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OVERVIEW

KARIBU is a distinguished 2011 Ferretti Custom Line 97 that harmonizes timeless Italian styling with an extensive program of modern upgrades, presenting as a truly turnkey luxury motor yacht. Exceptionally maintained and continuously refreshed, she underwent a full interior refit in 2024 and has benefited from significant mechanical, electrical, and cosmetic enhancements carried out through 2026. Designed to accommodate up to 12 guests across five beautifully appointed staterooms, KARIBU features a rare on-deck, full-beam owner's suite complete with a private lounge, walk-in wardrobe, vanity, and an opulent ensuite finished with granite countertops and intricate mosaic tilework. The lower deck houses two queen guest staterooms and two twin cabins with Pullman berths, each with its own ensuite, while dedicated crew accommodations include a captain's cabin, two crew cabins and a separate crew lounge to ensure discreet, professional service.

The interior exudes refinement with rich oak joinery, hardwood flooring and new carpeting installed during the 2024 refit, while the salon offers generous seating, a formal dining area for eight, upgraded Samsung entertainment with surround sound, wine refrigeration and elevated finishes throughout. The galley has been thoughtfully modernized and fitted with premium Miele and Bosch appliances, including a new induction hob, hood extraction and an under-counter refrigerator/freezer to meet demanding culinary expectations. Exterior spaces are equally crafted for effortless entertaining and relaxation; the expansive flybridge on this planing flybridge superyacht is appointed with a hardtop and retractable canopy, an oversized wet bar, American-style BBQ, refrigeration, ice maker, granite-topped tables and comfortable lounge seating, while the teak aft deck provides alfresco dining for eight and direct access to the hydraulic beach club garage that houses a Williams 435 Jet Tender plus custom stowage for water toys.

Additional exterior appointments include full teak decks, foredeck sunpads, a Besenzoni hydraulic passerelle and davit, NEMO side-boarding doors, and freshly polished hull and topsides completed in 2026. KARIBU is propelled by twin 2,000 HP MTU 16V 2000 M93 engines and supported by twin 55kW Kohler generators, with low-hour Seakeeper 9 and Seakeeper 18 gyro stabilizers delivering exceptional underway comfort. The recent, extensive upgrade list underscores her turnkey condition and includes four new Dometic variable-speed A/C chillers, rebuilt ASEA power converters, new engine and house batteries with chargers, new watermaker membranes, new blackwater and greywater pumps, a serviced ABT bow thruster, serviced Besenzoni systems, Starlink connectivity, updated electronics and numerous other mechanical improvements. With an impeccable maintenance history, sumptuous accommodations and an unusually broad suite of new equipment, KARIBU represents an outstanding opportunity to acquire one of the most meticulously updated Ferretti Custom Line 97 yachts on the market.

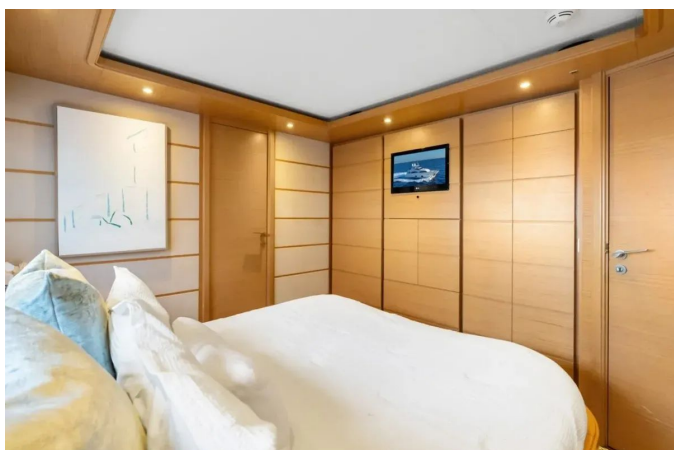


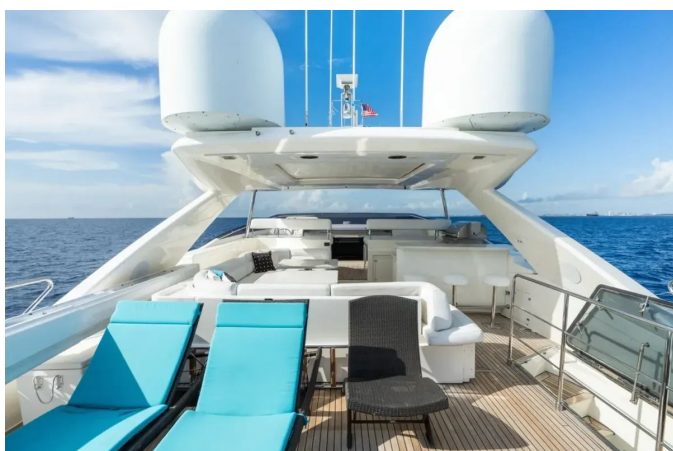
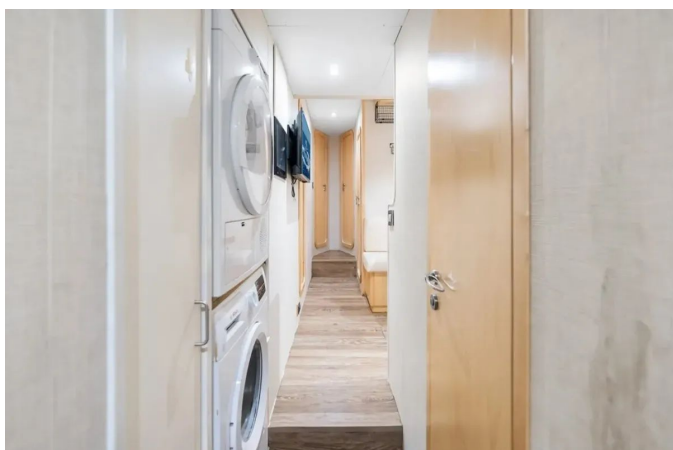




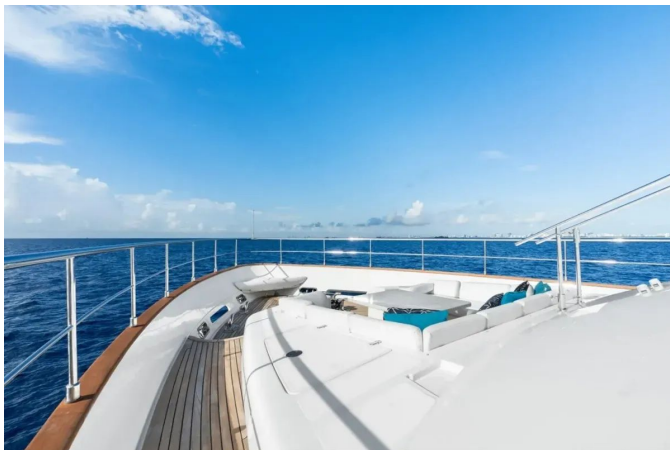


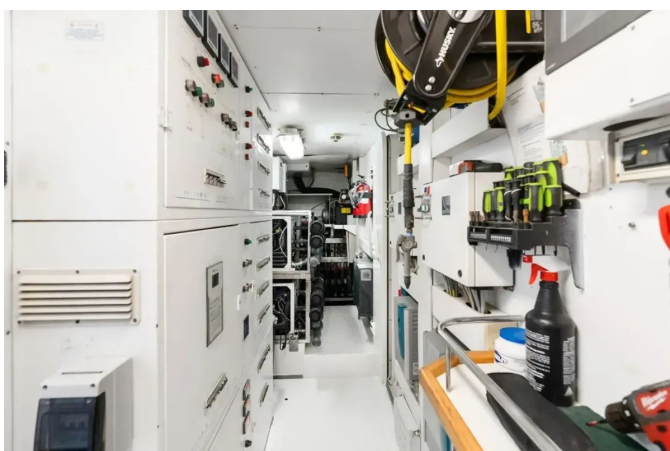
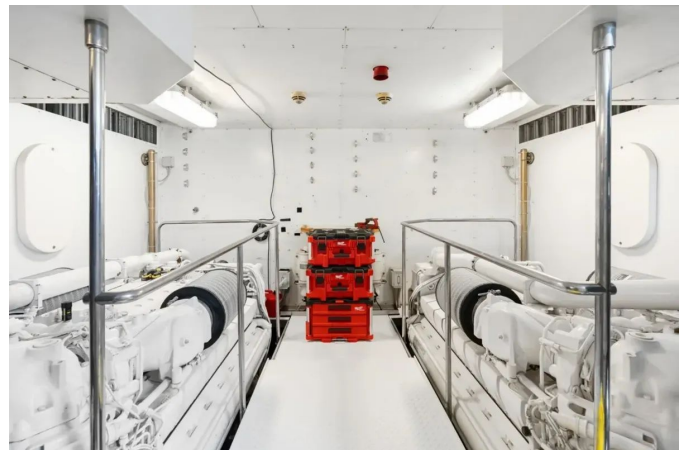














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Recent upgrades

A freshly renewed hull and brilliantly finished topsides announce a meticulous schedule of enhancements carried out over recent years. In 2026 the blackwater and greywater systems received new pumps, while 2025 saw a major service program that included replacement watermaker membranes and a new manifold, new engine batteries complete with a dedicated charger, and new house batteries also paired with a charger; the Besenzoni passerelle and the Dafit were serviced in January 2025, and that year also brought the installation of a new garage door and new rudder manifolds. The interior experienced a full transformation in 2024 with a complete refit of living areas, supported by two ASEA POWER AC36VII power converters rebuilt in 2024 to meet US electrical specifications and an ABT bow thruster that was serviced the same year. Comfort and cosmetic refinements were addressed in 2024 with all-new exterior cushions, new interior carpeting throughout, and a brand-new anchor rode chain, while stability was dramatically enhanced in 2023 with the installation of low-hour Seakeeper 9 and Seakeeper 18 gyro stabilizers. The galley was upgraded in 2024 with a new Miele hood vent, a Bosch induction cooktop and a Summit drawer-style under-counter fridge/freezer, and the entertainment package was modernized that year with new salon and master televisions plus a Starlink antenna. Climate control was comprehensively renewed with a four-unit Dometic VARCX48E chiller system installed in 2024—featuring variable-speed chillers and integrated load management—which was serviced in 2026 and benefits from a new raw-water AC pump and a new chilled-water loop pump, while the Dometic Breathe System provides clean, conditioned air throughout the yacht.

Layout and accommodations

Accommodating twelve guests in five cabins, the yacht centers around an on-deck, full-beam master suite complete with couch seating, a vanity, granite countertops, a mosaic shower and a walk-in closet. Two guest staterooms are fitted with queen beds and private en suite heads with showers, while two further guest cabins offer twin berths alongside a Pullman in each, each finished with its own en suite head with shower.

Salon

Step into the salon where rich hardwood underfoot establishes a warm foundation and oak-grain woodwork flows throughout the space, enhanced by newly installed carpets for added comfort and refinement. Entertainment is centered on an LG TV accompanied by immersive surround sound, while onboard service is effortless with two wine coolers, a freezer, an ice maker and staging tables arranged for elegant presentation. A conveniently located day head completes this sophisticated gathering area.

Galley

Equipped with premium Miele appliances, the galley boasts a combined oven and microwave paired with a precision cooktop and a generous double-door refrigerator. Polished stainless-steel worktops and splashbacks provide enduring resilience and simplify upkeep, while bespoke cabinetry and dedicated pantry doors create ample, intelligently arranged storage finished with refined elegance.

Exterior and deck

Sweeping teak underfoot unifies every exterior surface, providing an elegant setting for open-air living beneath a flybridge hardtop equipped with a retractable canopy. A U-shaped exterior lounge arranged around granite tables is finished with plush upholstered cushions, protective bridge shields and bespoke canvas shades. Entertaining is effortless at the wet bar with three barstools and at the fully appointed outdoor kitchen, which features an American-style oversize BBQ, refrigeration, an ice maker and a sink, while additional built-in cold storage includes a Frigidbar on the flybridge, an icemaker on the flybridge and an Isotherm fridge on the aft deck. Foredeck and bridge sunpads offer forward and elevated spaces for sunbathing, and aft a teak dining table seats eight, accompanied by adjustable rear-facing seating and a third, aft-mounted control station for confident handling in tight quarters.

A full-beam, generous garage is revealed by an aft-opening “beach club” teak-laid door, exposing custom cradles for water toys and storing a Williams Project 435 dinghy alongside a POP3 Aquabanas Pool. Practical access and deployment are managed through NEMO port and starboard lateral doors and a hydraulic Besenzoni pasarelle and davit, while twin Bruce-type anchors, a swim ladder, two self-inflating life rafts and a comprehensive fire system reinforce safety and seamanship throughout the vessel.

Engine room and mechanics

The engine room is appointed with twin MTU M93 16V engines, each rated at 2,000 HP, complemented by a pair of 55 kW Kohler generators, while Dometic VARCX48E units deliver Tropical BTU air conditioning and an ASEA A-36VII frequency converter ensures smooth, reliable power conversion and distribution. Extended autonomy at sea is provided by a Seafari Horizon

watermaker rated at 900 GPD, and onboard conveniences are fully covered with two hot water heaters, MasterVolt battery chargers and a built-in washer/dryer.

Systems for motion control and deck operations are equally sophisticated: stabilization and roll control come from a Seakeeper 9 with 197 hours alongside a Seakeeper 18 with 205 hours, delivering exceptional reduction of roll. Anchoring and mooring are managed by two Lofrans windlasses and two Lofrans capstans, with precise close-quarters handling via an ABT bow thruster. Fleet-standard deck and tender handling are facilitated by a Besenzoni Dafit and a Besenzoni Pasarelle, garage access is governed by a PressMair garage door controller, and the running gear is protected with Prop Speed on the shafts and props.

Electronics and navigation

A pair of Furuno Navnet 3D MFDBB units, integrated with two Furuno radar antennas and a Furuno AIS, form the heart of the helm, providing uninterrupted situational awareness and pinpoint accuracy. An Airmar 1 kW transducer operates alongside GPS, radar and chartplotter functionality to supply precise navigational data and clear guidance, while the Naviop monitoring system offers continuous oversight of all onboard systems. Confident, effortless handling is delivered by the Furuno autopilot and tridata, supported by a depth sounder, compass, log-speedometer and reliable VHF radio communications. When night falls, a FLIR night vision camera, a CCTV full camera monitoring system and a powerful searchlight extend visibility and enhance safety, and onboard entertainment is refined with Samsung televisions and a full surround-sound system throughout.

Crew

The yacht's dedicated crew domain has been conceived to uphold both professionalism and comfort at sea, centred around a welcoming crew mess lounge equipped with new AV and televisions to allow effortless relaxation and smooth briefings. Sleeping accommodations are thoughtfully configured with two cabins that each offer twin bunks, while a separate captain's quarters ensures privacy and ready command presence. Two heads serve the team, delivering efficient support and convenience for all aboard.

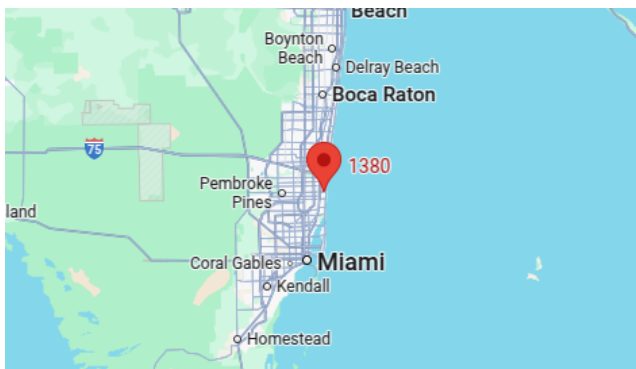
