OVERVIEW

Delivered in 2019, the Baltic 112 Liara is a triumph of performance-driven luxury, a custom sailing superyacht built by Baltic Yachts in advanced carbon fiber composite. That engineering makes her one of the lightest bluewater cruiser yachts in her size range, a vessel whose slender weight and stiffness are intended for long ocean passages while sustaining the refinement expected of a luxury yacht.

Conceived by a seasoned yachtsman and penned by Malcolm McKeon Yacht Design, Liara was imagined to traverse the globe with effortless authority and to hold her own on the superyacht regatta circuit. Her pedigree was recognised at the 2020 Boat International Design & Innovation Awards, where she earned Best Sailing Yacht Interior and Outstanding Exterior Designed Sailing Yacht, distinctions that underline her dual identity as a world class racer cruiser and a high performance sailing yacht.

Accommodation is arranged for 8 guests in four ensuite cabins: a forward owner's double suite, a midships VIP double and two twin cabins located aft of the saloon. Aft, three dedicated crew cabins sleep 5, providing the professional crew support necessary for impeccable service aboard a premium sailing superyacht.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed specification

Launched in 2019, the Baltic 112 'Liara' is a masterpiece of high performance luxury that seamlessly marries speed and comfort. Built by Baltic Yachts in advanced carbon composite, she stands among the lightest cruising yachts of her size and was conceived by an experienced yachtsman with exterior and naval architecture by Malcolm McKeon Yacht Design to cruise the globe in supreme comfort while remaining fiercely competitive at international superyacht regattas. Her design excellence was acknowledged at the 2020 Boat International Design & Innovation Awards, where she won Best Sailing Yacht Interior and Outstanding Exterior Designed Sailing Yacht. Below deck, Liara accommodates eight guests in four luxuriously appointed ensuite cabins: the owner's forward double suite, a midships double VIP and two twin cabins aft of the saloon, while three dedicated crew cabins aft sleep five crew in total. The serene interior by Adam Lay Studios reflects the owner's affinity for the natural world, with calm, high quality limed and stained oak joinery that enhances unusually spacious accommodation. On deck, comfort and sociability are paramount: a large protected guest cockpit provides deep cushioned lounging sofas and a sunpad alongside a generous U shaped dining area, and versatility is embodied in the striking yet easily removable carbon hard top bimini that delivers ultimate shelter for relaxed cruising and, when removed, a clean, performance optimised deck for racing. For long passages her 5.5 m Ribeye tender stows neatly on the foredeck or aft deck. True to Baltic Yachts' reputation for innovation, Liara is fitted with advanced performance solutions, most notably the Hundested Retractable Propulsion System (RPS) which fully retracts into the hull to eliminate drag while its pod rotates 170 degrees each way for exceptional manoeuvrability; a powerful 190

kWh high voltage DC power pack allows all onboard systems — including deck winches, air conditioning and galley utilities — to run in quiet ship mode for up to eight hours without the generator. She also benefits from a retracting telescopic keel (3.9 m to 6 m), dramatically improving access to shallow anchorages and remote cruising grounds, and paired with a 6 m draft, the powerful Southern Spars rig and a Norths square top mainsail deliver outstanding performance. Opportunities to acquire an all carbon composite Baltic yacht of this pedigree are rare; rarer still one so technologically advanced. Meticulously maintained under her owner's program, LIARA is completely turnkey, has never been chartered and has only been lightly raced. Full brochure and specification available on request.
