OVERVIEW

If you are in search of a rugged pilothouse motor yacht suited for Pacific Northwest voyages, seize this uncommon opportunity. Built in the UK, she is fashioned with a long, full keel that delivers unwavering directional stability, while her ketch rig brings added comfort and simpler sail handling—smaller individual sails, balanced driving force, and the practicality of making most points of sail with one canvas struck. The raised pilothouse affords true 360-degree visibility and incorporates a sliding sunroof to boost ventilation. Below decks the main salon offers generous headroom, a well-appointed galley and ample, welcoming settees. Forward is an enclosed head with shower opposite a spacious V-berth complete with vanity and wash basin. A refined bluewater cruiser and explorer yacht—trawler-style, liveaboard-capable and a confident offshore passagemaker.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Accommodations

A large, comfortable pilothouse crowns the yacht, delivering true 360-degree viewing through expansive windows, complete with a helm seat, a dedicated navigation table, and an opening sun roof that floods the space with light. Below, the galley is thoughtfully positioned down, while the salon invites gatherings around a folding dinette table with generous seating. To starboard, additional seating complements an enclosed head and a hanging locker, ensuring day-cruising ease and overnight practicality. When the temperature dips, a Dickinson LPG stove keeps the interior warm and toasty. Forward, a full galley service supports a private stateroom featuring a vanity, a hanging locker, and an escape hatch for safety and ventilation.

Galley

Purpose-built for cruising, the galley is set down and finished with a stainless steel counter and sink, pressurized hot and cold water, and an on-demand water heater for instant comfort. Daily cooking is effortless with a microwave and a two-burner LPG stove with oven, while a refrigerator preserves provisions with dependable efficiency.

Deck

On deck, safety and control begin with stainless steel bow and stern pulpits and single lifelines, while a manual anchor windlass, an anchor with proper rode, and a forward deck locker complement the forward hatch for secure ground tackle management. The rig features an aluminum mast and mizzen with a furler and a reaching strut, supported by two Lewmar 7 mast winches

and two Lewmar 40 sheet winches, all set off by handsome tanbark sails. Ventilation and weather protection are equally refined, with three solar vents, two 3-inch cowl vents, pilothouse window covers, and a pilothouse sliding sun roof. Practical cruising details abound, including teak cabin-top hand rails, a removable boarding ladder, cockpit cushions, a cockpit folding table, a propane locker, an emergency tiller, and a cockpit manual bilge pump, plus five cockpit lazarettes that swallow gear with ease.

Additional

Thoughtful equipment elevates navigation and comfort: a VHF Icom M324G and a VHF Horizon Eclipse pair with a Richie compass for clear communications and reliable heading, while a pilothouse and salon fan keeps air moving below. Performance data is precise via BG depth, BG speed, and BG wind speed/direction, all working in concert with an autopilot and a Raymarine Flir A Series touch screen chart plotter/radar/fish finder. A manual toilet with a teak grate head enhances durability and hygiene. Rounding out the cruising package are a BBQ, fenders, mooring lines, and new batteries for confident, turn-key departures.
