DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Introduction

Cruise the Mediterranean this summer with family and friends aboard “Olivia RB,” then seamlessly ship her stateside when the season turns—there is even a potential fifty/fifty partnership available. “Olivia RB” is hull two of the highly acclaimed Pearl 95 Series, making a striking debut at the 2020 Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show with Pearl Yachts USA where she met her current and only owner. Since the Pearl 95’s launch in 2018 the model has earned industry-wide recognition, collecting awards for Best Interior Design, Best Main Salon, and Best Layout in her class. Configured in the sought-after four-cabin layout with an on-deck master, “Olivia RB” pairs desirability with long-range versatility; her CATERPILLAR C32 engines and shallow draft unlock access to the world’s most beautiful ports, an ASEA converter guarantees shore-power compatibility worldwide, and underway a Seakeeper Gyro calms the sea, keeping the yacht level and guests comfortable as they enjoy the serene, luxurious interior conceived by Kelly Hoppen.

Interior

Kelly Hoppen’s signature interior design scheme defines every space aboard, her curated accessories completing a harmonious, contemporary aesthetic that feels both warm and refined. The yacht offers four guest cabins, including a magnificent on-deck master suite and three additional guest suites; the port and starboard cabins are fitted with single beds on a sliding mechanism that allow flexible sleeping arrangements. A custom bathtub graces the master en suite, elevating daily rituals to spa-like indulgence, while the salon is finished with Amtico wood-effect flooring that complements the muted palette and tactile surfaces. Dometic venetian electric blinds provide effortless privacy and

light control in all guest cabins, excluding crew quarters, and heated towel rails together with dedicated air-conditioning vents in every head ensure comfort and convenience throughout.

Electrical

An ASEA 45 kVA shore-power converter delivers true global connectivity, ensuring seamless compatibility with international electrical systems, while Aventics three-station joystick controls bring fingertip precision to close-quarters handling. A Glendenning 24 V shore-power Cablemaster and a 100 A primary dockside shore-power cable streamline plug-in simplicity, and a central vacuum system attends to housekeeping with quiet efficiency. When presence and authority are required, a commanding Kahlenberg D-330 air horn ensures you are heard.

Engineering

Power resilience is provided by two Kohler 40 kW 60 Hz paralleling generators, showing 2478 and 3056 hours as of August 2025, backed by a Seafire NFD1600M engine-room fire system for peace of mind. A Seakeeper SK35 Gyro with touch control steadies the ride and greatly reduces roll, while a tropical reverse-cycle A/C system with Smart Start keeps onboard climates perfectly tuned. Maintenance is simplified by a Reverso oil changer for engines and generators, and for autonomy at sea a Sea Recovery XL2200 watermaker produces 250 liters per hour; dehumidifiers in all cabins preserve fabrics and finishes in every season.

Hydraulics

A teak-laid hydraulic bathing platform forms a private waterside terrace,

complemented by teak-laid hydraulic drop-down sides to port and starboard that expand living space at anchor and create a seamless connection with the sea. The hydraulic garage door opens to reveal tender stowage with ease, while an Opacmare hydraulic passerelle streamlines boarding for guests. For confident handling at the dock there are two Lewmar hydraulic capstan winches and two Lewmar hydraulic anchor winches, with Side Power hydraulic bow and stern thrusters delivering authoritative control for precise manoeuvring.

Navigation

The helm benefits from two Furuno multi-station displays with AIS, supported by Furuno radar, a Furuno GPS receiver, and a Furuno autopilot for seamless passage-making; a Furuno color instrument display and Furuno AIRMAR transducer enrich situational awareness, while a SanDisk 64 GB Ultra microSDXC provides reliable chart and data storage. Precision navigation is further enhanced by Furuno fluxgate and rate heading sensors and two Ritchie compasses for steadfast bearing reference.

AV equipment

Entertainment throughout is orchestrated by a Crestron audio system, intuitively controlled via touch pad to deliver seamless mood and volume control across decks. On deck, a 55-inch outdoor waterproof TV graces the flybridge for al fresco viewing, while a 65-inch TV anchors cinematic evenings in the salon, and additional TVs are thoughtfully installed in each stateroom; Crestron speakers are integrated throughout to deliver immersive sound that complements conversation, dining and relaxation.

Appliances

Gourmet capability is assured with a Liebherr wine cooler, a Miele oven, and a Miele microwave, complemented by two Miele warming drawers to keep service impeccable. Cold storage is ample with a Gaggenau refrigerator, a Vitrifrigo drawer fridge, and a Vitrifrigo drawer freezer, while a Miele dishwasher attends to cleanup and a sleek Bora glass-ceramic induction cooktop makes cooking effortless. For extended cruising a Miele washing machine and a Miele tumble dryer are conveniently aboard. On the flybridge, entertaining is effortless with a Vitrifrigo icemaker, a Kenyon electric grill, a Webasto drinks drawer fridge, a Webasto icemaker, and a sink with hot and cold water; in the cockpit a Webasto drawer fridge, a Webasto icemaker, and a hot and cold sink complete the alfresco service suite.

Deck

Life on deck is richly appointed, beginning at the foredeck with a generous sunbathing area and upholstered seating, complemented by a fold-out teak table for relaxed aperitifs and social moments. Aft, the cockpit offers welcoming seating, while the flybridge features abundant seating with stowage below and a forward sunbathing area, and at the upper helm two Besenzoni seats stand ready, matched by a Besenzoni seat in the raised pilothouse. Practical touches include an anchor chain locker and a transom swim shower for post-dip refreshment. Teak craftsmanship is everywhere: a teak deck fitted to the cockpit, transom, and bathing platform, teak decking on the side decks and forepeak, and full teak decking on the flybridge. Leisure highlights abound, from a hot tub on the flybridge to a hard top with electric sunroof and an aft awning, plus a Bedouin-style foredeck canopy for shade at anchor, and a garage wet bar with sink and fridge keeps refreshments close at hand while beautifully finished teak tables dress the flybridge, cockpit, and foredeck.

Standard features

Signature Pearl hallmarks abound: a full-beam owner's cabin on the main deck with a sweeping panoramic view; a versatile beach club/garage with fold-down buttresses; and a foredeck lounge that marries seating with a sunbathing area. A hydraulically operated bathing platform and opening patio doors to the side decks blur the line between inside and out, while a hydraulic passerelle and an electrically operated patio door simplify every embarkation. Reverse-cycle air conditioning maintains perfect onboard climates, a Glendinning cable master streamlines shore-power management, and a glass bridge integrates navigation and vessel control systems into a single, elegant command center.

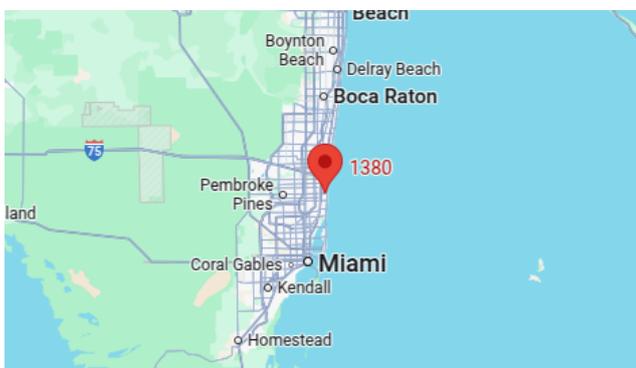
