


























DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Walkthrough

Boarding OBSESSION is effortless, whether you step aboard through the two port side boarding gates, the single starboard side gate, or directly from a floating dock via the generous swim platform. Aft, the teak decked cockpit unfolds as an expansive outdoor salon, complete with both fixed and loose seating, a walk behind bar beneath a full overhang, and open tread steps that sweep gracefully up to the boat deck. The salon welcomes you through a wide sliding door, revealing interior stairs to the skylounge, well appointed cabinetry to starboard, and a comforting C shaped sectional to port. Forward, an elegant dining table seats eight, flanked to port by outboard cabinets, while to starboard a dramatic set of full height sliding doors pairs with a hydraulically opening hull side balcony to merge the interior with the sea. Moving ahead, steps rise to the private Master suite, while to port the inviting "Country Kitchen" galley with forward seating becomes a natural gathering spot; a convenient day head resides to starboard. Further forward to starboard, stairs descend to the guest quarters: a spacious ensuite VIP forward, an upper/lower cabin on the starboard side, a queen berth ensuite to port, a twin lower berth cabin, and a well arranged head shared by the two starboard side twin cabins; a practical laundry center sits within the companionway. Nine open tread steps from the salon lead to the skylounge, where a centerline helm is flanked by companion Stidd double bench seats to port and starboard. Here you'll also find an L shaped upholstered settee with a high low table, an entertainment center to starboard, and a convenient day head just aft. The boat deck continues the theme of conviviality with a walk behind bar fitted with four stools, inviting loose deck furniture, and a dining table, with steps cascading down to the aft deck. Crew enjoy discreet

access via steps tucked behind the flybridge staircase, leading to a starboard side bunk room, a centrally located shared head and shower, and an extra wide single berth to port complemented by a small seating area outside the cabin. Aft, the meticulously kept engine room is served by an emergency exit that leads through to the garage for ultimate peace of mind.

Salon

Bathed in natural light from expansive side and aft windows, the salon feels wonderfully open and airy. A two panel Trend sliding entry door opens wide for an inviting welcome, and immediately to starboard the open steps rise to the skylounge. Progressing forward along the starboard side, a refined run of cabinetry hosts dedicated stemware nestled in Lucite cut outs, three drawers, and the yacht's entertainment suite, which comprises a Bose receiver, a Samsung Blu ray player, a Direct TV HD DVR, a URC network controller, a Luxul router and wireless controller, plus a Direct TV HD receiver for the aft deck. A 65 inch Samsung TV with sound bar lifts elegantly from the central cabinet behind the glass storage, while a U Line glass front wine cooler sits furthest forward. To port, a large light blue leather C shaped sofa with under seat storage anchors the room; at each corner, a high gloss wooden table conceals additional storage and rises at the touch of a button. Electric Oceanair blinds temper the daylight across the side windows, punctuated by tasteful sconces between each pane, while above, a decorative fabric valance integrates soffit style air conditioning delivery within rich walnut joinery. A stone and stainless end table and a matching coffee table complete the setting, and a custom opaque shade softens the wide aft sliding door. The sole is finished in Avalon Acacia Cocoa plank flooring, and the ceiling features eighteen LED lights as well as a smoke/fire alarm sensor for safety.

Dining salon

Open to the salon, the dining area centers on a high gloss table with inset stainless steel trim atop a fixed wood base, its low back upholstered chairs comfortably seating eight. Above, a slightly raised soffit with eight LED lights casts a gentle glow, while forward an upholstered panel on the bulkhead frames the owner's artwork. To port, six cabinet doors conceal the neatly organized service of dishes and cutlery. To starboard lies one of this Viking 93's most impressive signatures: dual, floor to ceiling glass doors that slide open to the side deck, paired with an Opacmare folding balcony that dramatically expands the space and invites the outdoors in. The salon's wood sole flows forward beneath your feet, illuminated by twelve overhead LED lights, two of which are dedicated to the artwork. Just ahead to starboard, steps descend to the private Master cabin, and next forward on the main deck a day head awaits with a two door vanity topped in Caesarstone and a Kohler china sink above, finished with a wood trimmed mirror and a Headhunter toilet upon the continuation of the salon's wood sole; large side windows here are dressed with electric Oceanair shades.

Galley

Spanning the full beam forward and bathed in ambient light, the country style galley is the social heart of any cruise, with ample dinette seating for five to six and a two level, aft facing breakfast bar accompanied by four fixed bar stools upholstered in Cora Outdoor Greyhound with contrasting double welt in Cora Outdoor Icing. The space is finished with Avalon Pinnacle Series Acacia Cocoa flooring and finely crafted countertops in Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo with a flat polished edge. Culinary equipment includes a Miele surface mount four burner induction cooktop, a Miele stainless steel oven, a full size upright Sub Zero refrigerator with twin doors and a freezer drawer, and a Miele

stainless steel microwave; an exterior vented exhaust fan, a Badger garbage disposal, and a double under mount stainless steel sink with a satin nickel faucet add daily convenience. Clean up is effortless with a Fisher Paykel drawer type dishwasher faced in walnut. A port side entry door simplifies provisioning, while dimmable recessed LED lighting sets the mood. Forward, a high gloss walnut dinette table on a stainless pedestal invites lingering meals, backed by a 32 inch flat screen TV in a custom corner cabinet. Automatic Oceanair blinds shade the forward windshield; a custom Paul Bright plexi dishware cabinet and abundant pantry storage keep essentials ship shape. Further amenities include a Kenmore trash compactor with a walnut front, a Scotsman clear ice maker behind a matching walnut door, a six light soffit over the bar, decorative glass brick backsplashes, twelve walnut drawers, seven walnut cabinet doors, ten overhead LED lights, a smoke/fire alarm, and two stereo speakers.

Master stateroom

Reached via nine illuminated steps and secured by a door at the lower landing, the Master sanctuary is both exquisitely private and warmly elegant. A full king island berth rests against the aft bulkhead, flanked by three drawer nightstands and twin two bulb sconces mounted above the upholstered headboard. Two drawers beneath the berth add discreet storage. Aft to starboard, a generous walk in wardrobe offers a digital safe, an HD SAT TV DVR, a Samsung Blu ray player, and abundant hanging space. Forward along the starboard side, a two person desk or breakfast nook sits beneath a large hull side window with automatic Oceanair shades, while ahead three substantial storage drawers with a high gloss wood top create a refined dresser. To port, a bank of four drawers and a cabinet topped in high gloss wood leads to a hinged top vanity with six drawers and an upholstered stool; above, a matching hull side window is dressed with electric Oceanair shades.

Inboard, a private doorway grants access to the ensuite head. Additional comforts include a Viking Slumber #8 mattress with quilted designer bedspread, pillow shams and décor pillows, a 65 inch Samsung flat screen TV, eighteen recessed LED lights plus two focused reading lights, luxurious Fabrica Athena Victoria heavy pile carpeting with deep padding, a large tray ceiling, and intuitive digital climate control.

Master head

Accessed from the port side of the berth, the owner's head features a seven foot vanity with nine drawers and four cabinet doors, twin Kohler under mount sinks, and five mirrored medicine cabinet doors above. The stall shower is enclosed by a clear glass hinged door with matching side light and fitted with both wall mounted and handheld fixtures plus a shelf outboard, while the Headhunter toilet underscores the premium specification. Finishes elevate the space with a Caesarstone Emperadoro vanity top with flat polished edges; flooring bordered in Caesarstone Urban Safari, transitioning to Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo and Caesarstone Emperadoro; Oceanair sky Venetian blinds; polished chrome towel bar and rings; generous linen storage; custom wallpaper; eight overhead lights; an A/C vent; an exhaust fan; and a mirrored ceiling that amplifies light and volume.

Companionway forward

From the starboard side of the galley, eight curved, carpeted steps with step lights descend to the main accommodation level. At their base, a stainless steel Miele washer and dryer are concealed behind a walnut door. Forward lies the VIP suite, with an upper/lower guest room to starboard; further aft you'll find a shared head and a twin lower berth cabin, while opposite to port sits a queen berth cabin with its own ensuite head. This

corridor is thoughtfully detailed with Awlgrip finished bilge areas complete with access hatches and lighting, Central Vac connections with accessories, sumptuous Fabrica Athena Victoria carpeting with heavy padding, dedicated linen storage, recessed LED overhead lighting, and custom designer wallpaper.

Forward VIP stateroom

All the way forward, a raised queen size berth with four drawers below is reached by carpeted hull side steps for effortless access. Built in nightstands flank the berth to port and starboard, while a padded headboard frames a backlit, etched glass sea scene and twin wall mounted reading lights. Aft to both port and starboard, auto lit two door hanging lockers sit above a pair of drawers, and opposing deadlights flood the space with natural light. The aft bulkhead holds a 32 inch Samsung TV and a discreet door to the ensuite head. Appointments include a Viking Slumber #6 mattress, a large foredeck skylight with opening hatch and Oceanair Skysol honeycomb blackout shade in beige, a Nuance Nickel Channel glass headboard detail, a designer comforter with pillow shams, a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD player, six overhead LED lights, walnut storage cabinets to port and starboard at the bedside, a Fabrica carpeted sole, a stereo speaker, a smoke/fire alarm sensor, and digital A/C control.

Forward VIP head

Aft to port within the suite, the ensuite head features a walnut vanity with three cabinet doors and two drawers beneath a Kohler under mount sink, complemented by a three panel mirrored medicine cabinet above. The Headhunter toilet underscores reliability, and the stall shower—enclosed with a clear glass hinged door—includes a seat, shelf, an opening stainless steel porthole with Oceanair blinds, and either wall mounted or handheld fixtures. Finishes comprise a vanity top in Caesarstone Emperadoro, a custom floor in

Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo with matching shower floor, custom designer wallpapers, a mirrored ceiling, a walnut door linen locker, an A/C vent, five LED overhead lights, and an exhaust fan; towel bar and rings are presented in a polished finish.

Guest stateroom - starboard forward

Immediately aft to starboard, the over/under twin berth cabin lines the outboard hull side, with the upper berth served by an opening stainless steel porthole fitted with a blackout cover. Inboard and forward, a half height auto lit hanging locker with two drawers below complements a four drawer chest aft, while a 22 inch Samsung TV crowns the space. Amenities include a Viking Slumber mattress, four recessed overhead LED lights, custom designer wallpaper, Fabrica carpeting, a Direct TV HD receiver, a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD player, two stereo speakers, digital A/C control, and a smoke/fire sensor.

Shared aft head

Serving the starboard side guest cabins, the shared head features a two door walnut vanity with a Kohler under mount sink and a mirrored medicine cabinet above. A Headhunter toilet provides dependable performance, while the stall shower—enclosed by a clear glass hinged door—offers a seat, shelf, tiled sole, opening stainless steel porthole with Oceanair blinds, and your choice of wall mounted or handheld fixture. Finishes include polished chrome towel bar and rings, a Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo vanity top, matching Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo flooring and shower floor, custom designer wallpaper, a mirrored ceiling, four overhead LED lights, an exhaust fan, and an A/C outlet. Two doors provide access—one from the centerline companionway and one from the twin berth stateroom aft.

Guest stateroom – starboard aft

Entered from the forward end, this aft starboard stateroom presents twin lower berths against the aft bulkhead with a three drawer nightstand between them; an upholstered headboard spans both beds, topped by a focused reading light. Each berth is hinged to reveal generous storage below. Forward, a door leads directly into the shared head, while further outboard a double door auto lit hanging locker with two large drawers beneath handles longer stays. Appointments include a Viking Slumber mattress, designer comforters with pillow shams, a 22 inch Samsung flat screen TV on the forward bulkhead, custom designer wallpaper, a Direct TV HD receiver, a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD player, overhead LED lights, a Fabrica carpeted sole, digital A/C control, and a smoke/fire sensor.

Port VIP stateroom

Entered from the forward end, the port VIP stateroom features a walk around queen berth on the aft bulkhead, its full beam upholstered headboard extending over twin three drawer walnut nightstands. Two drawers under the berth, plus further storage beneath the hinged base, maximize utility. Outboard, a shelf with concealed storage sits beneath a porthole, while further forward a two door auto lit hanging locker with two drawers below leads to the ensuite head. Amenities include a Viking Slumber #6 mattress, designer comforter with pillow shams, a 22 inch Samsung flat screen TV on the forward bulkhead, private access to the ensuite, custom designer wallpaper, digital A/C control, Fabrica carpeting, two stereo speakers, an opening porthole with blackout cover, a Fusion stereo with AM/FM/CD/DVD player, a Direct TV HD receiver, a soffit overhead with reading light, and a smoke/fire sensor.

Port VIP stateroom head

Within the port side guest cabin, the ensuite head presents a walnut vanity with two cabinet doors and a Kohler under mount sink, topped by a single door mirrored medicine cabinet. A Headhunter toilet ensures reliability, and the stall shower features a clear glass hinged door, seat, shelf, a handheld or wall mounted fixture, dedicated lighting, and an exhaust fan. Finishes include polished chrome towel bar and rings, a Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo vanity top with matching custom floor and shower floor, custom designer wallpaper, a mirrored ceiling with four overhead lights, and dedicated A/C vents.

Skylounge

Climbing nine open tread steps from the aft end of the salon reveals a remarkably spacious skylounge for a 93 foot yacht. The helm sits proudly on the centerline forward, while aft to port an L shaped upholstered sectional with abundant storage beneath pairs with a high gloss walnut hi lo table to create a relaxed, elevated salon. To starboard, a refined run of five walnut cabinets and five drawers conceals a Samsung 40 inch TV that rises at your command, together with a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD player; just aft, a dedicated day head enhances convenience. Opposite the day head, an aft facing bar with three fixed wood pedestal stools becomes an entertainer's hub; the aft window retracts so the attendant on the boat deck bar can serve directly inside. A two pane bi fold door effectively opens the entire aft bulkhead to the breeze. Additional refinements include a large opening glass sky roof, Oceanair blinds in Skyvenetian Alloy material, a custom flybridge window treatment, a Bose sound bar for the TV, and digital A/C controls.

Skylounge day head

Compact yet invaluable, the skylounge day head is finished with a two door walnut vanity, a stainless steel under mount sink, blinds on the house side window, and a Headhunter toilet. Premium surfaces include Caesarstone flooring in Emperadoro and Statuario Nuvo, a Caesarstone Emperadoro vanity top, clean overhead lighting, brushed nickel towel bar and rings, an exhaust fan, and an A/C vent.

Electronics & navigation equipment

The helm suite is comprehensively outfitted for confident passagemaking, beginning with two Garmin GPSMAP 8617 17 inch multifunction displays to port and starboard and a centerline Garmin FPSMAP 8622 22 inch multifunction display, all fed by a Garmin 2526 x HD2 25 kW radar with a 6 foot array, a Garmin GSD 26 CHIRP video sounder with a 1 kW wide beam transducer, and a Garmin GXM 53 weather antenna. Integration continues through a Garmin AIS 600 AIS transponder, full NMEA 2000 network components, and a Garmin Wi-Fi adapter for BlueChart, while a Furuno RD33 data organizer enhances situational awareness. Precision control comes from a Garmin GHP Reactor steer by wire autopilot, two ICOM M 605 VHF radios, a Fusion MS ACSXV SiriusXM tuner, and KVH TracPhone V7 IP with router and wireless access point, supported by a Panasonic two line cordless phone system, AIDEAN Networks AN 2000 Marine Wi-Fi, and a Mofi cellular 4G LTE router. For vigilance, seven GOST PM Mini IR ball cameras and a FLIR M625h dual payload thermal/low light system with Garmin integration stand watch, aided by an ACR RCL 300A spotlight. Entertainment and information flow through KVH HD7 TracVision SAT TV with Tri Americas 2 MD and a separate DirecTV receiver at each TV, plus Apple TV in all locations; security and tracking are bolstered by a GOST GNT 3.0 VMS with NavTracker. Engine data is

crystal clear on an MTU 6 inch LED engine monitor with MTU single lever engine controls, start/stop and parallel switches, an integrated SidePower bow and stern thruster control set, a SidePower stabilizer panel, a Seakeeper gyro control, a Fusion stereo remote, FLIR infrared camera controls, wiper controls, a SeaFire control panel, and a Ritchie 8 inch magnetic compass. Docking finesse is elevated by MTU joystick control with Dynamic Positioning, while a 12 inch PowerPlex alarm/status/tank touchscreen monitor streamlines systems oversight. Practical touches include two drawers at the helm, a Stidd helm chair, port and starboard Stidd two person companion seats with footrests, a windshield defogger, Pinnacle Acacia Cocoa flooring at the helm area, and a remote panel for the watermaker.

Flybridge aft deck

Partially shaded by the flybridge overhang, the aft deck of the flybridge is finished with a teak sole and anchored by a walk behind bar with a stone two level top, a Kenyon electric grill concealed beneath a hinged lid, and a corner cabinet with an under mount stainless steel sink. Four upholstered swivel bar stools with supportive backrests face forward, making this a magnetic gathering place. Highlights include free standing Jasper rattan outdoor seating with welt in distressed Outdoor Stone, an enlarged radar mast with SAT dome wings, a six person Revere life raft, a 6 foot open array Garmin radar scanner rated to 96 miles, five custom DRSA soft white LED mast uplights, painted SAT domes, stairs to the aft deck with railing and a hinged cover, three stainless steel sunshade poles with removable canvas shades, an Isotherm stainless steel bar fridge, two Bose speakers, overhead LED strip lighting, and four spreader lights.

Bow area & foredeck

Forward, the foredeck is arranged for both relaxation and practicality, featuring a bow seating area with new cushions and covers, a forward sunpad with matching new cushions and cover, and a removable sunshade set on carbon fiber poles over the seating. Convenience abounds with a starboard side refrigerated locker in a top loading cabinet, a port side sink in a matching top loading cabinet, a port side storage locker, and a dedicated stowage area for sunpads. Underfoot, teak decking sets a refined tone, while a Fusion stereo control head, custom Joana Balcazar pillows, and a bow flag pole add signature touches. Safety and seamanship are addressed with raised bulwarks and raised bow cleats, dual access to the chain locker, a hidden Lewmar windlass beneath a two door hatch, a stainless steel anchor chute, a stainless steel Bruce claw anchor, a 300 foot chain rode, a stainless steel bow railing, and built in dunnage boxes forward and aft to port and starboard. Evening ambience comes courtesy of Bose stereo speakers, pop up lights at the bow seat, and 8 inch stainless steel cup holders at the seating. Overhead, the forward VIP skylight includes a center escape hatch.

Side decks

Movement around the yacht is safe and fluid along wide, teak covered side decks with fuel fills to port and starboard. Boarding flexibility is assured with two port side boarding gates and one starboard side boarding gate, each with ladder attachment points. Dual spring line cleats simplify mooring, international navigation lights ensure visibility, and a port side galley entrance door streamlines service. Flush house side windows keep the profile clean, while two side deck cameras enhance situational awareness. Fold out wing controls facilitate close quarters handling, and a starboard side fold down balcony with a safety rail adds a spectacular over water perch.

Aft deck

Thoughtfully tiered for easy living, the aft deck offers port and starboard stairs from the swim platform with teak treads and hinged access gates, a discreet crew doorway with porthole, and a handsome staircase with teak treads up to the flybridge. Teak decks set the tone for alfresco dining on built-in seating for six to eight aft with removable cushions and covers, gathered around a custom high-gloss teak dining table with a protective cover and a center hinge for effortless access. The two-level aft deck bar features a stone top and an under-mount stainless steel sink with cover, with three drawers concealed behind a cabinet door beneath; nearby, an Isotherm stainless steel ice maker and refrigerator keep refreshments at hand, while a 40-inch Samsung flat-screen TV drops down for open-air cinema. Three bar stools in Brisa Outdoor Jasper with polished chrome bases complete the social scene. Seamanship elements include stainless steel cleats and hawse pipes, a hydraulic swim platform with teak deck, a garage with a hydraulic lift door for storage, aft deck air conditioning, two Bose stereo speakers, and Lumishore controls for six color-changing underwater lights. Structural confidence comes from two stainless steel support poles for the aft flybridge deck. Shore power logistics are simplified with port and starboard 100-amp shore cord reels with 75-foot cords, plus freshwater washdown and dockside water inlet. An oil transfer connection resides in the port-side locker on the platform, a freshwater shower graces the transom, pop-up tender cleats are set into the platform, step lights guide the way from the aft deck down to the platform, and a Fusion stereo remote keeps the soundtrack close at hand.

Crew quarters

Forward of the engine room and accessed separately from the aft deck, the crew quarters deliver complete privacy and excellent functionality. The

common area connects both cabins and features a double seat facing a 32 inch Samsung TV and a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD player, with a countertop beneath hosting two refrigerator drawers for additional cold storage and a Samsung microwave above for quick meals; a fold out table deploys from the bulkhead as needed. The head sits centerline forward, while engine room access is centerline aft; to port is the Captain's cabin and to starboard the bunk cabin. Practical details include a durable vinyl sole, emergency fire system pulls, and a Delta T ventilation touchscreen controller. All shore/generator switching is intuitively located by the steps descending from the aft deck.

Captain's stateroom

The Captain's private retreat is fitted with a three quarter berth dressed in a Viking Slumber #6 mattress, a bedspread with pillow shams, and a nightstand with three drawers beside a maple lined hanging locker. Entertainment and comfort are assured with a 22 inch Samsung flat screen TV, upgraded carpeting with plush padding, reading lights on swivel bases, digital A/C control, a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD stereo, an opening stainless steel porthole with blackout cover, and a Direct TV HD receiver.

Crew stateroom

The crew bunk cabin provides twin over/under berths complemented by designer bedspreads with pillow shams, a maple lined hanging locker, upgraded carpeting with plush padding, two reading lights with swivel bases, and two stereo speakers. Modern conveniences include digital A/C control, a 22 inch Samsung TV, a Fusion AM/FM/CD/DVD stereo, a Direct TV HD receiver, and overhead LED lighting.

Captain and crew head

Shared by the captain and crew, this head features a Caesarstone Statuario Nuvo vanity top with two cabinet doors below, custom Amtico flooring in vintage teak with dark walnut, and an exhaust fan with vent. The shower is enclosed by a one piece glass door and includes a light, shelf, and handheld or wall mountable fixture. A brushed nickel towel bar and rings, a mirror over the sink, a medicine cabinet with shelves, overhead LED lighting, and a mirrored overhead complete the space.

Mechanical equipment

Engineered for quiet strength and confident range, the machinery suite includes a Seakeeper SK35 stabilization system working in concert with Side Power Vector stabilizer fins, twin MTU 12V2000 M96L engines under warranty until December 2024, and ZF 3050 V drives with a 3:1 reduction gear. Fresh water reliability comes from a Headhunter pump, while the Headhunter head treatment system assures clean operation. Precision maneuvering is elevated by MTU Dynamic Positioning with joystick, Side Power hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, and twin engine driven hydraulic pumps. Climate control is robust via a Cruisair chilled water air conditioning and heat system with two 10 ton units, aided by a Delta T ventilation system, automatic and manual fire suppression, Viking proprietary fuel priming pumps, an oil change system, a fuel polishing system, and a Viking Viper electro hydraulic steering system. Illumination is both AC and DC, with watertight bulkhead doors enhancing integrity. Shore power handling is simplified by two Glendinning Cablemasters rated at 100 amps with 75 foot cords, plus an emergency tee in the dock water fill manifold and crash pumps on the main engines. Engine room blowers operate via automatic thermostat. Endurance is extended by a Blue Water 75 gph ClearMate watermaker and a Side Power

hydraulic power pack. The single epoxy wrapped exhaust, a rubber diamond plate sole, Racor FBO 10 MA fuel filters for each engine, a fresh water spigot and hose, two AQUA Drive soft starts for A/C compressors, two Racor 500 fuel filters for the generators, four soft starts for Delta T fans, two white painted tool boxes in the engine room, and three engine room cameras all speak to thoughtful specification. Practical touches include a 4 inch vice, two rudder room access doors with auto lights, two Seakeeper access doors, two generator coolant recovery bottles, 4 inch stainless steel shafts with dripless shaft seals and spares, overhead rod holders, a ladder and hatch to the garage, an overhead escape hatch to the aft deck, five blade Nibral Veem Interceptor propellers, and two Seaward 28 gallon water heaters. Fuel tanks are configured as follows: a forward main tank of 1010 gallons, an aft tank of 962 gallons, and port and starboard saddle tanks of 589 gallons each.

Electrical system

Electrical architecture is robust and redundant, comprising 12V/24V DC systems supported by ten 12V batteries; 120V/240V AC distribution at 60 Hz in single and three phase; four 24V 100 amp Mastervolt chargers dedicated respectively to electronics, house batteries, engine batteries, and general service; and two Kohler 55 kW generators within sound shields. An ASEA Power converter broadens shore power compatibility. Control is intuitive via four battery shut off switches, a 24V/12V panel at the crew entrance, a 120V/240V main switch panel feeding twelve sub panels, and three touchscreen PowerPlex control panels at the helm, in the salon, and in the crew area. Shore 1/Shore 2/Gen 1/Gen 2 selector breakers are conveniently grouped at the crew area panel.

Built as Viking's flagship motor yacht (ex: Bookends), OBSESSION is a rare find that blends pedigree, performance, and panache. She pairs 1945 hp MTUs still under warranty with a Seakeeper 35 gyro, a hydraulic swim platform, a garage, a hydraulic side deck balcony, and five luxurious staterooms anchored by a supremely private king size Master. An immense bow seating area, rivaled only by the two aft deck lounges, ensures there are always multiple indoor and outdoor settings for effortless entertaining. Very seriously for sale. 
