Built in epoxy-laminated mahogany with artisanal detail, she reimagines the classic gulet profile with contemporary luxury, refined performance, and a thoughtfully engineered layout—an elegant fusion of sailing yacht character and motor yacht ease.

Designed for sophisticated cruising, she sleeps 10 guests in five generous en-suite cabins (1 master, 4 double). Expansive outdoor living unfolds across the flybridge, fore and aft decks, complemented by an on-deck Jacuzzi. Inside, a chic salon with a fully outfitted bar and dining space sets the stage for effortless entertaining. A dedicated five-crew configuration delivers polished, silver-service hospitality—ideal as a luxury gulet for private escapes or a premium crewed charter yacht.

A proven charter performer, BELGIN SULTAN has entered the market with strong demand, demonstrating compelling commercial appeal and dependable revenue potential. She is fully equipped and compliant for high-end Turkish charter operations, positioning her as a standout superyacht in the motor-sailer category.

Built in the heart of Turkey's renowned yacht-building hub, BELGIN SULTAN showcases shipyard excellence and a confident, modern silhouette. 

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Motor sailor gulet Belgin Sultan

M/S Belgin Sultan is a thirty-five-metre, twenty twenty-four Turkish built motor sailor gulet with five cabins, delivered new and fully charter ready. Launched in Fethiye and registered commercially under the Turkish flag, she blends the timeless profile of a gulet with modern functionality, refined performance, and turnkey compliance for luxury crewed charter. Built in epoxy laminated mahogany over a pine frame and sheathed with double layer fiberglass (five hundred square metres along the hull sides), she carries a GUANA teak keel and an oak filled bow with eight curved forward frames—traditional craftsmanship enhanced by contemporary engineering. Currently lying in Bodrum with a base port in Göcek, she is equally at ease as a private family cruising yacht or as a luxury charter yacht in the superyacht gulet category. Her dimensions underline space and stability: an LOA of 35.00 metres and a registered length of 31.15 metres, a generous 7.90 metre beam and a 3.60 metre draft, with gross tonnage of 155 GRT, net tonnage of 46, and a deadweight of 118.70. As a motor sailor (gulet) completed in twenty twenty four, she presents as a new generation Turkish build with elegant lines and a purposeful stance.

Accommodation is designed for comfort and privacy: ten guests are hosted across five en suite cabins, including one full beam master and four double cabins, each fitted with televisions, safes, and hairdryers. Full climate control spans air conditioning and diesel heating throughout the interior. A dedicated crew of five—captain, chef, hostess, and two sailors—operate from separate quarters and service routes, ensuring discrete service and smooth operations. Expansive teak decks offer multiple relaxation zones, from a flybridge and broad fore and aft areas with sunbathing cushions for eight, to a freshwater

Jacuzzi on deck and a stylish bar. The salon brings everyone together with lounge seating, indoor dining, and a full entertainment system; the yacht is fully air conditioned and heated throughout for year round cruising.

A professional galley supports silver service hospitality with two full size refrigerators and four horizontal glass door coolers for beverages and produce, an industrial stove with electric oven, dishwasher, toaster, ice maker, a multi functional coffee machine alongside a Turkish coffee machine, two tea makers, a suite of electric kitchen appliances, dedicated cocktail equipment, and a washing machine with dryer combo. This comprehensive setup underpins effortless service whether at anchor or on passage.

Propulsion is robust and reliable, with twin 460 HP Baudouin engines delivering an easy cruising speed of eleven knots and a maximum of thirteen knots, aided by a BOURTHRUSTER bow thruster for precise manoeuvring. Power generation comes from two 33 kW VEGA generators. Tankage is generous for extended itineraries: 6,732 litres of fuel (six tons), 8,000 litres of fresh water (eight tons), and 5,000 litres of black/grey waste capacity (five tons).

Sail and deck systems are equally thoughtfully specified, featuring an electric genoa sail system, two anchors of 250 kilograms each, dual 240 metre (sixteen millimetre) anchor chains to port and starboard, and two aft cranes port and starboard, all laid over handsome teak decks.

Navigation and onboard technology are curated for confidence and comfort: Raymarine GPS, autopilot, and AIS integrate with radar and a depth sounder, an ICOM VHF, and full compass and navigation displays. A satellite system with internet is available in Turkish waters, while TVs are fitted in all cabins and the salon, and a Bluetooth music system sets the mood across guest areas.

On the water, a 5.60 metre tender with a 100 HP Honda engine enables swift transfers and tow sports, complemented by water skis, two paddleboards, two canoes, a Ringo inflatable towable, and full sets of snorkelling and fishing gear,

making her a versatile luxury yacht for active families and charter groups. As an investment, Belgin Sultan has already entered the luxury charter market with momentum, presenting a turnkey, operational, and profitable charter setup for a return-minded buyer. Her commercial classification, professional galley, five-star crew arrangement, and established charter appeal distinguish her among new-build gulets. For an owner seeking a Turkish-built sailing yacht with motor yacht ease—a superyacht gulet and crewed charter yacht that is genuinely yacht-for-sale ready—Belgin Sultan offers space, reliability, and immediate enjoyment.

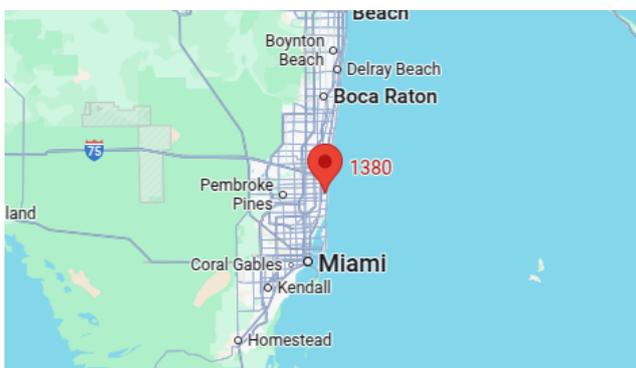
