OVERVIEW

A 95-foot expression of elegance and capability, this 2007 Horizon-designed motor yacht blends a timeless silhouette with intelligent engineering. Her 21-foot beam and a deep, ocean-going draft confer a resolute superyacht presence—sleek in profile, purposeful in stance, and harmoniously balanced for long bluewater passages as well as refined coastal cruising.

Built on a sturdy composite fiberglass monohull with matching fiberglass decks, the platform is both solid and quietly efficient. Horizon's design lineage is visible in every proportion and sweep, creating a vessel that feels composed offshore and assured in tight quarters. Propulsion comes from twin CAT diesel engines, delivering a spirited 22-knot top end and a comfortable 16-knot cruising pace, while a 3,600-gallon fuel capacity gives the range to pursue extended itineraries. Practical systems support autonomy at sea, including a 400-gallon freshwater reserve and integrated systems that make operation intuitive for owner or crew.

Interior spaces are refined and inviting, the result of Horizon's interior specialists crafting an elegant canvas for life aboard. Expansive living areas encourage relaxed conversation and effortless entertaining, where abundant natural light, rich textures, and precise joinery establish a calm, contemporary ambiance. The seamless flow between interior salons and open deck spaces fosters alfresco dining, sunset cocktails, and leisurely mornings at anchor. Whether hosting family escapes or sophisticated gatherings, the yacht's scale and thoughtful layout provide privacy, comfort, and flexibility without compromise.

On deck, broad side passages and uncluttered sightlines promote confident handling, while the substantial hull volume translates into generous storage and provisioning capacity for longer voyages. Engineering spaces are organized for straightforward service access, reflecting a build philosophy that unites

luxury with longevity. Every detail has been considered to elevate the onboard experience—quiet power, poised handling, and an enduring sense of occasion. Located in the United States and maintained with care, this 2007 Horizon creation represents a rare offering in the 95-foot class: a true Luxury Yacht in every sense, a Superyacht in stature, and a capable Motor Yacht for long-range, bluewater cruising. For those who prize fiberglass craftsmanship, monohull efficiency, and CAT-powered reliability wrapped in an ageless Horizon aesthetic, she embodies an ideal synthesis of performance, pedigree, and grace.
