OVERVIEW

The listed figure is a guideline, and all serious proposals will be considered with respect. The 1972 Whitby Alberg 37 is a revered offshore sloop—sturdy, traditionally styled, and engineered for long distance passagemaking by mariners who value seaworthiness, simplicity, and safety above trend driven speed. With attentive ownership and a careful refit, she remains a genuine bluewater performer with a loyal following among liveaboard and long range cruisers.

This yacht represents an attractive opportunity for a competent, hands on sailor to assume a refit that has already seen substantial investment. The previous owner dedicated more than five years to her restoration, including a professional overhaul of the Yanmar 3JH3E 29 HP diesel, which is reported to have zero hours since its rebuild. The interior has been sympathetically refreshed with professional joinery work, preserving a classic, inviting atmosphere. The navigation and electronics complement serious cruising needs, with Raytheon radar, a Raymarine ST4000 autopilot integrated with windvane control, and Raymarine ST60 instruments. Onboard comfort for extended passages is provided by a Force 10 propane range, a Cozy Cabin heater, a Dometic refrigeration unit, and a microwave, making her both practical and welcoming for bluewater life.

Mechanical and electrical systems have been thoughtfully upgraded: a new inverter/charger, fresh battery bank, updated lighting, a solar array, and a full rewiring completed in 2005. Fuel and sanitation arrangements include a custom aluminum diesel tank and a newly installed 20 gallon bladder tank. Sail handling was simplified during the 2005 work with replacement standing and running rigging, the addition of Selden in mast furling and roller furling, and sails that are reported to be in serviceable condition—an ideal setup for offshore cruising where ease of management matters. The hull received a

thorough restoration down to the gelcoat and was treated with a four coat barrier system, and a new cutlass bearing has been fitted, reflecting preparation for extended voyaging.

While a great deal of heavy work has been completed, additional projects remain to bring this classic fully to its next chapter. For an experienced, resourceful owner ready to finish the restoration and commission a capable ocean cruiser, this project offers meaningful potential. The vessel is offered strictly AS IS, WHERE IS, without warranty, and prospective buyers are strongly encouraged to inspect in person or engage a surveyor. The onboard equipment list includes a Raytheon R1XX radar with an RD424 digital radome, a Raymarine ST4000 autopilot with remote control paired with an ST60 wind vane and control unit, plus Raymarine ST60 depth and chartplotter electronics to support both coastal and offshore navigation. A trailer is not included in this sale. Nationwide transport can be arranged through CertifiedMarineTransport, with custom cradles and port delivery available for international export, and trailer solutions can be coordinated via the Mendon, MA office.
