DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

This center cockpit yacht presents a remarkable design with two staterooms and two heads, making it perfect for a cruising couple with occasional guests or a family on a voyage. The layout guarantees privacy and separation, featuring a roomy, luminous, and inviting interior with fine joinery and new LED lighting throughout the cabin. Outfitted with new aluminum opening ports and hatches, the yacht benefits from improved airflow and natural light.

The salon impresses with its ample 6'4" headroom, offering a dinette to port and a straight settee to starboard, both fitted with plush, comfortable cushions. The dining table easily seats four and can accommodate up to six if needed. The aft cabin serves as a secluded haven with a large double berth and its own private head, while the forward cabin boasts a traditional V berth setup with an insert to form a large double. The salon dinette also transforms into a roomy double berth. Storage is plentiful, both beneath and behind the settees.

A dedicated chart table and navigation station are included, and the galley is crafted to delight any culinary enthusiast. It performs excellently both at sea and dockside, being secure, well-ventilated, and bright. The galley features a spacious refrigerator/freezer combo and a new gimballed 3-burner stove, ensuring meal preparation is both easy and safe. Ample storage compartments keep provisions and kitchenware within easy reach, while a large double stainless steel sink with a new faucet and generous counter space is a cook's delight. Passing dishes to the cockpit is made easy through the companionway.

The separate engine room is accessible via large, insulated sliding doors that can be easily removed when needed. An opening hatch provides excellent light

and ventilation, and the engine room's location allows normal activities in other parts of the yacht during engine or mechanical work. The passageway adjacent to the engine room contains the batteries and a 2400W inverter/charger. Continuing aft through the passageway, the aft cabin offers a king-size berth, a highly valued feature. Opening ports, an access hatch, and a companionway to the cockpit ensure comfort in all weather. The separate head includes a shower, and both cabins provide ample storage. Additional LED lighting offers cozy, private reading lights, general illumination, and mood lighting. The varnished teak joinery, paired with white ceiling panels, creates a bright, spacious interior for the family.

Overview

This yacht exemplifies the pinnacle of contemporary engineering and design, offering an extensive range of features that prioritize both luxury and practicality. The galley is outfitted with a new Force 10 stove featuring three burners and an oven, a Seafrust 12v refrigeration system with holding plates in a spacious, well-insulated top-opening fridge, and double deep stainless steel sinks. The generous counter space, along with hot and pressurized water systems, manual foot pumps for fresh and saltwater, and excellent storage in cabinets, lockers, and drawers, makes it a chef's paradise. The galley also benefits from excellent ventilation and headroom.

The plumbing system includes a private ensuite head aft and a guest head forward of the bulkhead. Each head is equipped with sinks featuring mixing faucets, pull-out showers, and sump pumps. The yacht is fitted with an electric aft manual toilet forward with a holding tank and deck pump-out, a shower sump with a 12v sump pump, and a 120-gallon freshwater capacity with a new 6-gallon hot water heater. New diesel and freshwater deck fills provide convenience and efficiency.

Navigation and communication systems are state-of-the-art, featuring a 2018

4G Garmin radar mounted on the mast, an Icom 802 single sideband radio with a Pactor modem, and a Garmin GPS in the cockpit with a 12-inch chart plotter. The yacht is also equipped with VHF Standard Horizon radios at both the navigation station and helm, a depth sounder, a binnacle-mounted compass, a new Garmin autopilot, a new Hydrovane windvane steering system, and a new solid-state weather instrument on the masthead.

The mechanical systems are robust, featuring a Cummins 4B3.3 engine with 65hp, installed in 2007 and boasting low hours. The engine provides a cruising speed of 6.5 knots at 1800 RPMs, reaching a maximum of 8.0 knots at 2400 RPM. Engine mounts were replaced in 2016, along with a new starter. The engine room is equipped with two blowers, a tachometer, warning alarms, a Groco bronze strainer, and a 90-gallon fuel tank with a range of nearly 500 miles at 1800 RPMs. The yacht also features dual Racor 500 fuel filters, a straight direct drive stainless steel shaft, a Max Prop feathering prop, and a new skeg-mounted rudder fitted in 2018.

The electrical systems are extensive, with a 12-volt system powered by six 200 amp batteries and a GEL 1000 amp heavy-duty start battery. A Balmar 120 amp alternator, rebuilt in 2019, ensures efficient engine charging. The yacht is equipped with a newly installed AC/DC breaker panel, LED navigation lights, a Seafrost 12v refrigeration system, LED cabin lights, DC and USB power outlets throughout, three electric bilge pumps, and a pressure water pump. The 110v shore power system includes a shore power connection for 30 amp service, two shore power cords and adapters, a 50 amp to 30 amp shore power adapter, and a Magnum 2400 Watt charger and inverter installed in 2015.

Additional features include a Honda portable generator, a 1000 Watt pole-mounted wind generator, three Siemens 75 watt solar panels, and various deck and safety equipment. The yacht's sails and rigging are equally impressive, with a refurbished aluminum keel-stepped mast, double spreader rig, new chainplates, and a full inventory of sails including a fully battened

mainsail, Yankee cut headsail, and staysail. The winches are serviced regularly, and the hull construction is solid, with a full keel displacement and a hand-laid fiberglass layup.

The deck details are meticulously crafted for safety and convenience, with teak decks removed and replaced with fiberglass and nonskid paint, solid stainless steel fittings, and ample storage. The cockpit is deep and secure, with comfortable seating for eight, a binnacle and wheel steering, and excellent visibility from the helm. Ground tackle includes a Maxwell 1500 electric windlass and a variety of anchors and chains.

The yacht also features a spacious aft cabin with a queen-size bunk, a large navigation station, and well-equipped heads. Other equipment includes bilge pumps, a dinghy, a Yamaha outboard, and a comprehensive set of spare parts and additional items such as Garmin charts, cruising guide books, and fishing gear. The yacht is truly a complete package, ready for any adventure on the high seas.


