OVERVIEW

Boutique charter operation in Paros, Cyclades — all 2026 reservations and associated income fully assignable to the purchaser. From October onward, the yacht is available exclusively for private cruising while remaining Greece based.

Launched in 2023, this Bali 4.6 exemplifies contemporary multihull design, marrying expansive interior volume with an open, villa like ambience that elevates Mediterranean island cruising and multigenerational escapes. The Catana Group pedigree is evident in the generous living spaces and the signature Bali open plan concept, which together create a relaxed yet refined floating residence ideal for effortless island hopping or extended stays at anchor.

This particular 2023 example is fitted in a versatile five cabin layout that comfortably accommodates up to ten guests and is fitted with four bathrooms, delivering a considered mix of privacy and communal areas. Propulsion is provided by twin Yanmar 4JH57 diesel engines producing 57 hp apiece, mounted on saildrives for assured maneuverability and efficient coastal passages. The yacht's dimensions — 14.3 m overall length, 7.66 m beam and a 1.27 m draft — reflect the stable, comfortable platform that distinguishes premium flybridge catamarans.

Configured for autonomy, the vessel carries 800 L of fuel (including an auxiliary tank for extended range) and 860 L of freshwater, supported by a low consumption watermaker rated at 105 L/h. An integrated 500 W solar array comprising five 100 W panels contributes to energy independence, while the 12 V / 230 V electrical installation includes a 2000 VA inverter, an 80 A charger/inverter unit, a battery controller and two additional 130 Ah service batteries to ensure reliable onboard power management.

The living areas are designed to maximise light and flow. The luminous saloon

features Bali's forward opening window and direct access to the foredeck lounge, creating a seamless indoor outdoor connection with excellent cross ventilation and natural light that suits warm Aegean climates. Convertible saloon seating adds flexibility, and a forward peak cabin with mattress and blackout curtain provides a discreet bunk for crew or occasional guests. Comfort is enhanced by private ventilation fans in each cabin and soft, indirect LED illumination throughout, set against tasteful grey beige upholstery.

Culinary needs are met with a well appointed galley boasting a four burner glass hob, a large oven with a supplementary gas oven, and a 230 V microwave, while a freshwater purification filter supplies clean drinking water throughout the voyage. Exterior living is equally generous, with a broad aft cockpit for dining and lounging, an inviting forward lounge that forms the social focal point when at anchor, and a fully appointed flybridge with sunbeds and dining table offering panoramic viewpoints underway or at rest.

Deck equipment and guest conveniences have been carefully considered: a 1500 W electric windlass, dedicated dinghy lifting system with electric davits, a hydraulic aft platform that converts the stern into a beach club and tender station, wide swim steps, a teak swim ladder with handrails, and a hot and cold cockpit shower for post swim comfort. Foldable forward sun mattresses, a bimini with integrated LED lighting, luxuriously padded flybridge cushions and a gas plancha grill further enhance the alfresco lifestyle, while a Fusion audio system with six speakers provides high quality entertainment. The sailing rig is arranged for approachable, pleasurable handling, with a fully battened Dacron mainsail, a reinforced Solent with UV protection, a lazy bag with lazy jacks for neat stowage, and a Code 0 on a bowsprit for improved light air performance; two manual headsail winches give tactile control for trimming. Navigation and electronics comprise a comprehensive Raymarine suite including Axiom 7 and Axiom 12 chartplotters, an i70 multifunction

display, AIS transceiver, mast integrated radar, the P70S autopilot and a Ray63 VHF with wireless handset for confident passage making throughout the Cyclades and beyond.

Operated within a boutique charter management programme across the Greek islands and scheduled to be based in Paros from mid June 2026, the yacht represents a rare opportunity to acquire an income producing vessel with an established summer itinerary; all current 2026 bookings and associated revenue are fully transferable to the buyer. The management runs with a professional, mandatory skipper and a carefully curated, limited rotation calendar designed to protect the yacht and preserve guest standards. From October the yacht will be used exclusively for private cruising while remaining Greece based, and private viewings can be arranged during available windows throughout the season.

Presented in turnkey condition with upgraded systems and premium factory options, this Bali 4.6 has been meticulously maintained and is equally suited as a private family cruiser or a charter asset delivering immediate returns. Offered for sale with a full photo and video package available on request, viewings may be scheduled by appointment.

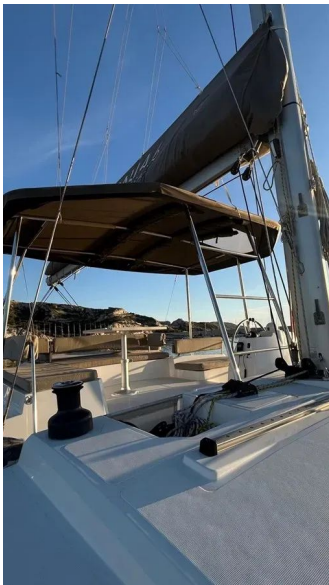

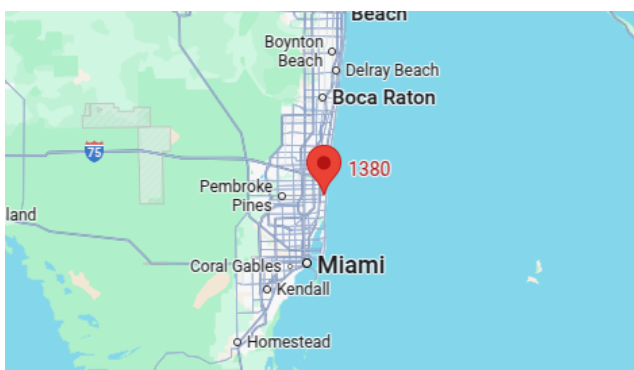
