## OVERVIEW

---

SEAQUELL reflects the renowned Dubois/Alloy lineage, a high-end sailing yacht whose elegant hull and performance-oriented platform are complemented by a reverse transom and twin helm stations that open onto a spacious cockpit and a distinctive 360-degree skylounge, creating a yacht built for true bluewater voyaging. Designed for serious passagemaking, she eats up long ocean legs with the poise and reliability expected of a world-cruising sailing superyacht. The raised saloon wraps guests in panoramic, uninterrupted horizon views and incorporates a plush seating area together with an interior helm and a fully appointed navigation hub, all arranged for comfortable long-range sailing. Immediately forward and a step down from the interior helm, the renewed main saloon — recently refreshed by the current owner — balances formal dining and casual lounging with understated elegance. Aft of the saloon, matching guest cabins to port and starboard provide stylish accommodations: the port cabin features a queen berth while the starboard twin berths convert easily into a king to suit varying guest arrangements. Granite soles and countertops, renewed in 2013, contribute a timeless refinement, and the interior volumes are notably generous for a performance-oriented yacht of this size. The full-beam owner's stateroom occupies the aft section and serves as a serene retreat, offering ample seating and the indulgence of a private steam shower. Forward to port a flexible bonus room or nanny cabin can be fitted with a Pullman berth, adapted as a private gym, or used for discreet storage of luggage and equipment — a practical space for extended bluewater passages. Characteristic Dubois/Alloy split stairways sweep up to the transom and onto an expansive aft deck where deep lockers flank a deck-level Jacuzzi, keeping gear out of sight and the deck uncluttered whether at sea or at anchor. From the twin wheels, excellent sightlines inspire confidence under sail and in tight marinas, and just ahead a comfortable center cockpit provides an inviting al fresco dining spot and a

prime viewing position for the sailing drama. Elevated further forward, a sunning and observation area affords commanding panoramas — the ideal place to savor every horizon aboard this distinguished, world-ready sailing yacht.
