OVERVIEW

Delivered in July 2019, the exquisite S/Y Corsario is a fully bespoke sailing yacht, hand-built from marine-grade steel to meet the highest European standards by the esteemed Radež d.d. shipyard in Croatia. Created for those who crave both comfort and the call of the open sea, she is an impeccable vessel for passionate sailors and discerning guests alike.

Commercially registered under the Croatian flag and constructed in strict accordance with the MCA LY3 code, S/Y Corsario has been subject to rigorous oversight by the Croatian Shipping Register for short-range navigation. Her generous interior volume of 339 GT has been artfully arranged to maximize space and refinement: the saloon presents a dining table for 12, two separate lounge areas and a fully stocked bar, while accommodation for up to 12 guests is provided across six sumptuous cabins — a Master and VIP suite each with ensuite bathrooms featuring underfloor heating, two Double cabins with ensuite facilities, and two Twin cabins with individual bathrooms.

Outside, the yacht's 8 m wide aft deck is appointed with two expansive sunbeds that look over an al fresco dining area capable of hosting 12 guests, and the foredeck offers two additional lounges that command vivid sea views. The sundeck is a crowning feature, composed of two distinct lounge zones: an upper aft lounge with large sunbeds, a jacuzzi, sauna and dayhead, and a striking upper fore lounge with sunbeds that deliver a sweeping 180° panorama. A graceful 6 m bowsprit enhances her sailing silhouette while contributing to optimized performance.

Propulsion comes from two John Deere diesel engines, each producing 425 hp, yielding a top speed of 11 knots and an economical cruise at 8.5 knots with fuel consumption of approximately 50 liters per hour and a remarkable range of around 2,000 nautical miles. The main engine room houses two John Deere generators delivering 64 kW of power, complemented by an additional 27 kW

Cummins generator for nighttime use, and a desalinator capable of producing 425 liters of fresh water per hour ensures onboard self-sufficiency.

S/Y Corsario is equipped with a sturdy 5.5 m tender suited to towing water-skiers, wake-boarders and an assortment of towable toys, and her water toy inventory includes a Yamaha jet ski, a seabob, inflatable swim platforms, two paddleboards and two SUP boards. Offered for sale in the current boat location, S/Y Corsario represents a rare fusion of luxury, seaworthiness and adventure, awaiting her next owner to claim this sailing masterpiece.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

Delivered in July 2019 as an extraordinary, fully custom sailing yacht, S/Y Corsario was crafted with precision and elegance by the renowned Radež d.d. shipyard in Croatia. Constructed from marine-grade steel to the highest European standards, this yacht is designed for those who seek pure comfort and adventure on the seas. Commercially registered under the Croatian flag and built in accordance with the MCA LY3 code, S/Y Corsario is supervised by the Croatian Shipping Register for short-range navigation. It boasts an impressive interior volume of 339 GT, featuring a smart layout that maximizes space and luxury. Inside, the saloon is a testament to opulence, hosting a dining table for twelve guests, two separate lounge areas, and a fully equipped bar. The yacht can accommodate up to twelve guests in six luxurious cabins, including two expansive cabins, Master and VIP, with ensuite bathrooms featuring floor heating, two double-bed cabins with ensuite bathrooms, and two twin cabins with ensuite bathrooms. The eight-meter wide aft deck is a haven for relaxation, with two large sunbeds overlooking a delightful al fresco dining area for up to twelve guests, while the foredeck offers two inviting lounges with breathtaking sea views. The sundeck is equally impressive, providing two separate lounge areas: an upper aft lounge with large sunbeds, a jacuzzi, a sauna, and a dayhead, and a beautiful upper fore lounge with sunbeds offering a stunning 180° view. A six-meter bowsprit not only adds style to her elegant sailing design but also enhances her sailing performance. Powered by two John Deere diesel engines of 425 hp each, this yacht is both economical and eco-friendly, capable of reaching a top speed of 11 knots and cruising smoothly at 8.5 knots while consuming only 50 liters per hour, allowing for a range of 2,000 nautical miles. The main engine room houses two

John Deere generators with 64 kW for power supply and an additional Cummins generator of 27 kW for night use. A desalinizer is also on board, producing 425 liters of fresh water per hour. S/Y Corsario is equipped with a powerful 5.5-meter tender capable of towing water-skiers, wake-boarders, and many towable toys available on board, and guests can also enjoy a variety of other toys, including a Yamaha jet ski, a Seabob, an inflatable swim platform, two paddle boards, and two SUP boards, ensuring endless entertainment and adventure on the water.

Equipment & details

The S/Y Corsario is a marvel of engineering and design, equipped with two robust John Deere engines, each delivering 425 horsepower. The starboard engine has clocked 647 hours, while the port engine has 1100 hours, reflecting their reliable performance. At a cruising speed, the yacht consumes a modest 50 liters per hour, making it both efficient and eco-friendly. Powering the yacht's electrical systems are two John Deere generators, each providing 64 kW, complemented by an additional Cummins generator of 27 kW. The starboard generator has 7990 hours, and the port generator has 8010 hours of operation. The yacht's black water capacity is an impressive 14,000 liters, ensuring extended voyages without frequent stops. The pilot station is strategically located on the bridge of the upper fore deck, offering excellent visibility and control. Entertainment is top-notch with two Sony SMART TVs paired with a Bose sound system in the saloon, all enhanced by a great sound isolation system for an immersive experience. For added convenience, there is an additional cabin available for a nanny or a masseuse, ensuring that guests have all the comforts they might need. The yacht's design, with a 2.9-meter draft, ensures stability and seaworthiness, making it a reliable vessel in various sea conditions. The total sail area is an impressive 400 square meters of Dustom sails, complemented by a six-meter bowsprit that not only adds to the

yacht's elegant design but also enhances its sailing performance. Onboard amenities include a desalinizer capable of producing 425 liters of fresh water per hour, a jacuzzi on the deck, and a Finnish sauna for ultimate relaxation. The aft deck features two sunbeds, while the fore deck offers two attractive lounges. The sundeck is divided into two separate lounge areas: the upper aft lounge with large sunbeds and the upper fore lounge with sunbeds offering a stunning 180° view, providing guests with unparalleled comfort and luxury.

Tender & toys

The S/Y Corsario is not just about luxury and comfort; it also promises endless fun and adventure on the water with its impressive array of tenders and toys. At the heart of this collection is a 5.5-meter Tiger Marine tender, powered by a 100 hp outboard engine, ensuring swift and smooth transfers to and from the yacht. For those seeking thrills, the Yamaha jet ski offers exhilarating speed and agility on the open water. Wakeboarders and waterski enthusiasts will find plenty to enjoy, with equipment readily available for their use. For a more relaxed exploration of the sea, the F5 Seabob provides an exciting way to glide through the water, while the inflatable swim platform offers a perfect spot for sunbathing or simply enjoying the ocean. Paddleboarding enthusiasts are well catered for with two paddle boards and two SUP boards, allowing guests to explore the surroundings at their own pace. Towable tubbings add an extra layer of excitement, perfect for those who love a bit of adrenaline. Finally, snorkeling gear is on hand for guests to discover the vibrant underwater world, making every moment on the S/Y Corsario an unforgettable experience.
