## OVERVIEW

---

A 95-foot motor yacht, built in 2016 and currently poised in Mexico, embodies an enticing blend of speed, refinement and luxurious ease. Molded in GRP/fiberglass and finished inside with the signature Italian elegance of Sanlorenzo, her construction balances artful interior detailing with a seaworthy, confident hull that announces quality the moment you step aboard.

Power is supplied by twin MTU inboard diesels, propelling the yacht to a thrilling 28 knots with a composed 25-knot cruise—fast enough to leap between Baja sanctuaries yet steady and economical for extended passages along the Riviera Maya. A generous 22-foot beam creates exceptional interior volume and stability, while a shallow draft of just over 6 feet grants access to secluded anchorages and crystalline coves across the Sea of Cortez.

Substantial tankage, approximately 3,038 gallons of fuel and 502 gallons of fresh water, provides the autonomy to pursue ambitious itineraries with confidence.

Inside, the atmosphere is at once contemporary and timeless, defined by clean lines, refined materials and a soothing palette that amplifies natural light. Sanlorenzo's hand is evident in every transition, producing a harmonious flow between active social areas and private retreats. Four elegant heads ensure comfort and privacy for owners and guests, and dedicated crew accommodations for two allow discreet, attentive service that keeps daily life aboard effortless.

The deck spaces are thoughtfully arranged for all-day enjoyment, offering generous lounging and dining areas that invite sunlit breakfasts and starlit suppers alike. Ergonomics and layout make the yacht equally suited to intimate family weekends or polished entertaining, with seamless connections between interior salons, open-air terraces and the flybridge to capture Mexico's warm

breezes and sweeping views.

Underway, the boat feels solid and reassuring—true to fine GRP construction—yet lively and responsive when you seek excitement. At anchor she becomes a serene sanctuary, the water glowing beneath and the horizon drawing near, providing a private refuge as elegant as it is peaceful.

A compelling proposition for those after a performance-oriented, design-led 95-footer with international appeal and a distinctly Mediterranean sense of style, perfectly positioned to explore Mexico's most coveted cruising grounds.



# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Exteriors

---

At the stern cockpit, Norwegian curtains fall with tailored precision, a micro-perforated summer cover breathes effortlessly in warmer months, and an electric up/down table transforms the space from open lounge to intimate dining at a touch. Forward, the bow area welcomes you with a bench dressed in deep cushions, inviting unhurried moments under the sun. On the upper bridge, a lateral balcony opens off the salon through a smooth sliding door, dissolving the boundary between interior elegance and the sea beyond. Crowning it all, the flybridge embraces open-air living with a GRP hardtop and teak decking, exterior furniture by Paola Lenti, and a refined Boffi bar cabinet. An inox column shower refreshes after a swim, while an eight-person table and three generous sofas gather guests around a sun-awning enclave layered with cushions—an alfresco salon that feels as sophisticated as it is serene.

## Navigation

---

The wheelhouse places command at your fingertips with two multifunction monitors (plotter, radar, GPS), a touch screen dedicated to onboard utilities, and a full suite of navigation and control instruments: speedometer, depth sounder, anemometer, rudder angle sensor, autopilot, VHF, and the Raymarine Gold Upgrade package. Mirroring this confidence aloft, the flybridge helm features a single multifunction monitor (plotter, radar, GPS), a touch screen for ship systems, and the same essential array—speedometer, depth sounder, anemometer, rudder angle sensor, autopilot, and VHF—ensuring seamless control whether you pilot from within or under open sky.

## Satellite antennas

---

A comprehensive array of antennas ensures clear reception and confident situational awareness, including GPS, radar with Open Array, VHF, and TV.

---

## Household appliances

---

In the galley, culinary ambition meets professional poise: a 90 cm cooktop breathes beneath a powerful extractor hood, paired with a 90 cm oven and a microwave oven, while Gaggenau provides both the refrigerator and freezer; a Zanussi dishwasher streamlines service, and a discreet goods lift carries provisions with quiet efficiency. The main salon keeps conversation flowing with a Frigonautica fridge, a Vitrifrigo icemaker, and a Gaggenau wine cooler. Up on the flybridge, conviviality continues with a Siemens grill, a Vitrifrigo icemaker, and a Frigonautica fridge. For the crew, Miele delivers robust daily reliability with a washing machine and dryer, and throughout the yacht, seamless connectivity is supported by a 4G modem.

---

## Audio video

---

On the main deck, the salon becomes a cinematic retreat with a 48" Samsung LED TV, a multi area amplifier with AirPlay, and a home theatre kit with subwoofer. Two ceiling integrated speakers, linked to the cockpit, flybridge, and bow area, carry ambience throughout, while a 3D Blu ray DVD player and remote place control in your hands. The dining area maintains a refined soundscape with two flush mounted ceiling speakers. In the master cabin, a 48" Samsung LED TV pairs with a home theatre kit and subwoofer, two ceiling integrated speakers, a 3D Blu ray DVD player, and a remote for indulgent private viewing. Below, the starboard and port guest cabins each offer a Hi Fi system with two ceiling integrated speakers and an integrated

DVD player, a 32" Samsung LED TV, and a remote control, while the VIP cabin elevates the experience with a 40" Samsung LED TV and a Hi-Fi system with two ceiling-integrated speakers and an integrated DVD player, complete with remote. Outdoors, the flybridge helm conceals a 40" Samsung LED TV within the pilot cabinet and features two ceiling-integrated speakers connected to the salon, a configuration echoed in the cockpit for a cohesive, yacht-wide audio presence.

## Interiors main deck

---

In the living area, materials speak in a quiet, confident palette: stained grey oak flooring with anti-slip treatment underfoot; a lacquered wood ceiling traced by a central stripe in Nuvola Canapa leather; and window surrounds clad in the same supple Nuvola Canapa. The forward wall, also in Nuvola Canapa leather with satin metallic inserts, reflects a subtle glamour against a fumè mirror to starboard, while grey oak storage cabinets balance the port side. Grey satin oak bulkhead storage with metallic accents and a Nuvola Canapa leather vanity desk complete the composition. Furnishings strike a poised equilibrium: an L-shaped light grey sofa, a bold red leather armchair, and a Minotti smoking table, anchored by a grey marble dining table encircled by ten Nuvola Canapa leather chairs, with manual drapes refining light and privacy. The daily toilet is finished in Calacatta marble for both floor and sink top, with oak door, vanity, and walls beneath gloss-lacquered ceilings. In the galley, Allura vinyl flooring and lacquered ceilings offset natural satin oak bulkheads; a black gloss granite worktop sets a professional tone, complemented by a table with an oak expandable top and an inox base, two stools, an oak sofa with Nuvola leather cushions, and extra insulation between the galley and master cabin for hushed comfort. The master cabin continues the narrative in moquette underfoot and lacquered ceilings articulated by a central panel in Nuvola Canapa leather. Stained grey satin oak bulkheads feature a mirror TV cover,

while window frames return to the signature Nuvola Canapa leather. Furniture includes a stained grey oak forward cabinet, a fumè mirror with metal framed door, and grey satin oak ship's side cabinetry with satin metallic inserts. A Nuvola Canapa leather vanity desk, bed, and nightstand are complemented by a Minotti bench with Nuvola Canapa leather top and a black nickel base. The ensuite bathroom elevates the experience with Calacatta marble in a gloss finish across floor, shower, and sink top, gloss lacquered wood ceilings and bulkheads, and a grey oak sink cabinet.

## Interiors lower deck

---

The VIP cabin rests in quiet luxury with moquette flooring, lacquered wood ceilings, and a feature panel over the bed in Nuvola Canapa leather. Grey oak bulkheads frame the space, including a grey satin oak TV bulkhead, while furnishings include a Nuvola Canapa leather Pullman bed, a grey oak bulkhead cabinet, and a Minotti bench in Nuvola Canapa, plus a safe for complete peace of mind. The ensuite bathroom continues in gloss Calacatta marble underfoot, with gloss lacquered wood across ceilings, shower, and bulkheads, and a satin grey oak sink cabinet. Guest cabins echo the refined materiality with moquette flooring, lacquered wood ceilings and an over bed panel in Nuvola Canapa leather, grey oak bulkheads, and a grey satin oak TV bulkhead. Furniture comprises two Nuvola Canapa leather single sliding beds, with an additional Pullman bed in the port side cabin for adaptable accommodation. In the crew area, practicality is beautifully resolved with moquette flooring, gloss lacquered ceilings, and natural oak bulkheads and furniture; in the bathroom, gloss lacquered finishes extend across ceiling, floor, and shower, complemented by a painted teak shower floor for warm tactility and lasting durability.
