Her expansive exterior decks and plentiful sunbathing areas unfold like terraces to the sea, while a thoughtful arrangement tailored to families and couples, together with a wide assortment of water toys, will enthrall any buyer seeking a luxury motor yacht in this class.

She comfortably sleeps 10 guests in five exquisitely appointed double cabins, making her an exceptional platform for private cruising or a charter vessel to share with friends and family. A spacious full beam owner's suite occupies the main deck, and the contemporary, refined interior is enhanced by oversized windows that flood the living spaces with abundant natural light.

From the bow through to the sun deck, KATARIINA XO offers extensive open air lounging designed for effortless days under the sun. Her cruising profile strikes a graceful balance between privacy and sociable areas, perfectly suited to long passages or short weekend escapes. Presented in immaculate condition, this elegant superyacht and versatile family cruiser stands ready for her next discerning owner.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Specifications

Presented at an asking price of 6.300.000 EURO, VAT paid, this yacht blends Northern European engineering with Mediterranean poise, delivering a specification curated for confident passagemaking and indulgent life on the water. Her accommodation is arranged as five beautifully appointed staterooms for ten guests, offering a serene private realm for family and friends. Propulsion and onboard systems are defined by reliability and effortless control: twin MTU 2,638 hp engines with engine hours of 1,603 and 1,601 as of July 22, 2025, complemented by generators showing 3,841 and 3,846 hours as of the same date, all managed through electronic engine controls and supported by practical 12 V and 220 V distribution throughout. The navigation and communication suite is thoroughly equipped for precise control and situational awareness, built around a SIMRAD autopilot with OP12 control keyboard and an echo stand-alone IS40 at the cockpit control station, with a multidata Simrad IS42 display and an ultrasonic NMEA-AIRMAR weather station; long-range and redundancy are enhanced by a Radar Navnet sensor PG 500, a SIMRAD NAIS400 AIS receiver alongside a dedicated AIS, a radar antenna, and a rudder angle indicator. Communications and auxiliary interfaces include DSC VHF with Fax, GSM Fax, a comprehensive interface module, intercom, a plotter with GPS antenna, and sonar, supported by SSB, a GSM phone, a satellite phone, and a Yacht controller for precision low-speed maneuvering, while an IR remote control signal relay and EPIRB emergency locator with ACR GPS complete the safety-forward electronics. Generous tankage ensures extended autonomy with fuel capacity of 9,000 l and fresh water at 1,320 l, plus an additional 250 L/H watermaker added to the original 180 L/H, allowing high output at anchor or underway. Safety and security are

anchored by engine alarms, bilge alarms, an intrusion alarm, thermovision, a video camera with CCTV external color coverage, and a safe for valuables. On deck every working detail is refined for ease and elegance: a chain counter pairs with anchor and anchor chain, while twin steering, auto dynamic trim interceptors, and an electric engine compartment opening simplify operations; a water pressure pump, life raft, folding cleats, a draining system, a fume/gas detector, and a shorepower connector serve day-to-day reliability, and a tender crane with davits for tender on the fly plus a side boarding ladder make tendering effortless. The purposeful profile is enhanced by a hard top, T-Top cover, canvas wing and special colour, complemented by a bimini and sprayhood, cockpit cover, hull cover, window cover, flybridge cover, instrument cover and seat cover for complete protection in port, while a directional spotlight and an electrically controlled large rectangular searchlight extend command after dark and underwater lights provide a striking night-time signature. Relaxation and hospitality are considered at every turn: cushions and blackout curtains frame a sunbathing deck with back-rest and an electric canopy and sunshade moderate the midday sun while mosquito nets keep breezes fresh, and hospitality touches include a GE fridge without ice dispenser with inverter, washer and dryer as separate units with 5.5 kg capacity, and a bar unit on the fly. Comfort lighting is tuned via a dimmer for fly lights, dimmer lights in cabins, watertight lights for the staircase from the cockpit to fly and lighting in the spoiler stairs; the master bathroom is elevated with a big shower with LED lighting, and personal comfort extends to a queen-size mattress with double spring, an additional towel-rail in the bathroom for each space and an additional shelf for the wardrobe. Systems visibility and control have been modernized with a flap angle indicator on the flybridge, NAVIOP air conditioning control page and NAVIOP page for watermaker management, plus a SIMRAD upgrade featuring two 19-inch monitors and one 17-inch monitor on the main bridge; rubber rugs under generators and a holder under the watermaker reduce vibration and

safeguard equipment. A tow hook for water skiing invites spirited watersports while stern winches and bow winches streamline line handling, and an automatic bilge pump stands ready as silent protection. The audio/visual entertainment experience rivals a private cinema with a 55" television in the main-deck salon, a 55" in the master cabin, a 22" screen in the kitchen and four 48" televisions serving the starboard VIP cabin, port VIP cabin, starboard guests cabin and port guests cabin; immersive sound is delivered through speakers and a home theater with a TV lift mechanism for seamless concealment, complemented by a satellite decoder, satellite receiver, PC and PlayStation, while satellite reception is provided by a KVH TV8 TV SAT antenna with the standard receiver in the saloon, an empty matching dome for KVH TV8 on the roll-bar for symmetry, and a projection screen in the salon for movie nights. Domestic equipment is comprehensive and built to professional standards with an inverter supporting sensitive loads, air conditioning managed via a domotic controller with light dimmers, a waste water plant and interior wooden floor; the galley specification is generous with a garbage disposer, dryer, central vacuum system, burner, deck refrigerator, mechanical refrigerator, icebox, ice maker, coffee machine, electric hot plate, ceramic hot plate and a winecooler, while laundry capability is secured by a washer dryer and Miele Professional dryer and washing machine. Completing the picture, the toys locker is primed for adventure with a Tender Williams 425, a Jet Ski Seadoo RXT 300 RS from 2020 and two Seabob F5 units from 2020, ensuring days on the water are as dynamic as the yacht herself.
