OVERVIEW

NAMUUN is the second of the Truly Classic 108 series, launched and handed over in 2012, originally christened SIMBA by her first owner. Having explored the Eastern Mediterranean extensively early in her career, she was later taken by her current owner to the Western Mediterranean and onward to the Caribbean, a cruising history that underscores her credentials as a bluewater luxury sailing yacht. In 2024/2025 she underwent a major refit at Pendennis Shipyard in the UK, a comprehensive renewal that has effectively returned her to near new condition and elevated her to the ranks of standout classic sailing superyachts.

Her interior is arranged with four cabins accommodating eight guests, an unusually generous layout for a yacht of this size and aesthetic that combines refined styling with practical liveaboard convenience. Maintained in private Bureau Veritas class, NAMUUN also presents a credible pathway toward charter compliance, aligning her with the expectations of discerning charter standards. Under sail she delights: a slab reefed mainsail set on a Park Avenue boom and hydraulic furlers for the headsails give poise and control, and on a reach she will comfortably make 13 knots in 20 knots of breeze, true to her pedigree as a refined performance cruiser.

Life aboard is shaped around well considered deck spaces — an inviting midships cockpit for alfresco meals and conversation, a roomy aft working cockpit, and a dedicated Captain's/Navigation deckhouse that enhances command and privacy. The main deckhouse welcomes dining and social gatherings, while a few steps forward lead to a serene salon ideal for relaxation and watching TV. A superb full beam owner's suite with en suite bath occupies the aft section, and the fore area is intelligently laid out with the galley, crew mess and crew quarters, a thoughtful expression of deckhouse sailing yacht design.

Given the depth and quality of her recent works and her impeccable condition, NAMUUN represents a rare opportunity to own a magnificent 108 foot Truly Classic sailing yacht — timeless, capable, and deeply rewarding.
