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OVERVIEW

97-foot Motor Yacht (2009) — Refined Power, Effortless Comfort

With a graceful profile and fortitude to match, this 97-foot motor yacht from 2009 combines the presence of a superyacht with the nimbleness to reach hidden coves and distant anchorages. Her generous 28-foot beam and a shallow draft just under 6 feet create expansive interior volume and exceptional stability while keeping her friendly to marinas and secluded bays—ideal for island-hopping along the Turkish Riviera and beyond. Twin MTU inboard diesels deliver assured propulsion, carrying her to a top speed of approximately 25 knots and providing a serene cruising pace of around 16 knots. Long-range cruising is uncomplicated thanks to around 3,276 gallons of fuel capacity and roughly 793 gallons of fresh water storage, while robust fiberglass-composite construction with fiberglass decks ensures durability and straightforward upkeep.

Inside, sweeping windows bathe the salon in daylight and frame continual sea views that set a refined, relaxed mood for both intimate living and gracious entertaining. The interior layout comfortably sleeps up to 10 guests overnight and is supported by six well-appointed heads for privacy and convenience. A fully equipped galley keeps service efficient, and a dedicated crew area accommodates up to five, assuring professional, discreet operation.

Exterior spaces are crafted for enjoyment: dine al fresco on the aft deck, recline on ample sun lounges, and take in panoramic vistas from an inviting flybridge—perfect for languid afternoons and evenings under the stars. Wide side decks and a user-friendly swim platform enhance safety, accessibility, and ease of water access. Lying in Turkey and offered in appealing condition, this yacht marries style, speed, space, and seaworthiness, poised to elevate everything from a quick weekend getaway to an extended season of coastal cruising.

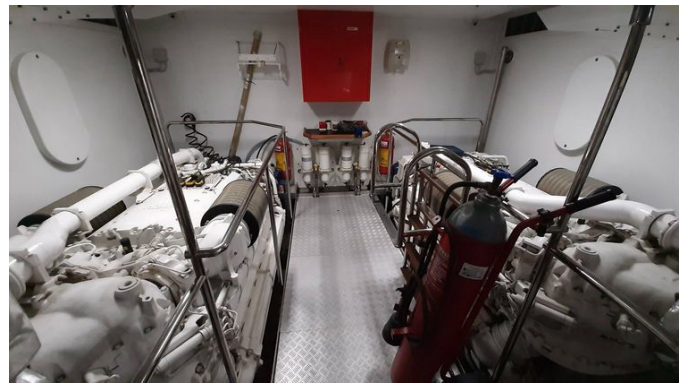

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Specs & equipments

Built in 2009 and refit in 2016 by FERRETTI YACHTS, this fiberglass yacht lies in Southern Turkey under the Gibraltar flag, stretching 29.7 m in length with a 97.0 ft overall, a generous 8.51 m beam equating to 28 ft, and a comfortable 1.8 m draft or 6 ft, presenting a blend of elegant proportion and seagoing stability. Her displacement is recorded as 176 GRT with 52 Net T, and she moves with poise through a speed range of 16–25 knots, propelled by twin MTU 16 V 2000 M93 main engines running on diesel, with engine hours at one thousand eight hundred hours starboard and one thousand eight hundred hours portside and fuel consumption of 460 lt at cruising speed and 800 lt at maximum speed, assuring both efficient passage-making and exhilarating performance when desired. Electrical autonomy is assured by two Kohler Efoz 40 kW generators, while onboard capacities are generous with a fuel capacity of 12,400 LT~, a water capacity of 3,000 LT~, and holding of 1,732 LT~, supporting extended cruises in comfort.

Her interior layout is designed for effortless comfort and refined privacy, accommodating up to ten guests in five cabins comprising one Master, two Double, and two Twin cabins, each with ensuite bathrooms appointed with shower cells to ensure complete convenience and discretion for owners and guests. The equipment list is curated for discerning cruising lifestyle: a 4.20 m Zodiac jet tender powered by a 100 Hp Weber delivers smooth shore transfers, complemented by a Bombardier 255 Hp jet-ski for spirited waterborne fun. The galley is specified to professional standard and fitted with microwave, grill, refrigerator, deep freezer, microwave oven, ice maker, dish washer, cooker, and washing machine, enabling gourmet service at sea with ease.

Navigation and control are precise and duplicated for redundancy both at the

main helm and on the flybridge; the lower station presents a comprehensive suite including Radar (Fruno), VHF (Simrad), GPS (Simrad), Depth Sounder (Simrad), Auto Pilot (Simrad), Speedometer (Simrad), Compass, Chart Plotter (Fruno), and Wind Speed (Simrad), while the flybridge repeats Radar (Fruno), VHF (Simrad), GPS (Simrad), Depth Sounder (Simrad), Auto Pilot (Simrad), Speedometer (Simrad), Compass (Simrad), Chart Plotter (Fruno), and Wind Speed (Simrad) for confident handling in any condition.

Deck and technical outfitting are equally comprehensive and appointed for serious cruising: two Idromar water makers, two Lofrans 380V 3500W windlasses, two ten-person liferafts, American bow thruster and American stern thruster for fingertip maneuvering, a gangway, two anchors of 120 kg each, teak deck, two chains of 165 m, four Mitsubishi zero speed stabilizers for absolute composure at anchor, a swim platform, two Lofrans 380V 2000W winches, three Mastervolt 24V battery chargers rated 25 A, 50 A and 75 A, a search light, a Lofrans chain meter, one flybridge crane and one front garage crane, eleven underwater lights to elevate the evening atmosphere, an electro-hydraulic swim ladder for refined sea access, satellite communications via one KVH Satellite Tv and one Skytec VSAT, and essential systems including waste treatment, security camera and EPIRB. Climate throughout is maintained by a powerful A/C system Condaria 480.000 BTU, rounding off a specification that promises confidence, comfort, and quiet capability in every mile.

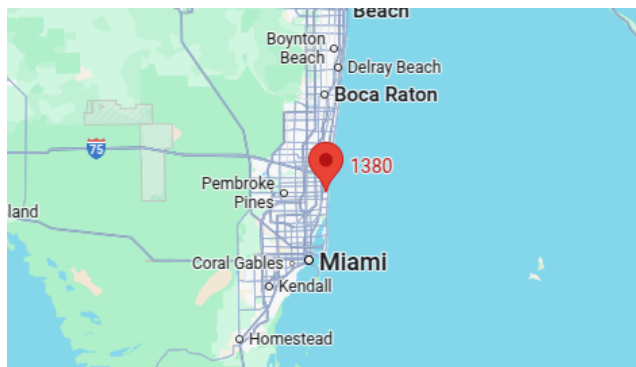
