Azimut 98 Leonardo

The Azimut 98 Leonardo unites the exhilaration of an open sport yacht with the pedigree and polish of a mega luxury motor yacht. Confident, proud, defying convention and rewriting the rules. The 98 is a mood, a philosophy. It is a distinctive yacht for a self-reliant spirit. A luxury motor yacht that is at once lively and alluring—bold and forward-thinking. The 98 Leonardo... in a single expression... *avant garde*.

Featuring an expansive, open-plan saloon, the concealed retractable flat-screen in the entertainment console can be viewed from nearly anywhere on this deck, from the four-seat port-side settee to the eight-person starboard sofa. You can even enjoy it from the dining area, though why would you, with a sweeping 180-degree vista whether the sliding glass is open or closed? Seamlessly merging interior and exterior, the aft-port saloon bar serves guests in both realms. Even the teak cockpit decking advances into the lounge, meeting the ivory Berber carpet partway forward to dissolve boundaries. Textured shades lend the saloon the ambience of an alfresco terrace, especially when a soft breeze filters through the two-panel sunroof above the helm. A true Italian superyacht and contemporary open motor yacht, the 98 Leonardo embodies performance, style, and cutting-edge design in perfect harmony.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Broker remarks

Azimut 98 Leonardo is the embodiment of open-boat exhilaration fused with the poise and refinement of a mega luxury yacht—strong, proud, and unabashedly rule defying. More than a vessel, the 98 is an attitude and a state of mind, crafted for the independent spirit who craves something both spirited and sensual, boldly contemporary and cutting edge. In a word: avant garde. Its wide open saloon sets the tone for effortless indoor outdoor living. A retractable flat screen television within the entertainment center is visible from nearly every vantage on this level, from the four person port side couch to the eight person couch to starboard, and even from the dining table—though the temptation to look away is strong when a 180 degree panorama beckons, whether the sliding door is open or closed. Enhancing this seamless flow, the bar sits aft and to port in the saloon, perfectly positioned to serve guests both inside and out. The teak cockpit sole extends into the saloon, meeting the ivory Berber carpet partway forward to blur boundaries with warm, tactile contrast, while coarse fabric shades lend the ambiance of an outdoor patio, especially when a gentle breeze drifts through the two panel sunroof over the helm.

Electronics

At the helm, a Raymarine ST60 delivers precise wind speed and direction data, complemented by a log-speedometer, a reliable compass, and a capable radar. Navigation is further refined with a Raymarine RL80C GPS and a Raymarine RC631 plotter, while underwater awareness is assured by the Raymarine L760 Plus depthsounder. Confident passage-making comes courtesy of the

Raymarine ST7001 autopilot, and clear communication is provided by the Garmin GHS 10i VHF. For onboard enjoyment, a TV set, CD player, radio, and cockpit speakers create an inviting entertainment experience.

Inside equipment

Onboard comforts are anchored by an IDROMAR MC3J fresh water maker producing 180 l/h, complemented by a bow thruster for confident maneuvering. Daily living is made effortless with a washing machine paired with a clothes dryer, a deep freezer, two refrigerators, an oven, and a microwave oven. Climate control is assured by CRUISAIR air conditioning and efficient heating, while hot water is always on tap. Practical necessities include an electric head, an electric bilge pump for peace of mind, and a reliable battery charger to keep every system ready.

Electrical equipment

Power is delivered by two Kohler generators, ensuring reliable onboard electricity throughout every voyage, while a shore power inlet provides seamless dockside connection for quiet, efficient operation in port.

Outside equipment and extras

The exterior is refined with a teak cockpit and teak side-decks underfoot, complemented by plush cockpit cushions and a versatile cockpit table for elegant alfresco moments. Effortless access to the water comes via the swimming ladder, while the hydraulic gangway ensures seamless boarding in any marina. A convenient cockpit shower enhances comfort after a swim, and a liferaft provides reassuring safety at sea.

Covers

Thoughtfully outfitted for comfort and protection, the yacht includes a fitted cockpit cover that shields the aft area when not in use and a Bimini top that delivers generous shade underway. Together they help preserve finishes and upholstery, reduce exposure to the elements, and ensure relaxed cruising in a range of conditions.

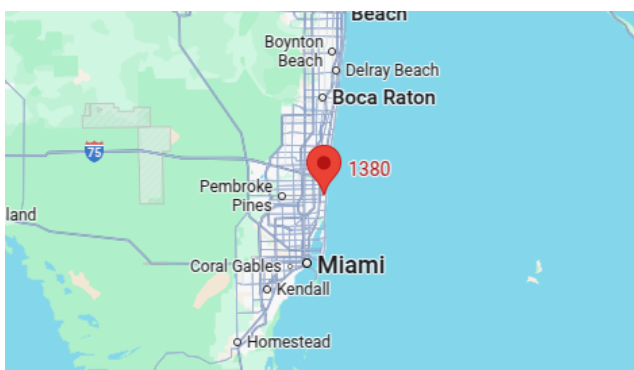
