Step aboard a superbly maintained Ferretti Custom Line 97, a Maltese-flagged, superyacht-class flybridge motor yacht that marries graceful styling with serious seagoing capability. At 29.70 m overall, this planing luxury cruiser is propelled by twin MTU engines, each developing 2,200 hp, and benefits from dedicated 2024 servicing carried out by authorized MTU technicians. Comfort is a priority: zero-speed stabilizers and four Mitsubishi Anti Rolling Gyro systems installed in the engine room ensure exceptionally smooth motion both underway and at anchor.

Privately used and fastidiously cared for by a permanent crew from day one, the yacht presents in impeccable condition with light family use. An onboard engineer and full-time crew keep every auxiliary and technical system meticulously maintained and fully operational, supporting effortless, five-star service at sea. The inventory is comprehensive, including a tender, a selection of water toys and an extensive list of extras to enhance cruising days.

Outdoor living is conceived for conviviality: an expansive flybridge with a wet bar, generous sunpads and a large fold-down swim platform create a true beach-club atmosphere. Accommodation is versatile and luxurious, comprising five ensuite cabins arranged as three doubles and two twin cabins with Pullman berths, delivering flexible, elegant guest arrangements.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Electrical equipment

Engineered for serene cruising and confident control, the yacht's electrical suite blends quiet power and redundancy to keep every voyage pleasurable and secure. Four Mitsubishi ARG gyro stabilisers dramatically quell roll even in confused seas, while tropical air conditioning delivers a powerful 160,000 BTU climate envelope throughout living and guest areas. An Idromar watermaker produces 220 ltr/hr, granting extended autonomy for long passages, and precise low—speed manoeuvring is assured by bow and stern thrusters. Power resilience is provided by a pair of ONAN generators, the portside unit rated at 40 KWA with 8,756 hours and the starboard unit rated at 40 KWA with 8,620 hours, all supported by six engine batteries and six service batteries to keep every onboard system poised, responsive and ready for uninterrupted enjoyment.

Navigation & communication equipment

At the helm the yacht presents a command environment designed for clarity and safety, where a main engine alarm panel with both visual and acoustic alerts pairs with a rudder angle indicator and a dedicated intercom for manoeuvring to ensure seamless crew coordination. A TV antenna and an electrically controlled searchlight provide clear command day or night, while the navigation suite is confidently specified with Simrad autopilot and Simrad depth sounder, two Raymarine VHF units, Furuno Navigation Control and a Master Navigation Multi Plotter. All instruments are orchestrated by NAVIOP and presented on a 15" touch—screen display distributed across three stations to deliver effortless, unified oversight wherever you choose to command the vessel.

Accommodations

Designed to pamper up to ten guests in refined privacy, the yacht's accommodation is a seamless presentation of comfort and Italian design sensibility, offering five luxury cabins each with en suite facilities. The forward main deck hosts the master cabin with its own ensuite bathroom, while the lower deck unfolds two twin cabins, each en suite and enhanced with Pullman beds, alongside two additional en suite double cabins, creating flexible configurations for family and guests. The crew area comfortably accommodates up to six in three crew cabins with an independent living quarter, ensuring discreet, professional service around the clock. Interiors are defined by light fabrics, white leather sofas and armchairs, and gleaming chrome and stainless steel accents, with the main deck flowing from a welcoming living room to an amidships dining area; to port a fully equipped and spacious galley, and to starboard a passageway leading to the forward crew and lower guest cabins, the bridge and the master suite. A guest day head is thoughtfully positioned on the same level next to the staircase descending to the lower guest quarters, and further aft a generous saloon invites relaxation with a large U shaped white fabric sofa and coffee table opposite an entertainment centre where a flat screen TV is elegantly concealed within its own cabinet.

Domestic equipment

Everyday life aboard is effortless thanks to a comprehensive domestic specification that anticipates modern expectations: an oven and microwave oven combine for versatile cooking, a dishwasher simplifies service, and a wine cellar is elegantly integrated into the dining area to present bottles with style. Cold storage is generous with a deep freezer of 93 lt and a refrigerator of 504

It, complemented by an ice maker for instant refreshment, while a washing machine and dryer handle onboard laundry with ease. A conveniently located day head serves guests moving between deck spaces, completing a domestic package designed for carefree yachting.

Deck equipment

On deck, control meets comfort in a meticulous arrangement of systems and finishes that invite both precision handling and relaxed enjoyment. Windlass and chain wash control are matched with a hydraulic door finished in teak internally, and a dedicated control box operates the hydraulic door and swim ladder for effortless transitions between sea and deck. Precision docking benefits from a third engine control station in the cockpit, while the main deck is laid in teak for timeless appeal. Two electric anchor winches stand ready forward, with sunbathing areas appointed with plush cushions both aft and on the forward deckhouse, and an aft table with chairs invites al fresco dining. tread stairs lead to the stern bathing platform, complemented by a bathing ladder and a retractable electric hydraulic gangway for seamless boarding, and a forward garage with a 250 kg crane completes the practical detailing. The flybridge is accessible via interior stairs and from the aft deck, revealing a helm dashboard with steering wheel and engine controls, trim tabs controls and navigation lights, alongside an electro hydraulic crane for the tender, a cushioned sunbathing zone and a well appointed refreshment module with grill, fridge and ice maker that elevate life al fresco.

Tankage

Extended passagemaking is assured by thoughtfully balanced tankage engineered for reliable range and responsible onboard management: fuel reserves of 13,000 liters, fresh water capacity of 3,000 liters, a 200 liter grey

water tank and a 1,000 liter black water tank provide the capacity needed for long cruises while supporting onboard systems and guest comfort.

Entertainment equipment

Leisure takes center stage with a refined entertainment package that places technology unobtrusively at your service: flat screen televisions are installed in the salon and all cabins, a satellite decoder box in the salon delivers global content, and an immersive Bose sound system with carefully tuned speakers fills the salon with rich, balanced audio. In the owner's cabin, Bose players, radio and dedicated amplifiers create a private listening sanctuary that complements the yacht's elegant environment.

Engines & tender

A versatile four metre tender powered by a 40 hp Yamaha outboard stands ready for swift transfers and coastal exploration, complementing the yacht's practical mobility. At the ship's controls the main engines feature hydraulic control with throttle and gear levers positioned at port, starboard and on the aft deck to provide flexible operation, while a comprehensive synoptic panel unit delivers acoustic and visual alarms for portholes, weather tight doors, bilge pumps and smoke detectors and oversees generators, shore power management and GPS to ensure full operational awareness and peace of mind during every passage.
