OVERVIEW

On view at the Palm Beach International Boat Show, March 25–29, Dock, Slip 103 at Palm Harbor Marina.

The Princess X95 represents the apex of the Princess Yachts collection, a sumptuous motor yacht whose signature Super Flybridge extends nearly the full length of the hull. This innovative layout dramatically enlarges both indoor and outdoor living spaces, imparting the scale and presence of a tri-deck flybridge yacht while retaining the elegance of a single, sweeping profile. Stepping aboard, light fills a generous saloon that flows without interruption into an enclosed skylounge, framing panoramic vistas and creating a peaceful, year-round haven for cruising. Outside, expansive deck areas are artfully arranged for alfresco dining, lively entertaining, sunbathing, and tranquil moments at the waterline—always unhurried, unfailingly refined.

The interior mood is airy, luminous, and voluminous, producing immediately the feeling of a much larger superyacht. SPLASH offers a genuine “buy and go” proposition—carefully maintained with an open checkbook—so you can be underway without delay. A \$700,000 price improvement highlights the compelling value. Accommodation is considered and luxurious, with two lavish owner’s suites—one situated on the main deck and a second aft on the lower deck—perfect for family or distinguished guests. Performance is poised and sure, with an 18–20 knot cruise complemented by Zero Speed fins that deliver exceptional steadiness at anchor. Entertaining is effortless thanks to wet bars on both the main and upper decks, while the skylounge atop the super flybridge provides elevated sightlines and climate-controlled comfort. A transformer boarding system on the aft deck—a \$350,000 enhancement—streamlines access to the water and the beach club, which is fitted with a seating area, table, refrigerator, TV, and ice maker for seamless waterside living. The galley is equipped with full-size Sub-Zero refrigeration

and freezer, a Dometic chiller system preserves cool serenity throughout, and hardwood floors sweep the main deck for a warm, contemporary finish. Forward, a bow deck Jacuzzi sheltered by shade poles and awnings creates an intimate private retreat, and a Williams SportJet 435 tender is included with the sale for immediate exploration. This flybridge motor yacht marries long range comfort with superyacht demeanor, bridging bluewater capability and family friendly cruising with effortless grace. Trades are welcomed and financing is available.









































DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

On display at the Palm Beach International Boat Show from March 25 to 29 on Dock at Palm Harbor Marina, SPLASH is an exceptional Princess X95—one of the marque’s flagships—defined by the Super Flybridge concept that carries the flybridge and main deck nearly the full length of the hull, unlocking expansive interior volumes and sweeping outdoor terraces far beyond the norm for this size class. Step aboard and the sense of space is immediate: a bright, gracefully proportioned saloon welcomes natural light, while the enclosed skylounge becomes a panoramic private retreat, delivering serene comfort in any weather. Generous exterior decks invite alfresco dining, effortless entertaining, sun-drenched lounging, and unhurried moments at the water’s edge without ever feeling confined. The atmosphere throughout is open, luminous, and airy—SPLASH simply feels like a much larger yacht the moment you enter. Meticulously maintained with no expense spared, she is the quintessential “buy and go” opportunity, ready to enjoy immediately. A dramatic \$700,000 price improvement underscores the offering. Notable highlights include two master staterooms strategically positioned on the main deck and lower deck aft, a comprehensive two-year bumper to bumper extended MAN warranty, an effortless 18–20 knot cruise, and wet bars thoughtfully placed on both the main and upper decks. Comfort underway and at anchor is assured by zero speed fins and the haven of a skylounge, while an electro hydraulic transformer on the aft deck—specified as a \$350,000 upgrade—elevates beach club living. Climate is precisely managed by a Dometic chiller system; the galley is fitted with full size Sub Zero refrigeration and freezer; and the main deck is finished in timeless hardwood flooring. Forward, a bow deck Jacuzzi with sunshade poles and awnings creates a

private spa like escape. A Williams SportJet 435 tender conveys with the sale, and the beach club completes the lifestyle with a seating area, table, refrigerator, TV, and ice maker. Trades are welcomed, and financing is available.

Power & performance

Propelled by twin MAN V12 2000 engines delivering 2000 mhp each, SPLASH combines effortless thrust with long legged composure. Power management is underpinned by two 55 kW Onan generators showing 964 and 985 hours respectively, while intuitive close quarters control comes via dual station Aventics joystick integration for engines and bow thruster. An onboard oil change system services both main engines and the generator plant, streamlining maintenance for uninterrupted cruising.

Hydraulics

A robust, cross connected hydraulic architecture driven by dual engine mounted pumps powers critical systems with seamless redundancy. The bow thruster and windlass are hydraulic for relentless torque and durability, complemented by a variable speed hydraulic stern thruster rated at 420 kgf, specified here in an upgraded configuration for authoritative low speed maneuvering.

Exterior & hull

The upper deck canopy and hardtop are finished in a sophisticated graphite grey, set on platinum metallic support legs and complemented by exterior furniture in an oyster grey metallic hue. A pure white hull draws a fine dark grey waterline and rides above deep black antifouling for a timeless,

purposeful stance at sea.

Interior finish

Inside, gloss walnut cabinetry sets a warm, contemporary tone, grounded by V groove planked walnut flooring through the galley, dining area, and helm for tactile continuity. An inlaid rug defines the aft salon conversation zone, softening acoustics and framing the space with understated luxury.

Layouts

The standard arrangement delivers four staterooms—an aft master, a forward VIP, and two twin cabins—each with its own en suite, balancing family living and guest privacy. An optional five stateroom plan elevates long range versatility with a main deck master, an enclosed galley, and formal dining for ten. Living spaces may be tailored further with an L shaped salon sofa and armchairs, convertible twin to double guest cabins on powered sliders, and a skylounge day head complete with basin, bidet, and ample storage.

Entertaining gains another dimension with an optional salon bar including fridge, icemaker, and sink, while the wheelhouse benefits from an additional navigation helm seat. A beach club option with revised crew layout brings waterside relaxation within easy reach, and acoustic insulation upgrades for the master and engine room refine onboard serenity.

Modified features

Thoughtful refinements elevate daily life aboard, including the Y85 dining table upgrade for a grander hosting experience, an updated flybridge hatch with a Y85 style catch for a cleaner, more secure closure, and additional power outlets strategically added on the flybridge and in the engine room for

practical flexibility.

Galley & baths

The galley work surfaces are clad in Misty Carrera quartz for durable elegance, while the bathrooms are finished with Mystery White marble across floors and bulkheads, enveloping each en suite in a calm, contemporary glow.

Color scheme

A premium interior palette is curated with designer scatter cushions to layer texture and tone, harmonizing the yacht's architectural lines with a refined residential warmth.

Deck & exterior hardware

Every outdoor moment is elevated by full teak decking from bow to flybridge, while an electro hydraulic transformer platform with a 1000 kg SWL becomes the ultimate beach club stage. The foredeck features a spa bath in place of a sunpad, and boarding ease is enhanced by additional side entry gates to port and starboard. Entertaining spaces abound: a cockpit bar with fridge, icemaker, sink, and smart storage; stainless steel keyway plates with tender sliders; and dedicated kedge anchors for versatile mooring. The flybridge serves as a culinary and command terrace with a bar featuring BBQ, hob, fridge, sink, and waste bin, a starboard cool box and icemaker, starboard wing station controls, and an electric aft awning in Anthracite Grey fabric. A carbon pole transom shower with its own socket refreshes waterside rituals, and a GRP storage box to port on the flybridge keeps deck life impeccably organized.

Generators

Electrical self-sufficiency is bolstered by an upgrade to two Onan 55 kW, 60 Hz generators in place of the standard 40 kW units, providing abundant, quiet power for hotel loads and climate control.

Electrical & lighting

Dockside connectivity is refined by twin Glendinning Cablemasters paired with Hubbell shore cables, while an AGM 90 Ah battery upgrade deepens the yacht's power reserve. Lifestyle comforts include a salon wine cooler and a top-loading coolbox on the foredeck, and safety presence is amplified by upgraded air horns and two anchor-pocket cameras. Evenings glow with underwater lighting—four Lumishore THX 803 color fixtures across the transom and eight Lumishore TIX 803 color units along the hull sides—managed from a Lumishore STV2240i cockpit controller. Indulgences extend inside with underfloor heating in the master bathroom and three heated towel bars, while exterior lighting upgrades for the cockpit, side decks, and bow/foredeck, together with fiber-optic interior enhancements in the salons, set a sophisticated ambiance after dark.

Audio/video & communications

Immersive sound is delivered by Naim Uniti series audio throughout with Bluetooth and streaming capability, paired to a suite of smart TVs: 65-inch screens in the salon and master, 55-inch sets in the skylounge and lower master, a 43-inch forward, 42-inch displays in the cockpit and on the flybridge, a 32-inch in the crew area, and 24-inch screens for guest cabins. Entertainment and work onboard are supported by a hard-wired Ethernet network with Wi-Fi coverage and an internal PBX phone system with handsets

distributed throughout.

Navigation

At the helm, the standard Raymarine suite anchors situational awareness with an Axiom XL19 display, Magnum radar, and autopilot. A comprehensive Garmin upgrade layers professional grade capability with three GPSMAP 8617 multifunction displays, a Fantom 126 radar, GHC20 autopilot, GMI20 instruments, VHF 315 radio, AIS 800, a sonar module, and a B744 triducer. Chase tubes are in place for future SAT TV integration, ensuring the yacht remains adaptable to evolving technology.

Exterior upholstery & covers

Exterior comfort is tailored with premium Comfort Exterior III materials in Met, Vogue, or Hitch finishes, while the cockpit is protected in all seasons by tailored Sunbrella covers specified in either refined grey or classic navy.

Accessories & spares

Delivered with the yacht is a curated eight place set of china, cutlery, and glassware—expanded to ten places with the five stateroom layout—together with spare anodes for the stern thruster and stabilizers, a full complement of bed linens (excluding crew), and a water delivery kit to simplify dockside provisioning.

Net options

Stability and poise are elevated by a Sleipner hydraulic package with SPS93/VF1950 fin stabilizers delivering both zero speed and underway damping. Further Garmin enhancements include a Fantom 54 radar, Gwind 2

wind instrumentation, GXM 53 SAT weather, and an additional VHF, while the beach club gains extra Boening and Garmin MFDs for systems insight at the waterline. The yacht is prepped for a flybridge crane, with VHF antennas painted for a seamless profile, and practicalities include a washer/dryer with soundproofing forward of the day head. Visual indulgence continues with 65 inch TVs in the skylounge and lower master, and the forward stateroom is pre-wired for a screen up to 55 inches.

Additions upon arrival (Florida)

Upon her Florida arrival, SPLASH received a suite of intelligent enhancements: ElectroSea CL 2000 Clearline for proactive seawater system protection; Yacht Safe Air Purification across eight zones for cleaner onboard air; and a KVH HD7 SAT TV system with a matched dummy dome and ten receivers for fleet level entertainment. Control and integration are orchestrated by a URC Total Control ecosystem with ten remotes and a remote access mini PC, supported by a Wi-Fi repeater and cellular modem for resilient connectivity. Water quality and finish protection benefit from a Spot Zero XZII 1800/2000, high gloss table refinements, and Seahawk Biocop bottom paint, while V-Kool window film and Prop Speed on props and shafts optimize comfort and efficiency. Practical upgrades include fabricated and installed shelving, toolboxes, and a refined bow chain locker arrangement to keep every voyage organized.


