, and an additional access hatch to the bow locker. The machinery spaces are equally convenient, with an engine room access door from the starboard side walkway complemented by an engine room access hatchway from the cockpit, also served by a stainless steel ladder. At the helm station, a windshield sun cover preserves clarity and comfort, while a lateral port-side hopper window enhances ventilation. Movement around the upper decks is effortless thanks to a port-side manual door on the flybridge for direct access to the bow area and a stainless steel and tempered glass sliding door connecting the wheelhouse to the flybridge. Practicality continues along the main deck with a portside manual side door from the galley to the external walkway and a starboard side manual sliding door from the main deck lobby to the external walkway, while the sliding manual main entrance saloon door is crafted in stainless steel and tempered monolithic glass. Refined finishes tie the ensemble together with portholes in stainless steel, interior doors in wood with stainless steel handles and thresholds, windows in monolithic or laminated glass, and a sleek plexiglass windshield in the flybridge area.

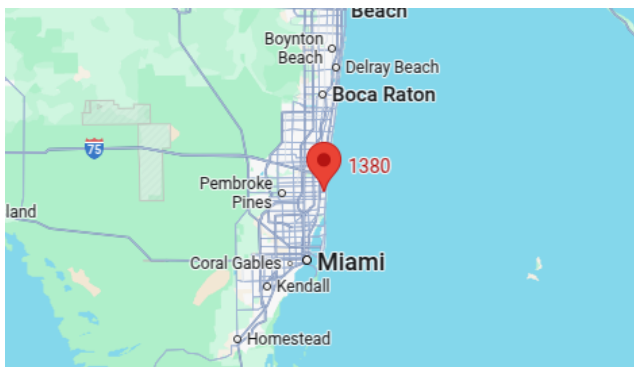
