OVERVIEW

Launched in 2007 and currently lying in Spain, this 93-foot luxury motor yacht marries time-honored wooden craftsmanship with contemporary performance and refinement. Designed inside and out by the Elegan Design Team, she is a semi-displacement wooden superyacht in the 90–100 ft class, conceived for Mediterranean cruising, gracious entertaining, and effortless long weekends at sea.

Her generous 20-foot beam creates an immediate sense of spaciousness, while the warm patina of fine woodwork and considerate detailing evokes a timeless, welcoming atmosphere. The interior by the Elegan Design Team harmonizes elegance with utility: flowing living spaces lead naturally from salon to dining, providing an ideal setting for relaxed family life or sophisticated soirées. Accommodation is arranged for up to seven guests and is served by six well-appointed heads, a level of convenience that enhances comfort on every passage. Crew quarters are discreet and efficient, comprising two cabins with six berths to ensure polished service and seamless operation. Beneath her handcrafted planking twin MAN diesel inboards deliver assured propulsion, yielding an economical 20-knot cruise and a lively 24-knot top speed. The semi-displacement hull form balances fuel efficiency with seakeeping, and an 8.53-foot draft lends steady composure offshore. Substantial tanks—approximately 2,641.72 gallons of fuel and roughly 528.34 gallons of water—support extended coastal exploration, languid anchorages, and unhurried island hopping.

On deck, expansive wood-clad areas invite al fresco living, from sunlit lounging to candlelit dinners with the sea breeze as accompaniment. Every surface, seam, and curve speaks of the charm and skill unique to a wooden yacht, married to the reliability and capability expected of a modern semi-displacement cruiser. This is a graceful, thoroughly capable

Mediterranean vessel: a luxury motor yacht, semi-displacement wooden superyacht with MAN diesel inboard power—equally suited to private family cruising and refined entertaining, distinguished by enduring style, range, and presence.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodation:

On board, the Seven You superyacht welcomes up to 10 guests in five luxurious en suite cabins, thoughtfully arranged for privacy and comfort, comprising one Master stateroom, two VIP cabins, and two Twin cabins that cater beautifully to families and friends alike, each cabin appointed with refined finishes and the attentive layout expected of a yacht of this calibre to ensure restful nights and convivial days at sea.

2022-2023 refit history

During 2022–2023 a comprehensive refit elevated Seven You's capability, safety, and comfort with meticulous work across machinery, structure, systems, and navigation equipment; major overhauls were carried out on the anchor windlass, passerelle, sundeck crane, bow and stern thrusters, generators, and main engines, accompanied by a full steering-system service and additional works on engines and generators to restore peak reliability. Structural and deck enhancements included reinforcement of the swimming platform to improve jetski manoeuvring, strengthening of stainless steel handrails, sandblasting of the hull followed by application of antiskid paint, and fresh paint for the crane and bar to renew visual appeal. Practical foredeck upgrades introduced a fabricated step to the sun pads, new chain locker hatches, a newly laid two square metre teak section on the bow, and replacement teak on the stairs to the swimming platform to combine elegance with durability. Propulsion and exhaust systems were renewed with shaftline works and repair and calibration of the propellers, repair of the exhaust line with new covers, and replacement of sacrificial zincs for optimal corrosion protection. The navigation suite was modernized with new Raymarine Axiom

nine inch and twelve inch displays, Navionics charts, a transducer, a twenty four mile radar antenna, two Raymarine P70RS autopilots, VHF HM390C BB DSC, and Raymarine AIS 700, complemented by navigation works fac 814 to bring situational awareness to contemporary standards. Systems upgrades included black water system works, a Maretron installation for enhanced monitoring, new batteries, renewed engine room extractors, and climate control enhancements featuring new air conditioning chillers, replacement fan coils, and comprehensive cleaning of all AC circuits and piping prior to installation of the new chillers. The watermaker received a full overhaul, eight underwater lights were added to create dramatic nocturnal ambiance, and a shore water treatment system was installed to ensure reliable dockside operation. The original swimming ladder was removed and replaced with a sleek carbon fiber swimming ladder, while general boat supplies and materials supported the project end to end and yard services, including Travelift and esplanade, ensured precise handling throughout the refit process.


