DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Iduna exterior and interior

As you walk across the passerelle and step onto Iduna's stern, you'll be immediately impressed by the sleek and elegant design of her long flat deck. The expansive teak planking curves forward in a distinctive style that exudes a classic charm. The materials used throughout the yacht add to the ambiance, with nickel, aluminum bronze, stainless steel, leather, varnished wood, and sails all contributing to a singular look and feel. Standing on this deck, you may find yourself drifting back in time, imagining the many who have faced the elements here, relishing every rain-soaked moment. The preservation and restoration of original features make Iduna historically compelling. Her deck remains uncannily close to how it looked back in 1939, with original features such as the main mast, skylights, deck saloon, compass, anchor winch, and steering wheel. The teak deck was laid in the traditional way, with a planking pattern that follows the original to the millimeter. All replica fittings have a traditional bronze look, designed and cast to appear completely authentic.

From the helm, you can oversee the rigging, crafted by Harry Spencer of Cowes, and the classically colored Ratsey & Lapthorne sails. The helm is a popular spot, featuring a fold-down captain's seat and ample space for others to enjoy the panoramic views. There is even a niche built into the dashboard to hold your drink and cigar, adding a touch of luxury to the experience.

Descending the staircase from Iduna's deckhouse is like stepping back in time to the golden age of yachting. Although the entire interior is brand new, the rebuild brief was to create the appearance of a boat that had been immaculately kept for 65 years, and they succeeded brilliantly. All materials chosen have a vintage look, including panels with the occasional knot or tasteful scratch. The decorative scheme matches the authentic mood, with

restrained furniture fabrics and understated cream carpeting creating an air of calm. Supplementary features such as cushions and artwork introduce brightness and color. The attention to detail is extraordinary, with design and function in total harmony, from the door handles and hinges to the porthole basins and lighting.

Cherrywood is used to great effect throughout the interior, which includes an owner's stateroom, a guest double with an ensuite bathroom, an ensuite guest twin, and two large cabins for four crew members with a spacious bathroom, galley, and crew mess. There is also a lovely lounge area, offering another place for fine dining in addition to the deckhouse. Modern conveniences ensure comfort while never being obtrusive on the classic atmosphere, allowing you to enjoy the timeless elegance of Iduna without compromise.

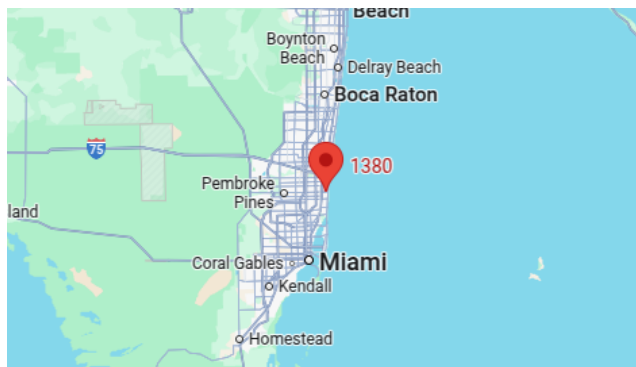
