OVERVIEW

Three-cabin, two-head layout

Designed by Berret-Racoupeau and influenced by the acclaimed Beneteau 473, this 39-foot monohull brings together refined comfort, contemporary style, and reliable seakeeping. Bright and spacious, the Beneteau 393 performs as a true passagemaker while offering the appointments and layout expected of an upscale cruising yacht. Introduction

The 393 answers the call of sailors seeking a genuine offshore cruiser: long-range capability, comfortable systems, and a sail plan that's manageable for short-handed crews. Her hull delivers steady stability while the 5'1" shoal draft allows access to shallower anchorages without sacrificing offshore confidence. The three-cabin, two-head arrangement sleeps up to eight, making her practical for family cruises or friends cruising together.

She is an excellent choice for a cruising couple who want to explore the

Bahamas and Caribbean shallows while keeping the option of longer ocean runs. "Grand Cru" is one of the most comprehensively equipped and well-maintained Beneteau 393s available and offers a turnkey experience for a buyer seeking a modern, comfortable cruiser.

Walkthrough

The more-than-13 ft beam is used intelligently to create airy living spaces with ample storage and headroom. Three double cabins plus a salon dinette conversion provide sleeping for up to eight. The interior craftsmanship is evident in the satin-finished cherry joinery, which complements light upholstery and headliners. Large deck hatches, numerous portlights, and three acrylic skylights brighten the salon. Custom shades and insect screens help control light and airflow, while twin CruiseAir 12,000 BTU systems (aft unit 2023) maintain climate comfort throughout the interior.

Main Salon

Access is through a sliding acrylic hatch and well-contoured companionway steps that aid safe movement when the boat is heeled. The salon is organized around a portside U-shaped settee with outboard shelving and a substantial hardwood table that converts quickly to a double berth. Ample lockers and under-seat storage keep personal items stowed neatly.

Navigation Station

A true forward-facing nav station with a lift-up top provides roomy storage for charts, navigation tools, and essentials. The contoured seat includes stowage beneath for convenience on passage. Breaker panels, battery monitoring, VHF, and stereo are logically arranged with extra shelving and lockers for organization.

Forward Guest Cabin

The forward cabin is filled with natural light from two large overhead hatches fitted with privacy curtains and custom screens. A portside double berth is paired with a settee, brass reading lamps, LED overhead lighting, and a 12V fan. Storage includes a generous hanging locker and custom compartments outboard and beneath the seating.

Forward Head

Efficiently organized, the forward head features an aft-facing toilet, freshwater basin with pullout shower faucet, and a teak grab rail for safety. Storage is provided by a mirrored medicine cabinet and under-sink cabinetry.

Aft Cabins

Two symmetric aft cabins offer comfortable double berths and include opening portlights with custom shades and screens, outboard shelving, a full-height hanging locker, and dedicated ventilation and power outlets.

Aft Head

Located to starboard of the companionway for easy cockpit access, this day head serves both aft cabins and guests. It includes a forward-facing toilet, basin with pullout shower, teak grab rail, and a mirrored forward bulkhead, plus storage above and below the counter.

Galley

The galley to starboard is laid out for efficient meal preparation underway. Twin stainless sinks offer freshwater (with inline filtration) and saltwater taps. Hot water is provided via the 110V heater. Cooking is by a gimbaled Force 10 two burner stove with oven and flame guards, fed from an external propane tank with solenoid. Top-loading 12V Waeco refrigeration serves cold storage. Louvered cabinets and drawers run the length of the counter with practical searails.

Equipped for offshore navigation and coastal passages, the electronics

Hull & Deck

Built in South Carolina for the North American market, the solid fiberglass hull with structural inner grid and glassed in floors creates a stiff, confident hull

form offshore. The balsa cored deck with molded non-skid supports a T-shaped cockpit with a fold-away transom seat and integrated swim platform for easy water access.

The cockpit features teak seats and sole, protected by a roomy dodger and bimini with wraparound enclosure and sun screens. All running lines are led aft to Spinlock clutches and Lewmar winches for efficient sail handling. The leather-wrapped helm with sailpod accommodates navigation instruments, VHF/AIS, stereo remote, and a Plastimo compass. A folding cockpit table with internal storage enhances on-deck dining.

Safety and secure movement are ensured by solidly backed stanchions, double lifelines, a sturdy pushpit, side and transom gates, wide side decks, and full-length jacklines.
