## OVERVIEW

---

119' Italian luxury motor yacht (2005)

Born of Italian design and engineered for leisurely, blue water confidence, this 119 foot motor yacht marries classic proportion with thoughtful technical intent. Her advanced composite hull and carbon fiber decks produce a rigid, quiet platform, while a purposeful deep draft gives the vessel reassuring seakeeping in open water. Propelled by a single MTU engine, she settles into an efficient 10 knot cruising speed and will attain roughly 13 knots at her top end—an ideal balance for tranquil passages, coastal exploration and extended Mediterranean seasons.

Interior spaces are suffused with light and a sense of welcome. Generous salons encourage relaxed conversation and refined entertaining, framed by panoramic views and meticulous Italian joinery. Circulation flows naturally from the main salon to the dining area and out to the alfresco lounges, so hosting an intimate dinner or a convivial gathering feels effortless.

Accommodations are arranged for comfort on longer voyages: a full beam owner's suite anchors the private accommodations, supported by ample guest cabins and well configured crew quarters that allow for discreet, professional service.

Life outdoors has been given equal attention. Wide walkways accented in teak and a carbon fiber superstructure reduce overall weight and reinforce structural stiffness, freeing expansive deck areas for sunning, shaded dining and relaxed afternoons at anchor. A broad aft deck opens onto a generous swim platform, making sea access simple for a morning swim or quick tender embarkation. The yacht's substantial fuel and water tankage, combined with the economical single engine arrangement, emphasize a design philosophy centered on range, low vibration and serene onboard comfort.

Launched in 2005 and lying in Italy, this 119 footer exemplifies Italian

craftsmanship—understated lines, enduring materials and seakeeping that invites longer voyages. Equally at home as a private family cruiser or a polished charter offering, she presents a rare union of composure, efficiency and the timeless ease that defines a true luxury motor yacht.
