OVERVIEW

FONTANA, a 2012 Sanlorenzo SD92, is an exquisite 92-foot luxury motor yacht that unites signature Italian craftsmanship, assured performance, and effortless comfort. Inside, her refined layout reveals four generous guest suites welcoming up to eight aboard, while an airy, open-concept salon merges seamlessly with the dining area and galley to create a warm hub for relaxed gathering and easy entertaining. Conceived for both family escapes and sophisticated hosting, this flybridge superyacht artfully balances grace with everyday function, presenting an ambiance that feels both polished and inviting.

Propelled by twin MTU 2000 series engines, each delivering 2,000 hp, she offers smooth, dependable cruising. Outdoors, the expansive flybridge invites sun-drenched lounging with ample seating and a wet bar, and the wide aft deck provides direct, uncomplicated access to the water for swimming and water toys. Ideal for coastal cruising and island-hopping, this semi-displacement motoryacht encourages you to explore shorelines in style and absolute comfort, with an elegant interior finish and thoughtful design details throughout that elevate every moment at sea.

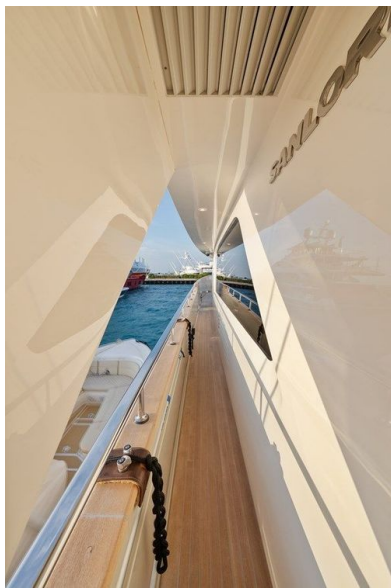

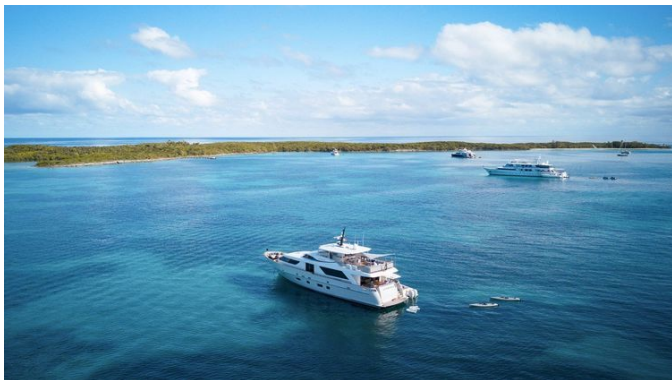


















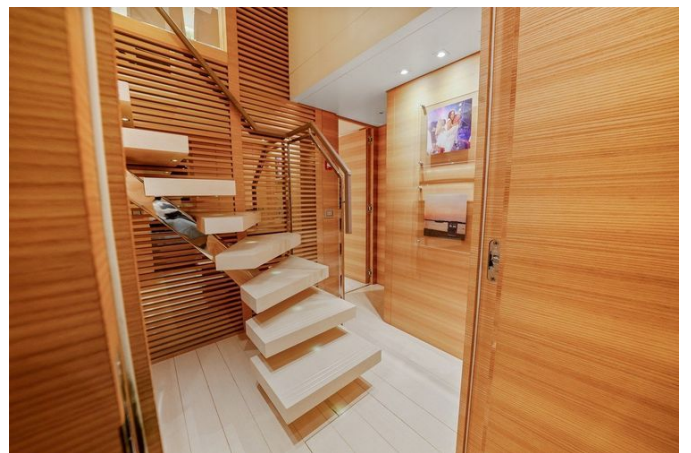














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Extensive recent upgrades and maintenance (2022–2024)

From 2022 through 2024, the yacht benefited from a comprehensive program of upgrades and meticulous servicing designed to elevate reliability, comfort, and performance. At the helm, new Simrad GPS navigational equipment, radar, and autopilot were installed in 2022 and 2023. The stabilizers underwent a full service in the same period, including new pipework, a new raw-water pump, and new heat exchangers. In 2022, new hydraulic pipelines were fitted for the garage door and the Passarella. The engines and generators received a complete service with compression checks plus valve, turbocharger, and cylinder inspections, performed with RPM Diesel expertise.

On the climate-control front, the air-conditioning chillers were removed and serviced, and new plumbing pumps were installed, with all pumps either serviced or replaced. All air-conditioning handlers were removed and serviced; four new handlers and new motors were fitted as required, and in 2024 new air ducts were installed throughout the yacht. Running gear attention included shafts pulled, checked, and straightened, new cutlass bearings, and propellers dynamically balanced in 2022 and again in 2024. Below the waterline, Sea Hawk bottom paint and Propspeed have been applied annually, while the watermakers were serviced in 2024 with a new high-pressure pump and new membranes.

Deck and exterior enhancements were equally thorough. New Maxwell windlasses were installed and the bow deck was reinforced. In 2024, new teak was laid on the flybridge, bow, and aft-deck steps, accompanied by new caulking throughout, while exterior window caulking was renewed in 2023. Safety systems have been diligently maintained with yearly fire-suppression

system servicing and new fire extinguishers added in 2022. All through-hull seacocks were replaced across 2022 and 2023, a new anchor chain was added in 2024, and new house, engine, and generator batteries were fitted in 2022 and 2024.

Interior comforts received notable upgrades as well. The galley was refreshed in 2023 and 2024 with a new oven, refrigerator, stovetop, and extractor fan, complemented by a new washing machine and dryer in 2023 and new crew and twin cabin mattresses the same year. On the flybridge, new ice glass was added in 2022, and the yacht's finish has been preserved with a DITEC protective exterior coating applied for three years.

Exterior & deck spaces

A spacious aft deck invites alfresco dining and lively entertaining, flowing seamlessly to a swim platform that offers direct access to the water for swimming and other activities. In 2024, new teak decking was fitted on the flybridge, bow, and aft deck steps with refreshed caulking throughout, while the bow deck was reinforced and equipped with new Maxwell windlasses, and a new anchor chain was installed. The exterior windows were re-caulked in 2023, and the exterior benefits from a Ditec protective coating that provides three-year protection.

Flybridge

The flybridge presents a large, open layout with generous seating and expansive sunbathing areas, creating a refined alfresco haven for relaxation. A well-appointed wet bar anchors the social arrangement, making it ideal for effortless entertaining. Underfoot, new teak decking installed in 2024 elevates both style and durability, while new Ice glass fitted in 2022 ensures clear protection and comfort in varying conditions. Seamless navigation comes

courtesy of updated Simrad GPS, radar, and autopilot, thoughtfully refreshed in 2022 and 2023.

Main salon & dining

An open-plan arrangement seamlessly unites the salon, dining area, and galley, creating a fluid social hub framed by expansive windows that bathe the space in natural light. An elegant Italian sensibility defines the interior, with refined finishes and meticulous detailing elevating the ambiance. Generous, thoughtfully arranged seating invites relaxed lounging or effortless entertaining, ensuring every moment onboard feels both intimate and sophisticated.

Galley

Fully equipped and conveniently positioned for seamless service, the galley showcases a new oven, refrigerator, stovetop, and extractor fan installed in 2023/2024. Abundant storage and generous work surfaces deliver the capacity and efficiency required for extended cruising, ensuring effortless provisioning, preparation, and cleanup underway or at anchor.

Guest accommodations

Four well-appointed guest cabins welcome up to eight guests, with staterooms that are comfortable and quiet, thoughtfully designed for extended stays. In 2023, new mattresses were fitted in the crew and twin guest cabins, further elevating rest and refinement across the accommodation.

Crew area

Designed for professional operation, the dedicated crew accommodations

provide a comfortable and efficient haven for the team, enhanced by a new washing machine and dryer installed in 2023 and a thoughtfully engineered layout that supports long range cruising and charter use.

Climate control and comfort systems

To elevate onboard comfort, the AC chillers were removed and fully serviced. The plumbing pumps were renewed, with each unit serviced or replaced as required. All air handlers were removed and serviced, and four new AC units were installed, with new motors fitted where required. Completing this comprehensive upgrade, new air ducts were installed throughout the yacht in 2024, ensuring consistent airflow in every interior space.

Machinery & mechanical systems

Power is delivered by twin MTU 2000 engines that have been professionally maintained, with both engines and generators fully serviced by RPM Diesel, including compression checks and thorough turbo and cylinder inspections. The stabilizers received comprehensive attention in 2022 and 2023 with new pipework, a new raw water pump, and new heat exchangers to ensure smooth, reliable performance. The running gear has been meticulously optimized, with shafts pulled, checked, and straightened and fitted with new cutlass bearings, while the propellers were precision balanced in 2022 and again in 2024 for peak efficiency and quiet operation.

Electrical, safety & technical systems

This yacht's critical infrastructure has been meticulously updated for confidence at sea, with new house, engine, and generator batteries fitted in 2022 and again in 2024 to deliver dependable starting power and sustained

onboard energy. All through-hull seacocks were renewed throughout the vessel in 2022 and 2023, enhancing below-the-waterline integrity and reliability. Safety systems are rigorously maintained with yearly fire suppression service, complemented by new fire extinguishers installed in 2022. For extended autonomy offshore, the watermakers were comprehensively serviced in 2024 with a new high-pressure pump and fresh membranes, ensuring efficient, reliable freshwater production.

Bottom & running gear

The underwater profile is protected with fresh Sea Hawk bottom paint applied annually, while the running gear is treated with PropSpeed every year to ensure smooth performance and lasting reliability.

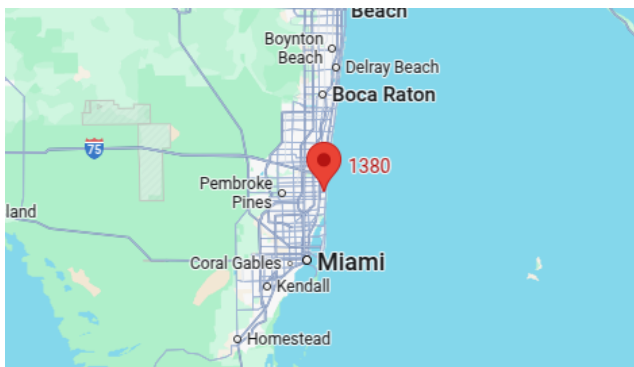
