Commissioned by a seasoned yachtsman, LIARA was penned by Malcolm McKeon Yacht Design to roam the globe in total ease while remaining regatta-ready for elite international superyacht competitions. Her design excellence was celebrated at the 2020 Boat International Design & Innovation Awards, where she claimed honors for “Best Sailing Yacht Interior” and “Outstanding Exterior Designed Sailing Yacht,” underscoring her stature as a benchmark performance sailing yacht.

Accommodations host eight guests in four exquisitely finished en suite cabins, comprising the owner’s forward stateroom, a midships double VIP, and two twin cabins aft of the salon. Three dedicated crew cabins aft sleep five, ensuring discreet, impeccable service and a seamless onboard experience worthy of a world-class luxury yacht.

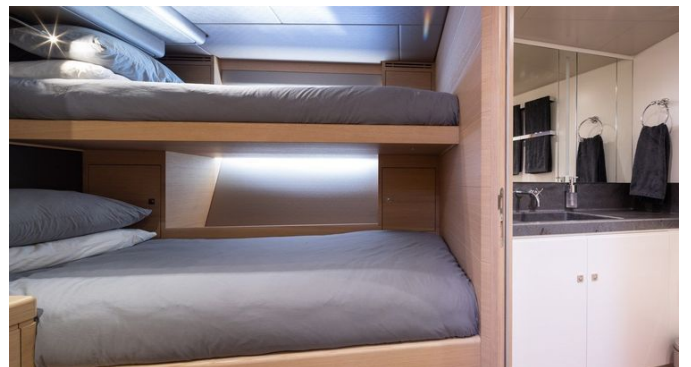
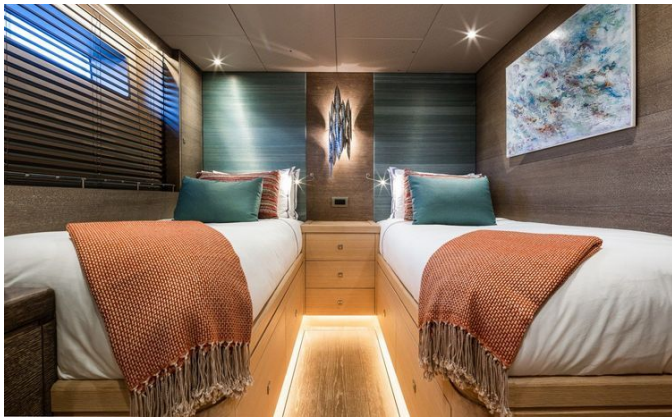

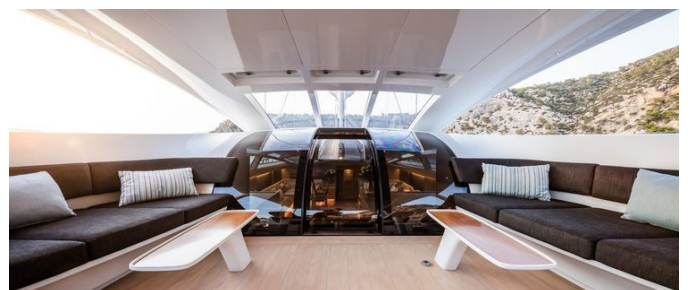

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Detailed specification

Launched in 2019, the Baltic 112 Liara is a masterpiece of high-performance luxury that perfectly blends speed with comfort, built by Baltic Yachts using advanced carbon composite construction methods to make her one of the lightest cruising yachts of her size. Conceived by an experienced yachtsman and designed by Malcolm McKeon Yacht Design to cruise the world while remaining highly competitive at international superyacht regattas, her design success was officially recognized at the 2020 Boat International Design & Innovation Awards, where she won her category for 'Best Sailing Yacht Interior' and 'Outstanding Exterior Designed Sailing Yacht'.

Liara sleeps eight guests in four luxuriously appointed ensuite cabins, comprising the owner's double suite forward, a double VIP cabin midships, and two twin cabins aft of the saloon. Three dedicated crew cabins aft sleep five in total. The beautiful interior by Adam Lay Studios reflects the owner's love of the natural environment, with calm, high quality limed and stained oak joinery throughout the yacht's unusually spacious accommodation.

On deck, Liara is designed for ultimate guest comfort and sociability, with a large, protected guest cockpit featuring lounging sofas and a sunpad for relaxation alongside a generous U shaped dining area. Versatility is central to her concept, expressed in the striking yet easily removable carbon bimini top: this hard top bimini provides excellent shelter while cruising, or a clean, performance optimised deck for racing when removed. For long range passages, her 5.5 m Ribeye tender can be neatly stowed on the foredeck or on the aft deck.

Famed for technological innovation, Baltic Yachts equipped Liara with cutting edge performance solutions, most notably the Hundested Retractable

Propulsion System (RPS). This drive fully retracts into the hull, eliminating drag and maintaining optimal hull speed, while also delivering exceptional close quarters manoeuvrability by allowing the drive pod to rotate 170 degrees in each direction. Liara also features a powerful 190 kWh high voltage DC power pack enabling all onboard systems, including deck winches, air conditioning, and galley utilities, to operate in quiet ship mode for up to eight hours without running the generator.

Liara further benefits from a retracting telescopic keel adjustable from 3.9 m to 6 m, significantly improving access to shallow anchorages and remote cruising grounds. Combine a 6 m draft with her powerful Southern Spars rig and North's square top mainsail and her performance is outstanding.

Rarely does an all carbon composite Baltic Yacht of this pedigree come to market, let alone one so technologically advanced. Thanks to her owner's meticulous maintenance program, LIARA is absolutely turnkey ready, has never chartered, and has only been lightly raced. Full brochure and specification available on request.
