OVERVIEW

Impeccably appointed and thoughtfully improved, SnAIL'n is a 2010 Hunter Marine 45 Center Cockpit that marries liveaboard luxury with seaworthy engineering and assured handling. This center cockpit monohull—built by Hunter Marine, model 45 Center Cockpit, year 2010, HIN US HUN4C198B910, USCG Documentation #1230542, MMSI 368118860—presents as a refined performance cruiser and capable passagemaker, conceived for the cruising sailor who values comfort without compromising reliability.

Underway she is driven by a dependable Yanmar 4JH4 TE 76 HP diesel (Engine Family RCD 4JH4TX2, Serial E12626) that has logged approximately 1,325 hours since 2019 and is serviced with an X Change R oil change system for both engine and genset. Racor filtration was cleanly relocated to the engine compartment in 2019 to simplify maintenance, while a professionally installed Side Power (Sleipner) SE60/185S bow thruster provides confident close quarters control. Auxiliary power comes from a Fischer Panda 8000NE PMS Digital 8 kW generator with roughly 850 hours; a new raw water pump was fitted in June 2024 and major generator electronics—control boards and panel—were renewed in July 2023, a testament to meticulous upkeep.

The electrical system is modern and self sustaining, centered on Victron intelligence: a 2022 Victron inverter/charger, battery monitor, and SmartSolar charge controller manage a house bank of approximately 600Ah AGM with a dedicated engine start battery. Renewable charging comes from two Panasonic 350W solar panels and a Rutland 1200 wind generator, all integrated for autonomy and efficiency. A Charles Industries ISO G2 3.6 kVA marine isolation transformer provides clean, safe shore power, and Micro Air EasyStart modules on the air conditioning systems allow soft starts at anchor or on limited power, enhancing comfort without demanding excess energy.

Navigation and communications are arranged for offshore confidence and

elegant day sailing: a Garmin 1242xsv chartplotter and a Garmin GMR Fantom 18" radar, both installed in 2021, pair with a Garmin Reactor 40 autopilot added in 2024 for precise course keeping. A Raymarine chartplotter at the nav station complements the suite, while a B&G V60 B VHF with AIS transmit/receive, an AIS GPS500 antenna, and a wireless handheld secure clear communications. A Ritchie FN 201 4.5" Navigator flush mount compass (2026) completes the cockpit's sailor-centric instrumentation.

Below decks the interior is bright and climate controlled by two 16,000 BTU air conditioning units, the forward unit having been replaced in 2020. The galley is outfitted for cruising: a Nova Kool RFS 7501 DC refrigerator, a Coolmatic CB 040 freezer new in 2023, a Panasonic NN-SN67KS microwave, and a propane stove and oven supplied by two tanks, with a Magma rail mounted BBQ on deck for all fresco evenings. Practical comforts include an 11-gallon hot water heater, a transom shower, a Roku 32" television, and three 12V cabin fans that together make extended time aboard comfortable and self-contained.

On deck the center cockpit is transformed into a protected, sociable command center by a full cockpit enclosure and cushions installed in 2021, accompanied by two comfortable cockpit chairs with arms. Hunter's signature "Tower in a Box" arch integrates a sturdy dinghy davit and traveler, while an electric windlass and saltwater washdown simplify anchoring and deck chores. Four winches—one electric—were serviced in 2022, reinforcing a low effort, high enjoyment sailing experience.

The rig and sailplan favor ease without sacrificing performance: a Doyle in-mast furling mainsail is matched with a new 2024 furling genoa for balanced power and fingertip control. Running rigging was renewed in 2019; the deck-stepped aluminum mast with B&R rig is stayed with stainless wire and swaged turnbuckles on stainless chain plates and is supported by a comprehensive set of trim aids—boom vang, sheet stoppers, genoa cars and

tracks with fairleads and blocks, and an arch mounted traveler. Lewmar two speed self tailing winches—one electrically driven—were serviced in 2022, completing a deck layout that invites confident single or short handed sailing.

With polished mechanical systems, renewable energy sources, contemporary electronics, and indulgent comforts integrated into a proven center cockpit platform, SnAIL'n—45' LOA with a friendly 5' draft and a 62' mast height for ICW versatility—stands ready as a luxurious offshore cruiser, coastal companion, or elegant liveaboard, prepared to slip the lines for coastal adventures or ocean passages.


