OVERVIEW

Launched by Monte Carlo Yachts in 2018, M/Y ESMERALDA OF THE SEAS masterfully combines exceptional performance with modern aesthetics crafted by Nuvolari Lenard. The interiors are designed to be both inviting and luminous, while the exteriors offer a variety of seating, dining, and sunbathing options.

The welcoming aft section is perfect for outdoor dining or unwinding, featuring a cozy seating setup. The main deck is home to a generous saloon and dining area, all styled with sophistication. M/Y ESMERALDA OF THE SEAS provides impressive space across three levels. It accommodates up to 10 guests in 5 beautifully appointed staterooms, including a Master suite on the main deck and 4 staterooms on the lower deck. The twin cabins can be converted into doubles, with one twin cabin offering an extra Pullman bed.

The sundeck offers an extraordinary experience, complete with dining areas, lounging spaces, and a lavish Jacuzzi.

Driven by twin MTU 16V M86 engines, each producing 2200hp, along with 2 x Kohler 45kW generators, she cruises smoothly at 20 knots and can achieve a maximum speed of 24 knots, with a range of 1800 nautical miles. M/Y ESMERALDA OF THE SEAS is commercially registered under 24m and holds RINA classification. This yacht for sale is fitted with stabilizers for a comfortable journey both in motion and at rest, making it an outstanding option for those interested in purchasing a yacht in the current boat location. DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Tender & toys

The selection of tenders and toys on the yacht is open to modification and discussion throughout the purchasing process, allowing for customization to meet your desires. Central to this assortment is the Williams Jet 445, featuring a robust 110HP engine, seamlessly paired with a hydraulic swim platform that can handle up to 1600Kg. For enthusiasts of underwater adventures, the yacht comes with two Seabobs FS5, offering thrilling underwater experiences. In addition, there are three paddle boards, perfect for gentle paddling on serene waters. For those seeking more excitement, a kayak and a wakeboard are included, providing a wide array of activities to enhance your enjoyment on the water.

Mechanical equipment

The yacht boasts a remarkable selection of mechanical systems crafted to boost both performance and comfort. Leading the way are the hydraulic bow and stern thrusters, each providing 40HP via the dependable Sidepower SH550 system, allowing for precise navigation. Stability is ensured at all speeds with

the CMC Electric fins SE80 - SE120 stabilizers. The electric trim system is specifically designed for high-speed yachts, enhancing both performance and efficiency. Made from AISI 316 steel, the rudder is both strong and durable. The Alfa Laval MIB 303 oil-water separator and the HAMANN HL-CONT 0125 sewage treatment system, with a 450-liter capacity, comply with IMO standards, ensuring eco-friendliness. The Tecma electric flushing system and the Alfa Laval MIB 303 fuel treatment system, which can handle 760 liters per hour, further improve operational efficiency. Comfort is guaranteed with the tropical option reverse cycle air conditioning from Climma, installed in 2021, and a Searecovery water maker that produces 280 liters per hour. Hot water is supplied by QUICK boilers, featuring two 80-liter units and one 160-liter unit. The CLIMMA CWS DC130 air compressor supports various onboard operations, while six 24V automatic bilge pumps and a comprehensive bilge alarm system with level and sound indicators, plus a repeater, ensure safety and tranquility.

Electrical equipment

The yacht's electrical systems are crafted to deliver strong and adaptable power management, ensuring smooth functionality in diverse regions. At the core of this setup is the ASEA electrical configuration, which accommodates both 110V and 220V at 50/60Hz, making it compatible with various power standards. Shore power is managed through two 125A cables, providing a dependable connection while docked. The battery array is extensive, comprising two 225Amp 12V batteries, fifteen 160Amp 12V batteries, and four 130Amp 12V batteries, all recently upgraded in 2021 and 2022. Charging requirements are addressed by a selection of chargers, including two 24V 80Amp units, four 24V 30Amp units, and a 12V 35Amp charger. The yacht is fitted with inverters that can handle both 110V and 220V, offering flexibility in power conversion. Furthermore, an ASEA transformer is part of the system, designed to meet both US and EU standards, with a capacity of 75Kw. It can

manage input ranges from 170-520V AC at 40-75Hz or 230/400V at 50Hz, ensuring the yacht is fully equipped for international travel.

Communication & navigation equipment

The yacht is equipped with an extensive array of communication and navigation tools, guaranteeing safety and accuracy throughout your journeys. Central to its navigation prowess is the Raymarine electronic plotter, a key component of the ECDIS system, offering precise chart plotting. The Raymarine AIS 650 boosts situational awareness by monitoring nearby vessels. For automated steering, the Raymarine P70R autopilot, paired with a Raymarine gyro compass, ensures precise course maintenance. The Ritchie F-83 magnetic compass acts as a dependable backup. Raymarine radar systems deliver crucial navigation data in various conditions, while the 15-inch Raymarine GS165 dual screens provide clear and detailed display options. The JRC NCR-333 Navtex system keeps the crew updated on weather and navigational alerts. Depth and echo readings are handled by the Raymarine DST800 Depth sounder and echo sounder, respectively. The Bioning AHD 1119GS 19-inch control panel centralizes system operations, and the Raymarine anemometer supplies wind speed and direction information. Communication is supported by the Furuno FM-8900S VHF radio, while safety is bolstered by the RIKS 701 SART and the GMDSS Cat1 MT403FF-e999J EPIRB. For satellite communication, the yacht features the Furuno Felcom18 SAT-C system, ensuring connectivity even in isolated locations.

Entertainment equipment

The yacht's entertainment amenities are crafted to deliver an opulent and connected experience for everyone on board. At the heart of the entertainment suite is the Sat KVH TV8, which provides access to a broad

selection of satellite TV channels. The Boning control system allows for effortless management of the yacht's diverse entertainment options. For security and assurance, a thorough CCTV system is installed, featuring two cameras in the engine room, one in the control room, one at the aft cockpit, and another on the swimming platform, ensuring comprehensive monitoring of crucial areas. Connectivity is boosted with Digital Yacht 4G and 5G antennas, guaranteeing dependable internet access while cruising. The sound system, driven by Sonos, offers premium audio quality throughout the yacht, creating an engaging auditory environment. Furthermore, an Asus Vivo 14-inch computer is on hand, providing flexible computing power for both professional and recreational use.

Domestic appliances, equipment & laundry

The yacht is outfitted with a selection of domestic appliances and equipment crafted to deliver exceptional comfort and convenience. In the galley, you'll discover a Miele K37473 ID refrigerator with a 300-liter capacity and a Miele FNS37402I freezer providing 200 liters of storage space. Culinary tasks are effortlessly managed with a SHARP R200BKW microwave at 800W, a Miele Jubilee SC dishwasher, and a Miele KWT6321UG wine cooler. The Miele H6290B oven and the Miele KM 6340 induction hob, measuring 76cm by 50cm and operating at 7.4Kw with 230V 50-60Hz, ensure a flawless cooking experience. For refreshments, there are two Vitrifrigo ice makers and two Nespresso Delonghi coffee machines.

In the laundry section, the yacht is equipped with a Miele WMH122 WPS washing machine with a 9Kg capacity and a corresponding dryer, ensuring all laundry needs are efficiently addressed.

The yacht's accommodation is both luxurious and adaptable. It features a master stateroom on the main deck, two double VIP staterooms, and two twin staterooms that can be converted into double beds, offering flexible sleeping

options. Additionally, a pullman bed is available, providing ample space for guests.

Deck equipment

The yacht's deck equipment is thoughtfully crafted to blend functionality with sophistication. It includes two sturdy 136Kg PTW steel anchors made from Duplex, accompanied by anchor chains that are 150 meters long and 14mm thick, ensuring reliable mooring. The anchoring system is driven by two electric windlasses, each with a 3Kw capacity and running on 400V AC, from the trusted Maxwell 4500 series. This setup is complemented by two electric winches, also from the Maxwell 4500 series, with a 3Kw capacity and operating on 24V, facilitating smooth handling of lines and sails. The Opacmare passerelle, capable of supporting 150kg, provides convenient access to and from the yacht.

Regarding external finishing, the yacht presents a captivating look with a white gelcoat superstructure and a pearl white hull, which was repainted in 2021 at Monte Carlo Yachts. The visual appeal is further enhanced by grey domes and side mast supports, along with a grey carbon fiber hard top featuring a retractable opening, merging contemporary design with practical utility.

Safety & security

The yacht is outfitted with an extensive suite of safety and security measures to guarantee the protection of everyone on board. It features three DeepSea SOLAS B liferafts, each designed to hold 10 individuals, offering substantial capacity for emergencies. A plentiful supply of lifejackets is available, with 24 SOLAS adult jackets and 4 SOLAS children's jackets, ensuring safety for guests of all ages. Additionally, the yacht is equipped with four liferings for extra flotation support.

For signaling and emergency communication, the yacht is stocked with a range of flares, including four parachute flares, four red handheld flares, and two orange smoke signals, ensuring visibility in emergency situations. Fire safety is paramount, with a fixed FM200 fire extinguisher system in the engine room, complete with alarms and automatic shutdown features. Furthermore, there are 18 handheld 1Kg powder extinguishers, one 9L foam extinguisher, and three 4.5Kg powder extinguishers strategically distributed throughout the yacht.

A fire blanket is situated in the galley, and the yacht is equipped with Gianneschi fire pumps capable of delivering 150 liters per minute. Smoke detectors are installed in every area, and a heat detector is specifically placed in the galley to provide early alerts of potential fire risks. A fire damper is also installed in the garage to enhance fire safety protocols. These features collectively ensure a high standard of safety and security for all passengers and crew.

Refit log

The yacht has been through a series of detailed refurbishments to keep it in top-notch condition. In 2021, the hull was repainted by Monte Carlo, boosting its visual appeal and shielding it from environmental wear. That same year, the superstructure was polished, bringing back its luster and sophistication. Routine maintenance is a key focus, with the MTU engines and generator receiving yearly check-ups to maintain peak performance. In 2021, the water cut bearings were replaced, and the packing glands were updated, ensuring the yacht runs smoothly. A new electric motor was fitted for the windlass, improving its dependability. Furthermore, the shaft and propellers underwent a comprehensive inspection, as did the stabilizers, confirming that all parts are in excellent condition. These refurbishments and checks demonstrate a dedication to upholding the yacht's high standards and guaranteeing a secure

and pleasurable experience for everyone on board.


