OVERVIEW

Namowan, a Bavaria Vision 46 (2015, Owner's Version, EU VAT paid — Malta), offers effortless passagemaking paired with contemporary sailing luxury. Conceived for extended family cruises, bluewater crossings and unhurried coastal retreats, this 46 foot yacht unites assured seagoing capability with refined onboard comfort. The owner's layout is arranged for true liveaboard ease, marrying generous interior volume with tasteful finishes and robust systems engineered to make every voyage intuitive and rewarding.

Propulsion is provided by a Volvo Penta D2 75 Turbo (75 hp / 55 kW) with approximately 1,200 hours, delivering quiet, controlled thrust through a saildrive for precise maneuvering. A fixed bulb keel, twin wheels and carefully balanced appendages yield predictable, confident handling across conditions. The rig is set up for uncomplicated shorthanded sailing: a 51 m² in mast furling mainsail, a 42 m² roller reefing jib and a nearly new 91 m² Code 0 flown from a Seldén bowsprit extend the sail wardrobe and keep the yacht moving with minimal effort. Aluminum spars rise to 21 m, giving a corresponding bridge clearance of 21 m, and all furling and reefing gear is configured for straightforward, reliable operation whether offshore or close to shore.

Lovingly maintained, lightly used and never chartered, Namowan is presented turn key and genuinely ready to cruise. EU VAT is paid (Malta). Recent upgrades enhance comfort and protection: a 2025 bimini, dodger and matching side screens shade the ergonomic cockpit, while the hydraulic cockpit table converts into a sun lounge for languid afternoons at anchor. Teak decks, protected hatches and stainless steel fittings form a cohesive, premium exterior palette, complemented by an integrated anchoring arrangement with electric windlass to make mooring effortless.

Measuring 13.99 m overall with a 4.19 m beam, this premium monohull offers

an airy, light filled interior and expansive deck spaces. The forward owner's suite includes an en suite head, abundant storage and considered night lighting, while two midship cabins welcome family or guests in comfort. The yacht features dual heads fitted with Laguna electric toilets (80 l tanks) and separate showers with overboard pumps to support extended passages. With 190 cm of headroom, generous ventilation and practical stowage solutions, the interior is tailored to prolonged liveaboard life without sacrificing style. The comfortable saloon flows naturally to the cockpit, ensuring easy circulation underway and at anchor; crew and guests enjoy intuitive access to deck systems and the swim platform for safe, fluid movement around the yacht. The galley is well appointed to meet culinary needs: a Bosch three burner gas stove with oven, Bosch microwave and dual access Isotherm refrigeration (top and side) make provisioning and food preparation simple. Built in cabinetry, bookshelves and carefully positioned reading lights underline the quality of finish and reinforce the "home afloat" atmosphere. A Fusion audio system is integrated for salon and cockpit entertainment, and hot and cold water at the transom shower extends comfort to post swim routines.

The deck layout balances secure sail handling with relaxed days on deck. Lewmar electric and manual winches oversee sail management with authority, twin wheel helm stations afford clear sightlines and easy communication with the cockpit, and a wide teak swim platform with boarding ladder invites easy water access. Stern stowage is arranged for a Zodiac inflatable with the option to fit an eSpirit2 electric outboard, keeping launch and retrieval simple and civilized. Safety equipment includes a four person life raft, EPIRB and man overboard gear, providing reassurance for offshore passages and family cruising alike.

Navigation and electronics are comprehensive: a full Garmin suite — GPSMap chartplotter, Doppler radar, autopilot and VHF — is NMEA 2000 compatible and neatly integrated for decisive situational awareness. A Victron 300 W

inverter supplies small AC loads away from shore power, and the electrical and electronic systems are organized for dependable, go anywhere operation. Tanks and capacities support autonomy: 210 l fuel, 510 l freshwater and a 160 l holding tank. CE Category A – Ocean certification, GRP construction, a 2.00 m draft and an 11,200 kg displacement complete a hull and structure engineered for serious cruising.

From sheltered helm to shaded lounge, Namowan projects the quiet confidence of a premium performance cruiser. The cockpit canvas was renewed in 2025 and routine servicing of sails, engine and electronics reflects diligent owner care. Maintained to exacting standards by an owner operator, systems are clean, sailhandling is crisp and the interior remains fresh and contemporary.

In sum, Namowan is at once a luxury sailing yacht, a bluewater cruiser and a performance cruising monohull: an elegant Bavaria Vision 46 that pairs ocean going capability with family friendly ease and modern style. Ready to depart at short notice, she delivers the sought after combination of efficiency, comfort and reliability that discerning sailors demand—transforming each passage into a quietly memorable journey.

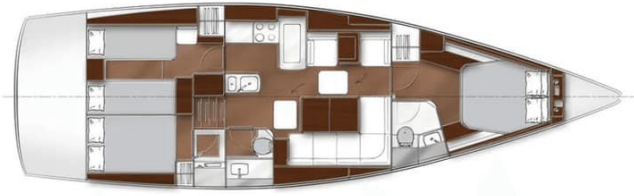
