




# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Specifications

---

A graceful motor sailor measuring 31.58 m length overall with a 7.90 m beam and a 3.72 m draft, she carries 179 gross tons and 53 net tons, combining traditional lines with modern seafaring standards. Launched in 2008 and benefitting from a major refit in 2021, she was built by Mengi Yay Shipyard in Istanbul, Turkey, and is based in Marmaris, Turkey, sailing under the Cayman Islands flag. The hull is mahogany finished in Awl Grip in a deep navy-blue tone, complemented by a mahogany superstructure coated in Awl Grip white, while her decks were replaced in 2021/2022 with Burmese teak and the interior wood is also Burmese teak, creating a warm, timeless ambiance throughout. Electrical systems are configured for 380/220 V to meet the demands of extended cruising and modern onboard systems.

## Performance

---

Power comes from twin MAN engines rated at 440 hp each, showing 4200 hours as of 22.09.2024, delivering an effortless cruising pace of 9.5 to 10 knots that invites relaxed passage-making. Precision handling is assured by a hydraulic bow thruster, while Data windlasses manage anchoring with authority, and a NorthStar tender of 3.10 m fitted with a 40 hp Honda outboard stands ready for swift transfers and coastal exploration.

## Generators

---

Onboard power is provided by two Onan John Deere units of 40 kW and a third Onan Kubota unit of 27.5 kW, delivering reliable electrical autonomy for hotel systems and engineering loads; generator hours are meticulously logged with

port at 9600 hours, starboard at 9600 hours, and the night generator at 9600 hours.

## Tanks

---

Long-range autonomy is secured by a fuel capacity of 9500 liters, complemented by 6600 liters of fresh water to support extended cruising, while waste systems include 1800 liters of grey water, a black water tank equipped with a treatment system, and a 200-liter waste oil tank, all arranged to meet practical and regulatory demands.

## Mast & sails

---

She is schooner-rigged on two aluminum masts in a classic configuration that blends grace with versatility, and her sail wardrobe includes a mainsail, a genoa, a jib, and a mizzen, all cut in durable Dacron to ensure reliable performance under sail and to preserve timeless lines whether under canvas or power.

## Accommodation

---

Five beautifully appointed cabins welcome guests with refined comfort: a full-beam Master cabin provides expansive privacy, a refined VIP offers elevated accommodation, and three guest cabins, including one configured with twin beds, ensure serene comfort for family or friends, while the crew are equally well provided for with three dedicated cabins comprising a captain's cabin and two crew cabins, keeping service discreet and efficient.

## Interior

---

Every cabin is en-suite with EWAC WCs and fitted showers, complemented by

generous wardrobes that enhance liveability, while the ambiance is enriched by a solid teak dining table for six and teak interior decking, and comprehensive air conditioning pampers every enclosed area for year-round comfort and climate control.

## Appliances

---

The galley is fully equipped for extended cruising, featuring three deep-freezers and five refrigerators to support provisioning, an electric cooker oven by Gaggenau and a Gaggenau electric cooktop for culinary versatility, a Miele dishwasher and a high-capacity watermaker delivering 350 L/h to guarantee freshwater independence; an ice machine, a Gaggenau microwave oven, a separate Gaggenau oven, and a Miele washing machine with dryer complete the specification for comfortable long-term liveaboard use.

## Exterior

---

On deck, an inviting dining area with a table for eight guests sets the stage for leisurely alfresco meals, while command is at your fingertips from the outside helm on the flybridge; four distinct seating groups and four sunbeds invite relaxation and sociable moments, and a hydraulic aft platform streamlines water access and tender operations with elegance and practicality.

## Safety equipment

---

Safety is paramount, with twelve lifejackets, two horseshoe buoys, and four life buoys at the ready, supported by a fire alarm system protecting every enclosed area to ensure peace of mind for guests and crew.


