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OVERVIEW

Launched in 2005 as a Posillipo Technema 95, ALBATOR 2 received tasteful refits in 2023 and 2024; her hull and superstructure are finished in pristine white, a visual testament to her refinement as a luxury motor yacht with the commanding poise of a flybridge superyacht.

Registering 163 GT with a 6.76 m beam, this planing-performance yacht is propelled by twin MTUs, offering a confident cruising speed of 23 knots and a top speed of about 28 knots, while her shallow draft allows ALBATOR 2 to slip into secluded coves and to moor with ease in shallow waters.

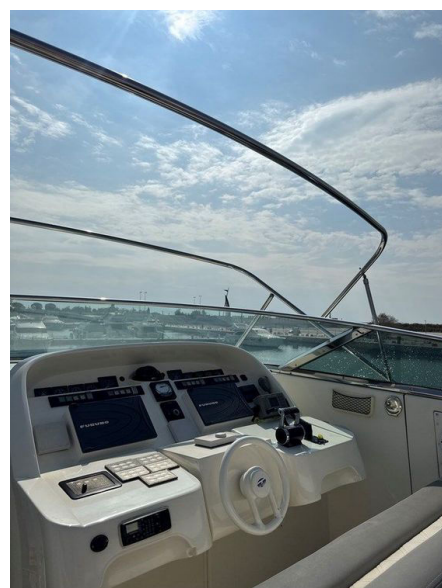


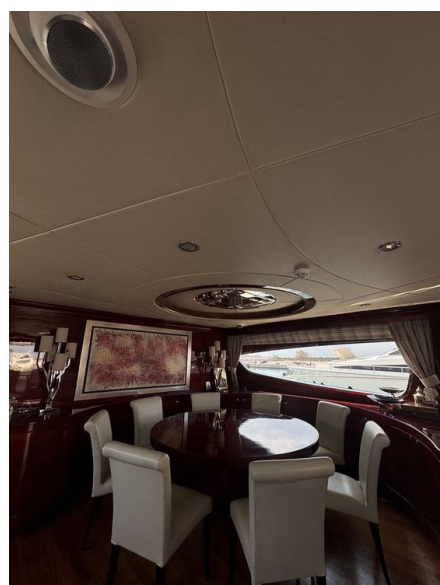
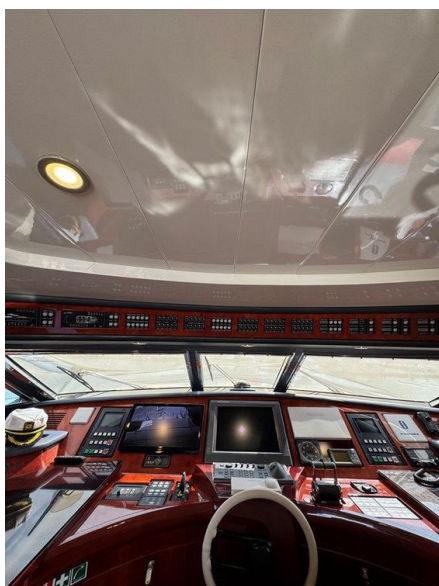






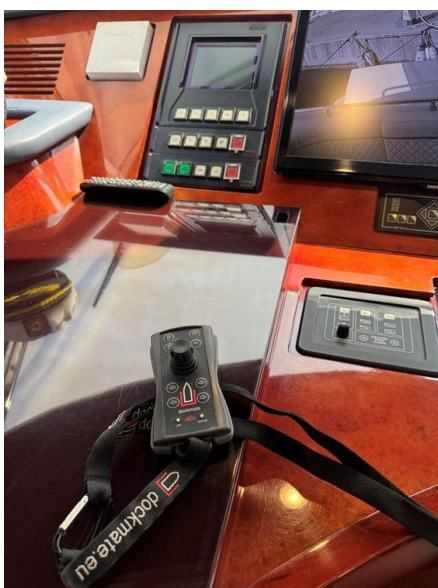
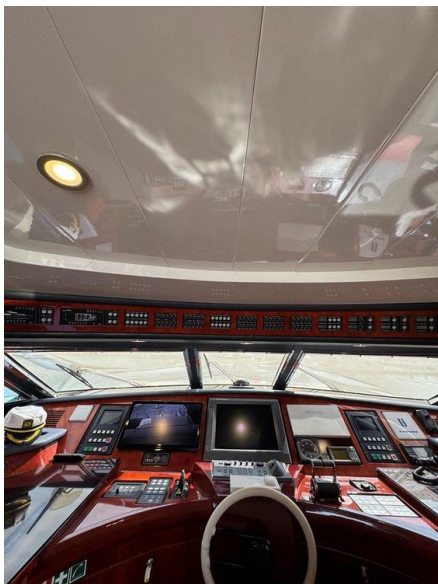


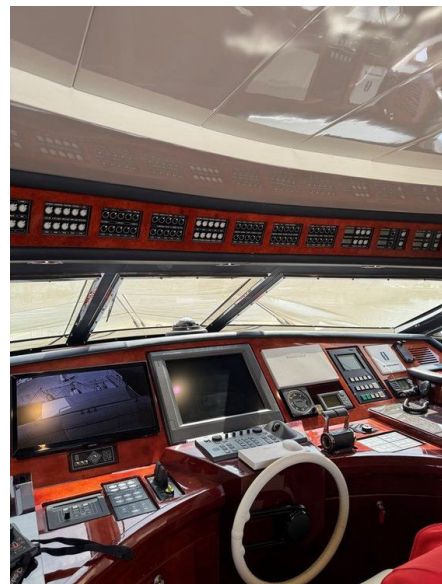
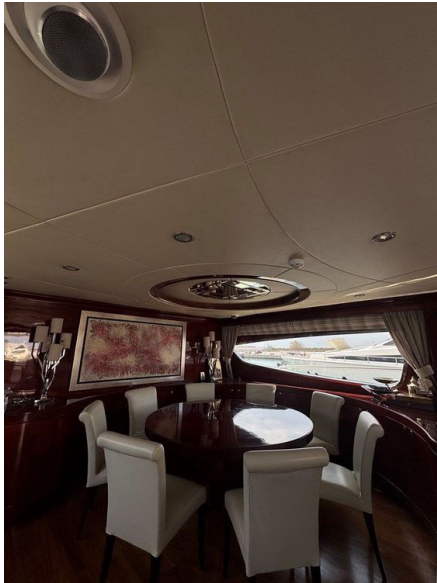


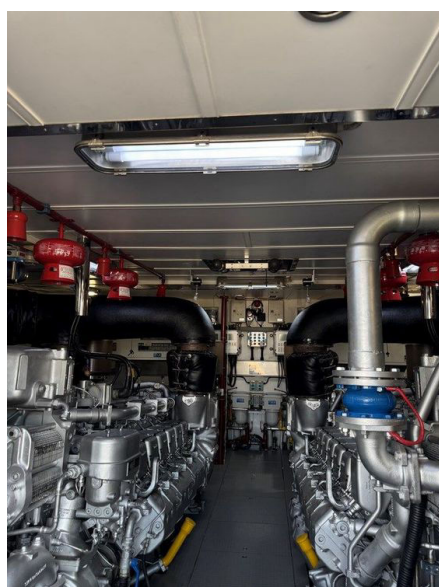
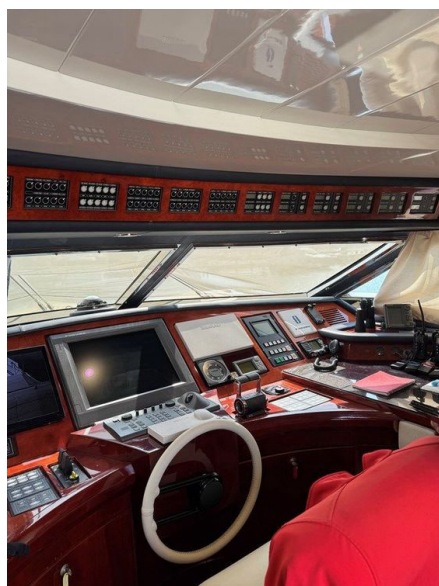




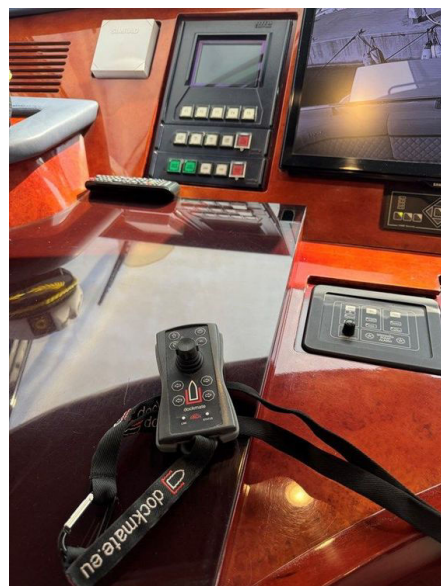
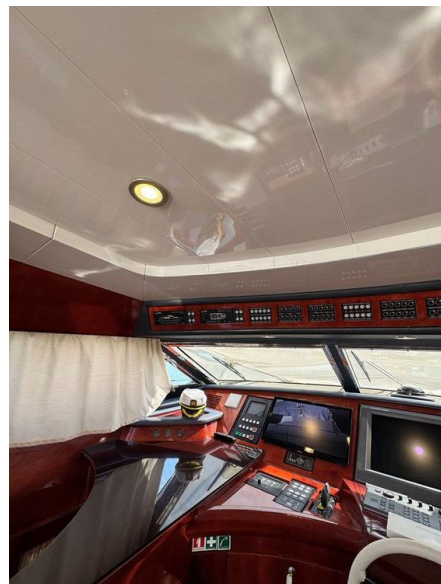
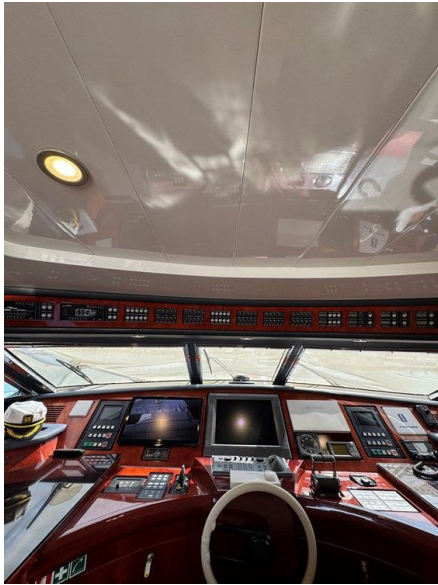


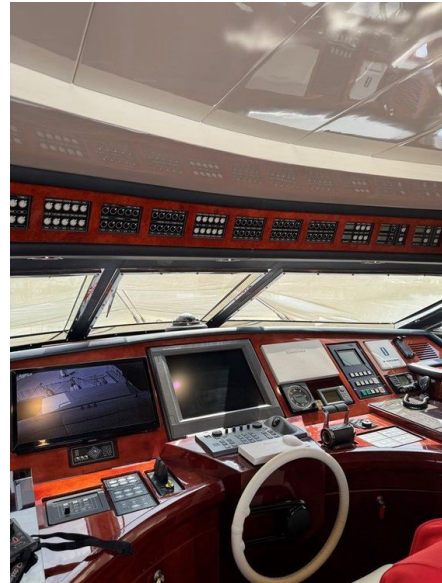












DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

ALBATOR 2, delivered in 2005 as part of the Posillipo Technema 95 series and freshly revitalized by refits in 2023 and 2024, embodies timeless Italian elegance with contemporary upgrades. Her hull and superstructure are finished in pristine white, and with a generous volume of 163 GT and a beam of 6.76 metres, she offers a remarkably spacious platform for cruising and entertaining. Twin MTU engines deliver confident performance, carrying her comfortably at a cruising speed of 23 knots and up to approximately 28 knots at maximum, while her shallow draft invites you to explore secluded anchorages and sheltered bays that remain off-limits to others. The comprehensive 2023 refit introduced a newly extended hydraulic platform with up/down function for tender handling and water access, a new garage, new Kohler 35 kW generators, refreshed sofa cushions at the aft dining table on the main deck, upgraded forward sunbeds, and a wide range of technical maintenance enhancements. On board, five beautifully appointed staterooms accommodate up to twelve guests in comfort, supported by quarters for four crew, and the atmosphere is enriched by an amazing lighting and sound system that elevates every moment from sunrise breakfasts to moonlit soirées. Maintained to an exacting standard, she presents with sleek lines, classic styling, and exceptional Italian craftsmanship, making her equally compelling for private cruising or charter operations. ALBATOR 2 is, quite simply, a must-see.

Technical specification Posillipo 95 2005

Built by POSILLIPO in 2005, this Technema 95 measures 30 m in length overall and spans a 6.76 m beam, with a gross tonnage of 163. A significant refit was

completed in 2023, complementing subsequent updates. She flies the Malta flag and is currently lying in Athens. Constructed in durable fiberglass, she benefits from VAT paid status. The interior layout offers five staterooms for up to twelve guests, delivering a refined balance of volume, comfort, and privacy.

Machinery

Power comes from MTU main engines showing 2450 hours (W5) and delivering 1680 kW, paired with ZF New Crantal gearboxes and conventional shaft-drive propulsion. This robust package underpins a confident cruising speed of 23 knots and a top speed of approximately 28 knots, combining reliability with poised performance.

Tank capacity

Designed for extended cruising, the yacht carries approximately 11,000 litres of fuel and 3,000 litres of fresh water, and is equipped with dedicated black and grey water tanks for efficient waste management.

Key features

A host of standout features distinguishes ALBATOR 2: a flybridge prepared for indulgence with a Jacuzzi and TV; a shallow draft that unlocks hidden coves; five cabins including a premium guest suite on the main deck; and an impressive 163 gross tonnage that delivers exceptional volume for her size. She has been maintained by the owner and crew to a meticulous standard, benefits from low main engine hours, boasts a very large hydraulic platform, and received new 35 kW generators in 2023. With VAT paid, she represents an elegant and practical opportunity, ready to delight her next custodians.

Exterior features

The exterior is thoughtfully configured for effortless outdoor living. On the flybridge, generous space invites relaxation and customization, with options for a Jacuzzi, TV, an open-air dining area, and a large bimini to temper the midday sun. The aft deck hosts an elegant setting for al fresco meals, with seamless access to the swim platform. Forward, broad sun pads with a bimini and a welcoming sofa create a serene lounge with sweeping views. At the water's edge, the hydraulic swim platform serves beautifully for launching water toys and tenders or transforming into a chic beach club area.

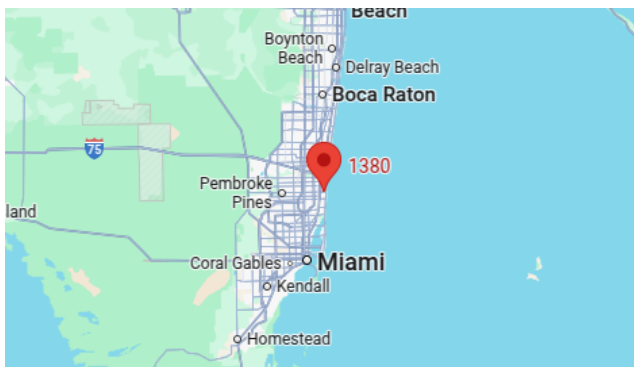
