## OVERVIEW

---

A much-desired four-stateroom arrangement unfolds with an on-deck master suite, a below-deck VIP appointed with a king berth, plus additional queen and twin cabins and a dedicated crew quarters, all arranged for refined comfort and privacy. Refit 2019 brought a fresh interior palette: seating reupholstered, new carpet underfoot, custom window treatments framing the views, upgraded lighting throughout, and renewed soft goods that together restore the yacht's luxurious ambiance.

An expansive flybridge is appointed with a Jacuzzi, a bar, a grill, and space for a waverunner, creating an alfresco haven for relaxation and entertaining. This luxury motor yacht / superyacht is powered by MTU/DDC 16V2000s, supported by Northern Lights gens and Atlas shore power, and fitted with stabilizers and a bow thruster—ideal as a private cruiser or a premium charter vessel.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Accommodations

---

AQUA has been donated to the National Save the Sea Turtle Foundation, and the opportunity available is the assumption of a pre-existing lease with an option to purchase. The lease is non-interest bearing with highly attractive terms, comprising approximately 22 monthly payments remaining at \$12,135.00 per month (\$266,970 total over 22 months) and a balloon payment due on October 20, 2027 in the amount of \$412,525.00, effectively providing interest-free financing for just under one half of the total lease assumption price. Refit in 2019, the yacht benefited from more than \$500K invested prior to donation, with a further \$400K in improvements by the charity and the current lessee; she now stands in excellent condition and is fully ready to cruise. Mechanical and systems highlights include MTU/DDC 16V 2000's, Northern Light gens, an Atlas power system, stabilizers, and a bow thruster. The 2019 refit also introduced new furnishings, carpeting, window treatments, soft goods, electrical updates, running gear attention, A/V equipment, headliners, and LED lighting. Enter the salon through two electric stainless and glass sliding doors from the aft deck to a space of high gloss woods and silk fabrics, an overstuffed free-standing sofa, two chairs, and a fully equipped granite-topped bar with four bar chairs, ice maker, refrigerator, glass and liquor storage; a circular staircase forward of the bar leads to the lower deck. The salon entertainment center presents a 50" TV, DVD player, AM/FM Linn stereo tuner, and generous storage for videos and CD's. Forward to port, the dining area showcases a circular dining table with six dining chairs, marble flooring, and a built-in storage suite for china and cutlery, all set within interior cherry woodwork with maple burl accents crafted by Elegance & Wood. The galley, positioned forward to port for easy and discreet crew service,

features granite countertops and full backsplash, a 4 burner ceramic cooktop, GE Profile oven, microwave/convection oven, waste disposal, Hansgrohe single lever faucet, a full size refrigerator/freezer with ice maker and chilled water dispenser, dishwasher, and trash compactor. The on deck day head gleams with a beautiful metal sink and marble countertops, while faucets and hardware throughout are by Safdenelli Jado and Hansgrohe. The full beam master stateroom forward offers a king size bed with a padded headboard and mirrored accents above; to port sits an L shaped settee and a built in burl wood dresser; the entertainment center integrates a pop up 32" TV, DVD player, VCR, AM/FM tuner, and media storage. A few steps down forward of the bed lead to a dressing area, cedar lined wardrobes with full height beveled mirror doors, and a grand athwartship master head. The his and her configuration includes a two sink vanity with marble countertops and backsplash, with separate enclosed spaces port and starboard—one for the toilet and the other for the shower—laid over exquisite Onyx stone flooring. The pilothouse is accessed starboard on the main deck, with a midships steering station and a comfortable L shaped settee set over classic teak and holly flooring. A full beam VIP—effectively a second master—sits aft on the lower deck, with a king size bed, padded fabric headboard with mirrored panels above, twin bedside nightstands, a settee, and a vanity; its his and her baths include a marble shower stall with marble sink, countertop and flooring, while “Her” bath features a marble tub with marble sink, countertop and flooring. Forward to port, a guest stateroom offers a queen size bed, nightstands, an entertainment center with a 20" TV, and a hanging locker, served by a guest head with a fully equipped shower stall, marble floor, and a single sink with marble countertop and backsplash. To starboard, the twin berth stateroom provides a nightstand, full height closet, entertainment center with a 20" TV, and a head with a marble shower stall, single sink with marble countertop and backsplash, and marble flooring. Forward lies the crew galley/laundry lounge with four berths, a full height

wardrobe, a small settee, a 20" TV/VCR, and a head with shower; the galley/laundry zone includes a sink, refrigerator, washer and dryer with built in ironing board, and an Amtico tiled floor, with a watertight door forward of the settee to a direct access storage compartment with a deep freezing unit. Up on the flybridge, a starboard helm station is flanked by two bench seats, while midships there is a wet bar, new stainless steel BBQ grill, and a dining area with U shaped seating and a hot tub; further aft, a social area provides a sofa, four chairs, and a coffee table with a built in gas fire pit.

## Main salon & dining

---

The full beam main salon and dining area spans almost 600 square feet, showcasing an Evan Marshall designed interior with rich cherry joinery. A comprehensive 2019 refit introduced all new high end fabrics, carpeting, Roman blinds, sconces, custom Savage lighting, and fresh soft goods, while preserving the space's timeless elegance. To starboard, a granite top bar with four high bar chairs anchors the social scene; forward to port, a formal dining area centers on an oversized round glass top table for eight. The entertainment suite features a Samsung 50" HD TV that disappears behind a Tambour door, surround sound stereo, DVD player, stereo tuner, a multi amplifier seeker, and a fully programmable remote system. High gloss cherry joinery flows throughout, complemented by an L shaped upholstered sofa, a large cocktail table, and two upholstered club chairs. The wet bar integrates a U Line icemaker, Master Chef refrigerator, sink, and glass and liquor storage, matched with four high back bar chairs. Technology includes an entertainment center with Samsung 50" TV, a Direct TV receiver, a stereo system, and a Yamaha wireless Bluetooth amplifier, all controlled via iPad. Overhead, padded panel headliners and automatic window shades set the mood alongside ten wall sconces, overhead LED lighting, and integrated stereo

speakers. In the dining zone, a generously scaled round glass top table is surrounded by eight upholstered dining chairs beneath a custom overhead soffit with accent lighting; custom marble flooring with Black Galaxy borders leads to a built in buffet with cabinet storage for china, flatware, and crystal and bespoke wallcoverings, while stairs on the starboard side descend to the lower guest accommodations. Along the starboard companionway, you'll find the on deck day head with a marble sink and vanity top and custom Safdenelli Jado and Hansgrohe faucets and fixtures; stairs rise to the pilothouse; there is storage beneath the pilothouse with a refrigerator and access to electronics; a starboard pantograph door opens to the foredeck; forward is the entrance to the on deck master; marble flooring with a Black Galaxy border and an outboard storage buffet with four doors refine the passage.

## Galley equipment

---

Immediately forward for easy, unobtrusive crew service to the dining area and salon, the fully equipped galley connects to the salon via a sliding glass door and presents granite countertops with a full backsplash, a GE stainless side by side refrigerator/freezer with icemaker, a Samsung stainless steel dishwasher, a Frigidaire four burner glass cooktop, a GE Profile stainless steel oven, and a GE Profile microwave/convection oven. Practical touches include a trash compactor, a double sink with garbage disposal, an exhaust fan, synthetic teak and holly flooring, and digital A/C controls, while a pantograph side door opens to the foredeck and stairs forward lead directly to the crew quarters.

## Pilothouse electronics

---

Accessed from the main deck starboard entry, the raised pilothouse offers a mid ship steering station with excellent forward and lateral visibility and an

L shaped settee that comfortably seats up to six. Navigation and control systems include Garmin 406 x HD Radar; a Simrad Robertson AP20 autopilot; three Garmin 7616 Map GPS/Plotter/Radar displays; an Icom M605 VHF radio; a Garmin VHF 210 radio; Garmin AIS 600; a Quantum 35 hp bow thruster; Sea Rocq stabilizer controls; a Garmin wind speed indicator/direction finder; a Robertson R135 rudder angle indicator; a Maretrom DSM 250 alarm monitor; a Fusion MSVD650 stereo; digital AC control; FCI Watermaker control; MTU Detroit Diesel main engine displays; an ACR search light control; a 6" compass; three windshield wipers; and emergency manual controls.

## Master stateroom, on-deck

---

The on deck master positions its king size bed aft within the suite, oriented forward to a half height electric pop up bulkhead that conceals a 32" plasma TV and the entertainment center. A few steps down to starboard reveal a large mirrored closet, a dressing area, and a grand athwartship master head with separate glass and cherry framed enclosures for both head and shower. Appointments include a centerline king berth with an upholstered padded headboard, custom spread and shams; custom mirrored panels on the bulkhead; two built in burl wood nightstands with three drawers each; two wall sconces; three windows per side, port and starboard; automatic window shades; a custom overhead semi circular soffit with mirrors and accent lighting; a built in burl wood dresser and vanity; an upholstered port settee; and an entertainment center with a Samsung 32" TV on an electric lift and a CD player. Overhead stereo speakers and LED lighting set the tone, while steps forward of the berth lead to the dressing area, cedar lined wardrobes with full height beveled mirror doors, and the master bath. The his and her head features a vanity with marble countertops and backsplash, double sinks, onyx flooring, a fully equipped shower, and mirrored medicine cabinets.

## VIP king stateroom, aft

---

Below deck aft, the full beam VIP stateroom is a serene retreat with a king berth, padded fabric headboard and mirrored panel above, vanity, settee, stereo, and a 27" TV. Detailing includes a king berth with upholstered padded berth and headboard, a custom mirrored bulkhead, two nightstands with cabinet doors, two wall sconces, and an entertainment center with an LG 27" TV. Storage abounds with a burl vanity with six drawers and an upholstered seat and two closets with full length beveled mirror door fronts. Overhead stereo speakers, a custom overhead lighted valance, custom upholstered wallcoverings, and custom Shoji screens with port and starboard portlights elevate the ambiance. The his and her separate bath boasts marble vanities with sinks, a marble shower with glass enclosure, a full tub, custom fixtures, and marble flooring.

## Queen guest stateroom, port

---

This port side guest stateroom features a walk around queen size bed with a padded fabric headboard and mirrored panels above and a fabric padded bed base with concealed storage beneath. Two nightstands with burl veneer tops and three drawers each flank the berth, while the entertainment center includes a Samsung 20" TV. A hanging locker to port, two overhead stereo speakers, overhead LED lighting, and a private bath with a full glass shower, vanity, sink, and marble floor make it thoroughly self contained; an oval portlight with a Shoji screen window treatment completes the setting.

## Twin guest stateroom

---

Thoughtfully designed for versatility, the twin guest stateroom provides twin berths with drawer storage below and custom spread and shams, upholstered

headboards with mirrored panels above, and a nightstand with a burl top, three drawers, and a table lamp. Entertainment is via an Insignia 20" TV, while storage includes a hanging locker with a full length beveled mirror door to starboard. An oval portlight with a Shoji screen brings in daylight, and the private bath features a marble vanity top, a full shower, and a marble floor.

## Crew quarters

---

Purpose built for professional service, the crew area comprises two crew cabins each with a private head, with lower bunk double berths and upper single bunks in each stateroom. The port crew stateroom includes an LG TV, with hanging lockers and drawer storage under the lower berths, while both crew heads offer showers, Corian vanities, and mirrored medicine cabinets. In the crew foyer you'll find a stackable GE washer and dryer, a premium under counter refrigerator, a stainless steel sink with faucet, and a small L shaped settee with a fold out table, plus a forward watertight hatch to a storage area with two under counter refrigerators.

## Flybridge electronics

---

Access to the flybridge is from the pilothouse centerline or via aft deck stairs, where a well sorted helm benefits from Garmin 406 x HD Radar, a Garmin 7612 GPS, a Garmin GPS 7608 chartplotter, a Simrad AP20 autopilot remote, bow thruster controls, a Sea 156 VHF, and an ACR searchlight control.

## Engine & mechanical equipment

---

Engineering is anchored by MTU/DDC 16V 2000s (Port: 6373 Hrs / Stbd: 6355 Hrs), with Koopnautic stabilizers, an Alpha Laval centrifuge, and a Village Marine 1600 GPD watermaker. Climate comfort is delivered by three Marine

Air 4 ton chilled water compressors. Exhaust systems feature DeAngelo marine exhaust strainers, misters, and risers. There is a hydraulic power take off from the port generator, four Delta T fans, a Baldor fire pump, a Baldor bilge pump, and a Grundfos freshwater circulating pump, complemented by a new A/C raw water pump and a fire suppression tank.

## Electrical equipment

---

Power generation and distribution are robust, with two Northern Lights 45KW generators (Port: 17,805 Hrs / Stbd: 15,075 Hrs), two in line 25 KVA polarization line transformers, and dockside electrical cables. Battery resources comprise three 24v DC battery banks with parallel selector switches for mains and gens, plus a separate 24v DC battery bank for ship's DC service. Charging is handled by two Sentry 24v 60 amp chargers and a Sentry 24v 40 amp charger. Emergency lighting provides added assurance.

## Deck equipment

---

The foredeck is outfitted for serious cruising with a Maxwell 3500 vertical electric anchor windlass with foot and remote controls, galvanized BBB 250' chain 5/8", and a Marquipt 2000 lb davit. A Kahlenberg triplex chrome chime horn announces your arrival, while underwater lights add theater at anchor. Safety gear includes life jackets and two life rings and a Coast Guard safety package. Teak caprails with stainless steel bow rails and midship port/starboard boarding gates frame the exterior, complemented by a bow bunny pad and courtesy lighting. There are four bollard cleats on the foredeck, plus a Marquipt seven step boarding ladder.

## Aft deck equipment

---

Aft, stainless steel tinted automatic double glass doors open to the salon from a teak soled cockpit with teak caprails. A built in settee with cushions pairs with four teak chairs around an oversized high gloss teak table for ten on stainless steel bases, while a mounted TCL Roku 24" TV, a canvas awning sunshade over the settee, and a custom lighting system elevate alfresco living. Starboard stairs rise to the flybridge; dual stairways port and starboard lead down to the swim platform, which features teak and stainless hoop guard rails and underwater lights at the transom. Practicalities include access to the engine room, Maxwell 2000 lb warping capstans, a Hikvision camera, a storage locker with a fire suppression system and firehouse, port/starboard bollard cleats, and two rod holders.

## Comments

---

AQUA, a 2000 94' Destiny Raised Pilothouse Motoryacht, has been donated to the National Save the Sea Turtle Foundation and is available via the assumption of an existing 3 year lease with an option to purchase. The lease is non interest bearing with highly desirable terms. A major 2019 refit delivered a complete new interior along with upgraded electronics and A/V equipment. The yacht's sought after four stateroom layout includes an on deck Master, a King VIP below, plus Queen and Twin guest staterooms and well appointed crew spaces. For buyers in the 90'-100' segment, this high quality vessel is a must see and represents the best value, particularly with the on deck king master and the full beam king VIP on the lower deck.

## Flybridge equipment

---

The flybridge is tailored for open air enjoyment with a Bimini top with rigid

canvas and an EZ2CY three sided enclosure. Seating includes two oversized athwartship upholstered bench seats and an aluminum framed three person sofa with four chairs with cushions around an aluminum cocktail table with a center gas fire pit. To starboard, the flybridge helm station is flanked by a wet bar with sink, U Line icemaker, Norcold refrigerator, and a BBQ grill; to port, an L shaped settee pairs with a dining table, complemented by two teak deck folding chairs. Lifting and safety gear include a Marquipt 2000 lb davit, a Jacuzzi hot tub with cushions and a canvas cover, a forward angled radar arch for improved sunbathing and exterior styling, a sliding hatch with tinted glass to the pilothouse, a stainless and plexiglass windscreen, two Revere six person life rafts, an ACR EPIRB, and five Fusion speakers.


