Launched in 2025, FREYA artfully melds the generous volume and commanding presence of a 30 metre luxury motor yacht with the dynamic performance and impeccable Italian lines of the Ferretti Yachts 1000. Measuring 30.13 metres overall, she features a RINA certified hull deliberately kept beneath 24 metres—a distinction that can confer tangible advantages in operation, regulatory compliance and ownership. Propelled by twin MTU engines of 2,638 hp each, she attains 28 knots, while Seakeeper stabilisation, tropical spec air conditioning and an enhanced specification deliver superb comfort both underway and at anchor. With minimal hours and the manufacturer's warranty valid through March 2027, FREYA offers immediate access to the Ferretti Yachts 1000 lifestyle without the wait of a new build.

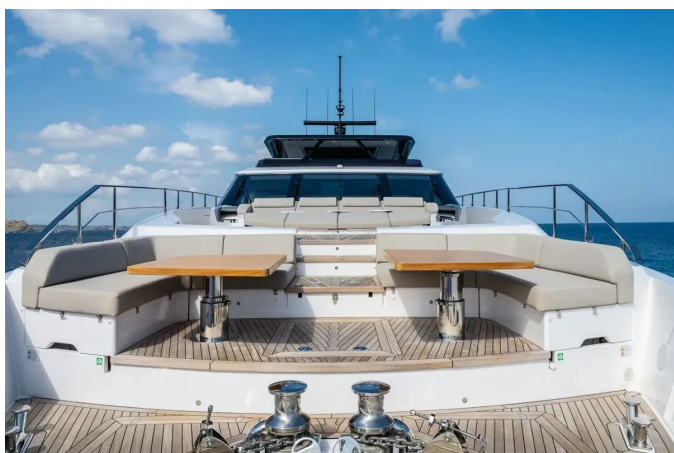


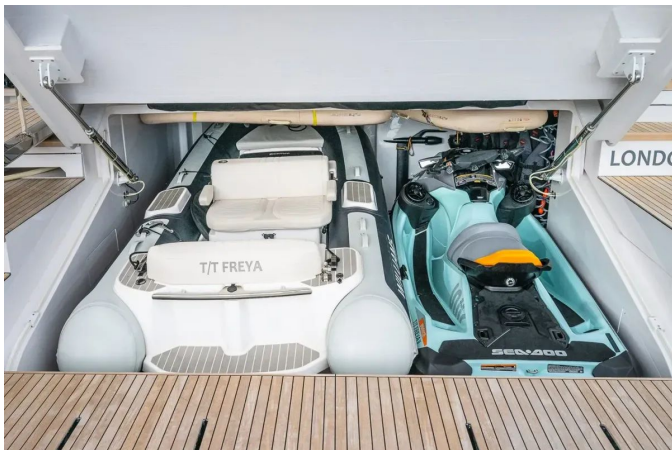
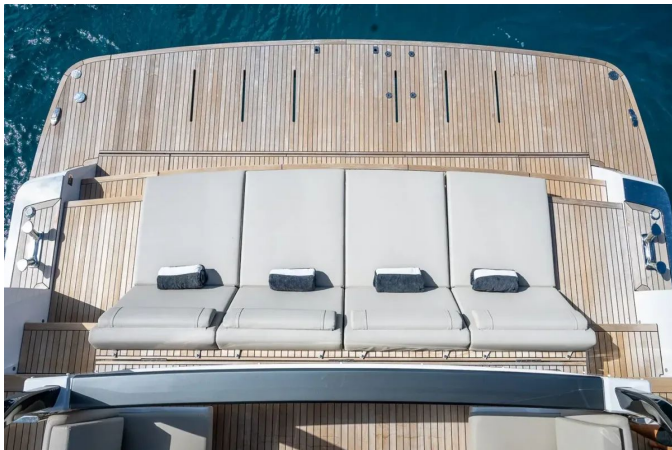


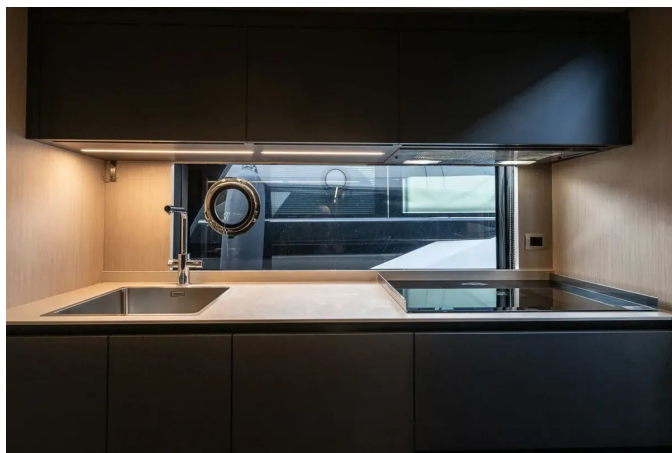




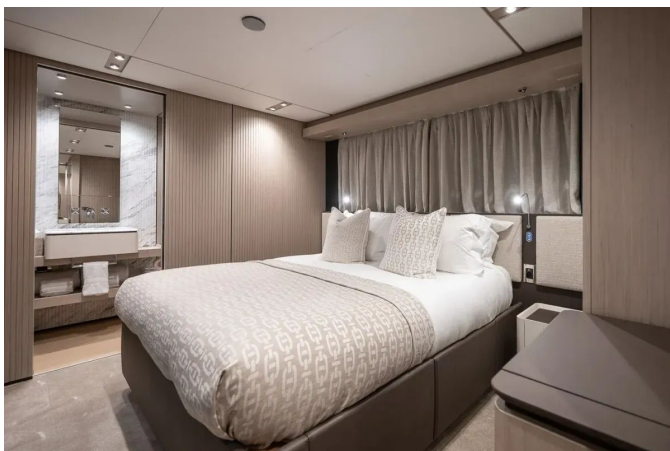














DETAILED DESCRIPTION

General

Thoughtfully laid out to host ten guests across five sumptuous guest cabins and supported by a professional five person crew housed in three crew cabins, this yacht offers an atmosphere of refined comfort throughout. Tropical air conditioning blankets the saloon, guest suites and crew areas to preserve a cool, pleasant interior in warm climates. Zero speed gyroscopic stabilizers combined with navigating fin stabilizers deliver exceptional steadiness at anchor and underway, while upgraded generators ensure robust, reliable electrical power on every voyage.

External

The flybridge deck is finished in teak with black caulking, a motif that continues across the cockpit, side decks, bow and platform, creating a warm, refined deckscape. Port and starboard side deck doors provide effortless circulation around the yacht, while a natural teak table at the bow converts into a generous sunpad and the aft beach platform accommodates a sheltered sunbathing lounge complete with protective covers. Versatility is further assured by awning systems over the bow dinette, aft platform and flybridge, all carried on lightweight carbon poles. Evening atmosphere is softly controlled by exterior courtesy lights with dimmers, augmented by two pop up courtesy lights in the bow living area, and illumination beneath the hull is delivered by two pairs of underwater lights plus an additional pair of watertight underwater lights. Anchoring and mooring are handled by upgraded 150 m anchor chains with a 14 mm diameter, twin 3000 W anchor winches and two stern mooring winches fitted with 90 kg pool anchors. Shore access is made effortless via a hydraulic telescopic passerelle, navigation is supported by an upgraded

electric searchlight, and the aft glass rail is prepared for a backlit boat name while the navigation equipment is elegantly finished in painted trim.

Interior

Discreetly engineered air extractors ensure a constant supply of fresh air in every bathroom, while interior courtesy lighting with dimmers sculpts the perfect atmosphere. The Master cabin is fitted with electric curtains offering complete blackout, a specification repeated in the VIP and Guest cabins, and the saloon features electric curtains designed to complement its electric sliding saloon door. For flexible access and an enhanced open-air feel, the saloon also includes manual glass doors to port and starboard. In the Guest cabins, clever sliding beds provide adaptable sleeping arrangements without compromising either space or comfort.

Technical

Underpinning the yacht's generous electrical capacity are two Kohler generators, each rated at 35 kW, supported by an inverter/battery charger and a dedicated converter to guarantee smooth, reliable power. Long range autonomy is assured by an Idromar Duplex watermaker producing 360 l/h, while onboard comfort and convenience are refined with German Schuko sockets throughout and both a shore fresh water intake and a shore electrical connection managed by a Glendinning system. Precise handling is delivered by hydraulic bow and stern thrusters of 50 hp and 40 hp respectively, complemented by Seakeeper gyro stabilisers that provide exceptional comfort whether underway or at anchor. Practicality and ease of use are further enhanced by a high pressure water cleaner with three selectable positions and an electro hydraulic garage door that affords effortless access to the tender bay.

Navigation

An upgraded Simrad display suite raises the bar for onboard navigation, accompanied by a Simrad 16" repeater in the crew dinette to provide seamless redundancy and shared situational awareness for the team. A Simrad NAIS500 AIS transponder with full RX/TX capability ensures continuous transmit-and-receive tracking, while the Watchit anti-collision system offers proactive hazard avoidance. Comprehensive oversight throughout the vessel is maintained by a CCTV camera kit with its own dedicated switch, and a powerful electric searchlight inspires confidence on night passages. Precise close-quarters handling is achieved from the cockpit control station, which delivers fingertip command exactly where it is required.

Audio visual

Onboard entertainment is arranged for maximum comfort and sophistication, with the saloon centered around a 75-inch television and the Master stateroom appointed with a 55-inch mirror TV. The port and starboard VIP cabins each boast a 50-inch mirror TV, the port and starboard guest cabins are fitted with 43-inch mirror TVs, and the crew dinette is served by a 24-inch TV. A high-end exterior audio system bathes the open-air decks in rich, immersive sound, while a premium 5G internet package ensures seamless connectivity. Satellite television is provided by a KVH TV8 antenna with a dedicated saloon receiver, and TV SAT cabling throughout the accommodation distributes programming to every cabin.

Domestic

Configured to make life aboard as refined and effortless as life ashore, the yacht features an extra refrigerator on the flybridge, an icemaker on the

flybridge fitted with its own water reservoir and a Texan grill for alfresco entertaining. Below deck a dedicated wine cooler preserves vintages at their ideal serving temperature, while the galley is comprehensively equipped for culinary excellence with a five-ring induction cooktop, a 90 cm galley oven and a built-in microwave oven. Practical comforts are completed by an independent washer and dryer, ensuring extended voyages retain the familiar convenience of home.

Tender & toys

Crafted for leisurely days at sea, the yacht features a purpose-built jet-ski launching system—jet ski not included—and a garage-mounted tender fuel pump positioned for fast, effortless refuelling. A Williams DieselJet 445 tender occupies pride of place, accompanied by a tailored accessory kit for the Williams tender to ensure smooth operation and immediate readiness whenever you choose to depart.

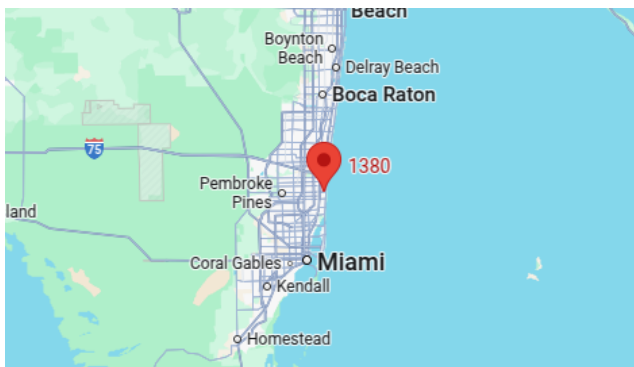
