OVERVIEW

Sloop IKARON, a graceful 30.48-meter creation from Holland Jachtbouw, was delivered in 2000 and meticulously refitted in 2022, presenting a timeless blend of classic lines and renewed refinement. Her polished aluminum hull, the product of Andre Hoek's acclaimed design, carries a beam of 7.19 meters and draws 3.63 meters, proportions that lend both stability and elegant presence on the water.

Under her decks, propulsion comes from MTU 6R 183 TE62 275 kW six-cylinder engines, a powerplant that produces an impressive 385 horsepower and permits a serene cruising pace of 9 knots while offering a maximum speed of 11 knots. Internally she is laid out to welcome up to 8 guests in sumptuous cabins, comfortably served by a professional crew of 4.

Offered for yacht sale at €2,900,000, IKARON is available for viewings in her current boat location, Genoa, Italy, inviting those who seek a vessel that marries sophistication with dependable performance.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Owner cabin

The owner cabin is a luxurious full-beam sanctuary designed for ultimate comfort and relaxation, where every detail has been considered to create a private retreat on the water. It features two double beds positioned on either side, providing generous sleeping space and a harmonious sense of symmetry, while the lavish en-suite bathroom with a stall shower ensures a private and opulent bathing experience. Rich materials, considered lighting and smart storage solutions combine with flawless finishes to deliver an atmosphere of understated elegance and practical functionality, making the owner cabin the perfect haven for restful evenings and serene mornings at sea.

Guest cabins

The guest cabins on this yacht are thoughtfully designed to provide comfort and privacy for every visitor, with an emphasis on tranquil accommodation and tasteful finishes. Located forward, there are two double twin cabins, one on the port side and the other on the starboard side, each arranged to maximize space and ease of access while maintaining a serene onboard ambiance. The port forward cabin is particularly noteworthy for its own en-suite bathroom, offering an added level of convenience and luxury, and together these cabins ensure that guests enjoy a restful and private stay with refined comfort throughout their time on board.

Crew area

The crew area is engineered to balance functionality with comfort, offering practical accommodations that support efficient operation while allowing

space for rest and respite. It comprises two bunk cabins situated on the port and starboard sides to provide individual sleeping quarters and privacy, alongside a welcoming crew mess furnished with a U-shaped sofa and all-electric controls to create a comfortable environment for dining and downtime. The cleverly designed crew bathroom doubles as an en-suite for the port forward guest cabin, reflecting an intelligent use of space that keeps the crew's workflow smooth while maintaining dignified living conditions and easy access to essential systems.

Cockpit

The cockpit is a masterfully arranged space that marries operational command with panoramic enjoyment, offering two helm stations each fitted with comprehensive sail controls to ensure precise handling and confident navigation. From this vantage the helmsperson and guests benefit from fantastic 360-degree views over and along the deckhouse, making the cockpit equally suited to relaxed socializing and focused passage-making. On the port side a large table and a U-shaped sofa in elegant blue leather create an inviting setting for dining and convivial moments, while the starboard side houses navigation and transmission equipment to keep essential instruments within easy reach; convenient steps lead from the cockpit to both the upper deck salon and the lower deck salon, ensuring a seamless flow between helm, social and interior living spaces.

Refit details and upgrades

The yacht has undergone an extensive program of refit and upgrades across recent seasons to ensure peak performance, reliability and modern onboard systems. In 2021 the mast and rig were removed for a comprehensive inspection, with all running rigging replaced and cabling, lights and electronics

checked, serviced or renewed as required; hydraulic furlers were serviced and rebuilt by Rondal, hydraulic halyard rams, aft stay tensioners and the boom vang were all serviced, after which the mast and boom were re-installed and finely tuned. New Furuno radar and navigators were fitted along with new PC screens, a cockpit resolution waterproof monitor, a B&G processor and Triton, and a new gyro-track compass, while all batteries were serviced or replaced to restore dependable electrical capacity. In 2022 the yacht received a new electric motor, the variable pitch gearbox was dismantled, serviced and reassembled with all new components, and the marine gearbox "Twin Disc" was removed, rebuilt and refitted with new seals and bearings. Work continued in 2023 when the underwater hull was sandblasted and rigorously inspected, the propeller, shaft, variable pitch system and gearbox received extensive attention, the variable pitch propeller "Teignbridge" was dismantled and serviced, the propeller shaft was checked for wear and torsion, cleaned and confirmed to be in excellent condition, propeller shaft bearings were serviced and all oil and water seals replaced, propeller shaft oil bath oil was renewed and the aft cutlass bearing replaced. The main engine rubber support blocks were renewed, propeller shaft and main engine were re-aligned with sea trials confirming perfect alignment, the rudder was fully serviced with both lower and upper bearings attended to, the steering system and quadrant were serviced, a new bearing Laghersmith was installed and fresh zinc anodes fitted, and the refit was complemented by brand new sails and a new tender, the Genius 320.

Aft deck

The aft deck is crafted to enhance both practicality and leisure, offering seamless access to storage and the water while providing a gracious outdoor living area. It provides convenient access to the lazarette for orderly stowage and retrieval of gear and supplies, while the hydraulic swim platform creates a

smooth transition to the sea for swimming, diving and launching water toys or the tender, turning the aft deck into a versatile hub for relaxation, boarding and waterfront enjoyment.
