OVERVIEW

The Hunter Legend 37.5 first appeared in 1993 from the yard of Hunter Marine, and at 37 feet 5 inches (11.4 meters) it occupies the upper reaches of the production cruiser category, offering a generous platform that still retains nimble handling. Conceived with advanced naval architecture and disciplined engineering, this refined sloop was aimed at sailors who wanted a contemporary, well-appointed yacht without compromising on performance. Built to Hunter's exacting standards, the Legend 37.5 rewards confidence at sea with a robust hull and meticulous construction that deliver both reassurance and enjoyment underway. As a performance cruiser, it reset expectations for comfort and ease in its class, becoming a benchmark for modern, user-friendly sailing.

The exterior presents a sleek, purposeful silhouette where clean sightlines and a subtly aerodynamic sheer hint at both efficiency and elegance. The design balances the timeless character of a classic sloop with contemporary sensibilities, reflecting Hunter's philosophy that form should follow function without sacrificing refined aesthetics.

On deck the proportions are immediately apparent: an expansive, well-protected cockpit provides ample room to handle a practical sail plan while inviting leisurely afternoons at anchor. Ergonomic touches ease every maneuver and an integrated swim platform simplifies water access, enhancing the boat's versatility as a family cruiser suited to both recreation and serious sailing.

Below, the interior unfolds with warmth and considered detail, blending practical layouts with understated luxury. The salon is comfortable and stylish, accommodating the full party for relaxed conversation or evening dining, while generous staterooms create peaceful retreats after a day under sail. Laid out as a two-cabin model, the accommodation plan suits a small family or two

couples, and the galley is comprehensively equipped with stove, oven and a capacious refrigerator to make provisioning for coastal passages straightforward. The well-sized head includes a separate shower stall, a prized convenience in a yacht of this size.

Sailing qualities are lively thanks to a purposeful rig and a sound hull form, and when motoring is required a single diesel engine supplies smooth, reliable power. The rigging arrangement—and the deck-stepped mast in particular—keeps systems straightforward and manageable, making the Legend 37.5 especially attractive for short-handed or solo voyaging without compromising on sailing capability.

More than simply a sailboat, the Legend 37.5 encapsulates Hunter's core tenets of efficiency, craftsmanship and comfortable livability. It harmonizes the spirit of a traditional sloop with contemporary amenities, which has preserved its popularity among coastal cruisers since launch. Equally adept on extended shoreline explorations or brisk weekend escapes, the Legend 37.5 impresses with intelligent use of space, an adaptable layout and assured sea manners, offering a sophisticated choice for those seeking luxury and capability afloat.

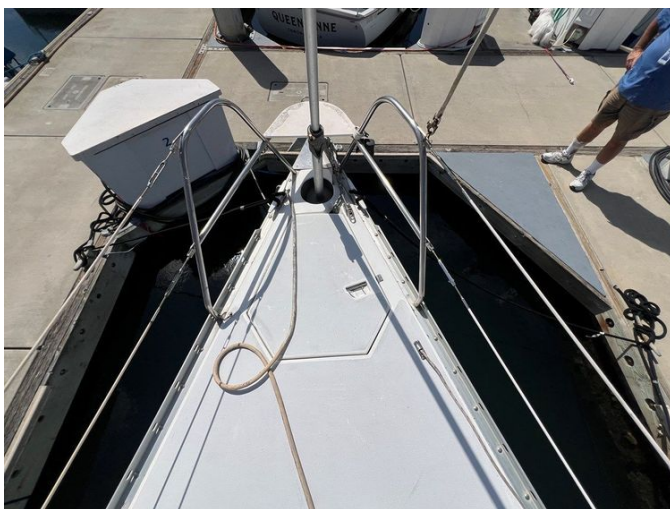
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Description

1993 Hunter Legend 37.5 "VIKTORIA" is a distinguished example of this popular design, combining responsive sailing characteristics with comfortable accommodations and classic styling. Equally capable on coastal passages, weekend getaways or competitive club racing, she delivers assurance and refinement on every voyage. The roomy cockpit opens into an interior arranged with two private staterooms and a convertible dinette, allowing comfortable sleeping for up to seven guests. The galley is configured for extended cruising and is equipped with a large refrigerator and freezer, a three-burner stove and oven, a stainless-steel double sink and ample storage to keep provisions orderly and within reach. Carefully cared for by her owners, "VIKTORIA" features gleaming varnished woodwork, renewed cushions and covers, Garmin electronics, a Fusion stereo system and an overall exceptionally well-presented condition. She preserves the charm of a classic yacht while benefiting from tasteful modern upgrades suited to the contemporary sailor. Features & highlights

Descend into a richly finished interior where warm teak-and-holly joinery surrounds an intelligently arranged layout that balances style with functionality. The forward V-berth sleeps two and offers generous stowage plus a dedicated hanging locker, while an aft master cabin provides a large double berth for private comfort. A convertible dinette enhances the yacht's flexibility, increasing sleeping capacity to accommodate up to seven, and the cabin benefits from three hanging lockers for wardrobe storage as well as

opening ports that bathe the space in natural light and fresh airflow. Daily life aboard is refined by a fully enclosed head with a separate shower area, a marine toilet with holding tank and hot-and-cold pressurized water, and a dedicated navigation station that keeps passage planning organized and precise; new fabric cushions throughout complete the interior with a crisp, inviting finish. The galley is equally well considered for provisioning and gourmet preparation, centered on a stainless steel double sink and a three-burner CNG stove with gimballed oven, complemented by a large refrigerator and freezer and generous counter and storage space that make cooking underway as effortless and enjoyable as at anchor.

Sails, canvas & rigging

Smooth, responsive performance is supplied by a roller furling genoa and a Hood roller furling jib, supported by a fully battened mainsail stowed in a Stack Pack with lazy jacks for immaculate, simple handling. Fine-tuning of the sail plan is achieved through a mainsheet traveler and dedicated boom vang, while sail trim is made effortless by a complement of self-tailing winches, comprising two Bariant 24-45 and two Bariant 21-33 units. The sail wardrobe consists of rugged Dacron main and jib, with two additional spare sails supplied bagged for secure storage.

Electronics

A refined ensemble of onboard electronics elevates every voyage, anchored by Raymarine navigation for precise route planning, a magnetic compass offering an immediate heading reference, a VHF radio ensuring clear, reliable communications, a television for sophisticated entertainment whether at anchor or underway, and a Fusion stereo with speakers that lavishes the interior and decks with rich, immersive sound.

Engine / electrical / mechanical

Propulsion comes from a Yanmar 3JH2E three-cylinder diesel marine engine, listed at 37 horsepower and showing 1,702 hours of use. The unit produces a peak output of 38 horsepower (28.5 kW) at 3,600 RPM and a continuous rating of 35 horsepower (25.7 kW) at 3,400 RPM, offering a refined blend of responsive performance and dependable efficiency. Shore power connections with cords support the vessel's electrical needs, while onboard comfort and independence are enhanced by an Adler Barbour refrigeration system, a hot water tank and a CNG burner stove with oven.

Deck & cockpit

Throughout the vessel the deck and cockpit marry refined comfort with effortless operation, beginning with an anchor mounted on a bow roller and equipped with both chain and line rode for reliable mooring. The cockpit features an elegant table with cushioned seating that invites alfresco entertaining, while a discreet cockpit shower provides an easy way to rinse off after a swim. Forward, the bow pulpit incorporates an integrated seat that serves as a peaceful vantage point, and aft the twin stern rail catbird seats offer elevated views while underway. A walk-through transom fitted with a stainless swim ladder delivers safe, convenient access to the water and the dock, enhancing every moment aboard.

Additional equipment

Alongside her standard inventory, the yacht is supplied with dock lines and fenders to make berthing effortless, comprehensive owner's manuals for immediate reference, a canvas winter cover to protect the vessel during the off-season, and spare sails to ensure you are prepared for changing

conditions.

Specifications

At 37.42 ft overall with a 12.67 ft beam and a maximum draft of 4.67 ft, this yacht artfully blends refined stability with confident performance. The interior layout offers two cabins and one head, while essential tankage comprises a 35 gal fuel tank, a 75 gal fresh water tank and a 20 gal holding tank. Propulsion is provided by a Yanmar 3JH2E inboard diesel showing 1,700 hours, delivering dependable economy for extended cruising. 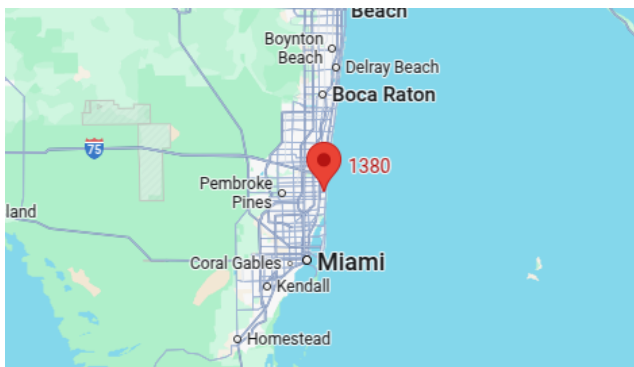
