



Key features

A true trideck built in heavy-duty steel, this expedition-grade vessel is engineered for durability and global cruising, with integrated diving tank racks, a compressor station, and organized gear storage complemented by full Nitrox facilities. Accommodations welcome up to thirteen guests plus crew and a divemaster in air-conditioned cabins with ensuites, supported by a large galley and mess area ideal for extended voyages. Twin diesel engines deliver reliable performance and long-range capability, while a watermaker, twin gensets, and a full navigation suite provide confident autonomous operation. Priced to sell and currently lying in Phuket, she is available for inspection by appointment.

Remarks

Whether you are embarking on private exploration, outfitting a dive school, launching an expedition brand, or expanding a charter fleet, this vessel blends robust functionality with genuine onboard comfort—more than a boat, she is a purpose-built platform for underwater discovery. La Mer, launched in 2003, has had only two owners; most recently she has cruised extensively on private diving expeditions throughout Thailand and as far as Myanmar and the Andamans, confidently handling rough seas to reach destinations others hesitate to attempt. She accommodates thirteen guests in six staterooms, including a main deck master; four staterooms feature private ensuites, while two share a single ensuite. High ceilings throughout and a fully equipped galley with a dumb waiter serving the saloon are complemented by multiple fridges, freezers, and iceboxes, a watermaker, recently rebuilt two sixty kW generators, a stern thruster, and two tenders with outboards, including a large RIB that launches by crane. Economical twin Nissan V10 three hundred fifty HP engines,

together with generous fuel, water, and holding tanks, empower true long-range expeditions to remote, exotic locations. As a trideck, she offers a wealth of entertainment spaces and both indoor and outdoor dining options, anchored by an enormous saloon that must be seen to be believed. Viewings are available by appointment in person or via electronic means—an exceptional opportunity to acquire a uniquely capable vessel for pleasure or business.


