Building on the legacy of her larger sibling, the Oceanis 51.1, this 40-foot cruiser showcases a fresh hull design by Marc Lombard, delivering unmatched deck space and interior volume without sacrificing performance. BENETEAU has pioneered a new era with the Oceanis 40.1's innovative flared hull, featuring steps that extend over a third of the bow, creating a hull with impressive speed potential that remains stable under sail. Above the waterline, her deck layout and exceptionally spacious interior, designed by Nauta Design, are unparalleled for a vessel of this size, making you feel as if you're aboard a 45-foot cruiser.

The interior, styled by the Italian designers at Nauta, is notably bright and excels in the clever arrangement of living areas. She offers two layout options, with a C-shaped galley on the starboard side that provides generous storage and a roomy worktop. On the port side, a large saloon with a table and a removable bench awaits, while a chart table at the base of the companionway offers ample workspace. Everything is modular, allowing everyone to live as they wish and enjoy sailing wherever the wind may lead.

Deck

The deck of this yacht is meticulously crafted to deliver both safety and luxury while navigating the seas. It boasts sturdy stainless steel rails at the bow and stern, enhanced by stainless stanchions and double lifelines, creating a secure setting for everyone on board. To shield against the elements, a dodger spray hood is fitted, along with a bimini top that includes a connector, providing generous shade and protection. The cockpit is adorned with plush cushions,

transforming it into a welcoming area for relaxation. A well-designed cockpit table enhances convenience, ideal for dining under the open sky or enjoying social gatherings. Anchoring is simplified with a Quick electric anchor windlass, coupled with a dependable Delta #45 anchor, chain, and rode, ensuring stability and tranquility when docked.

Sails and rigging

The sails and rigging of this yacht are crafted to offer outstanding performance and effortless handling. The aluminum deck-stepped furling mainsail provides both durability and seamless operation, while the ProFurl roller furling system enhances the ease of sail management. Outfitted with a 120% Genoa sail, complete with a sun cover, the yacht is well-protected against the elements. For those desiring extra speed and adaptability, a white Code Zero furling spinnaker is included, ideal for light wind scenarios. The rigging is further enhanced by Harken #46 ST genoa winches and Harken #40 ST halyard winches, with one halyard winch being electric for effortless control. Additionally, the yacht is equipped with ten SpinLock line clutches, ensuring secure and efficient line management. This well-rounded setup promises a sailing experience that is both thrilling and easily manageable.

Electronics

The yacht's electronics suite is meticulously crafted to elevate navigation and communication, ensuring a smooth and secure sailing journey. Central to the system is the B&G GPS chart plotter, featuring radar capabilities for precise navigation and enhanced situational awareness. The B&G autopilot alleviates the burden of steering, enabling leisurely cruising. To monitor the underwater environment, the B&G depth sounder provides precise readings, while the B&G speed log tracks your speed through the water. The B&G AWI (Apparent

Wind Indicator) delivers vital wind information, essential for optimizing sailing performance. Navigation is further bolstered by two Plastimo 5" compasses, offering reliable directional guidance. Communication is managed by the Standard Horizon VHF, ensuring clear and dependable contact with other vessels and shore stations. This comprehensive electronics package ensures you are fully prepared for any maritime adventure.

Accommodations

The accommodations on this yacht are meticulously crafted to offer both comfort and luxury to everyone on board. It includes three cabins with double berths, featuring a spacious owner's cabin with a centerline queen berth, complete with a private head and shower for enhanced privacy and convenience. Ample storage is thoughtfully integrated throughout, with hanging lockers and drawers to keep personal items neatly organized. The salon, positioned on the port side, provides ample seating and a fixed dining table, creating an inviting area for relaxation and social gatherings. with a freezer, ensuring all provisions remain fresh and ready for use. For quick and easy meal preparation, a microwave oven is also included. The galley boasts double stainless steel sinks, providing ample space for cleaning and food preparation. Hot water is always available, courtesy of the water heater powered by the engine and 110-volt electricity. The pressure water system guarantees a steady and strong flow, making kitchen tasks effortless. This well-equipped galley is designed to make life on board as comfortable and convenient as possible, allowing you to savor every moment of your voyage.

Electrical

The electrical system on this yacht is expertly crafted to guarantee reliable power management and distribution throughout your voyage. It includes both an AC 110-volt electric panel and a DC 12-volt electric panel, offering comprehensive control over the yacht's electrical operations. The Fischer Panda generator, with 405 hours of use, provides consistent power generation, ensuring all systems remain functional. The yacht is fitted with four AGM 12-volt house batteries, an engine start battery, a generator start battery, and two bow thruster batteries, all efficiently managed by a battery selector switch. An inverter charger is also included, facilitating seamless power conversion and charging. Additionally, two 30 amp 50-foot power cords are available, ensuring easy connection to shore power when docked. This robust electrical configuration ensures that all your power needs are met, allowing you to fully enjoy your time on the water.

Additional features

This yacht is equipped with a variety of additional features that boost its versatility and convenience. Among them is a 9-foot RIB with a hard bottom, driven by a dependable Mercury 6hp four-stroke outboard engine, delivering

outstanding performance for trips and easy shore access. Additionally, the yacht benefits from the ability to stay at its current mooring for up to six months, providing flexibility and peace of mind for planning extended stays or leisurely explorations.
