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OVERVIEW

The 2015 Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 469 is a refined performance cruiser that blends elegant lines with assured sailing manners, conceived by Philippe Briand to deliver both comfortable live aboard accommodation and spirited passage making. Poised for Mediterranean daysails or extended coastal passages alike, she offers modern ergonomics, excellent control from the cockpit, and a seakindly motion that makes settling into life under sail an immediate pleasure.

Offered from private ownership and never entered into charter, this example has been lightly used and conscientiously maintained, presenting in excellent condition throughout. She flies the Malaysia flag with VAT not paid, an appealing detail for buyers seeking flexible import options. Propulsion comes from a reliable Yanmar 4JH5 CE diesel producing 54 HP, supported by a factory installed bow thruster that transforms close quarters handling and marina maneuvers into a calm, confidence inspiring routine.

Her deck layout and sail handling have been arranged for straightforward operation: a fractional sloop rig with furling mainsail and furling genoa keeps sail trim simple, while a large gennaker on its own furler unlocks lively downwind performance in lighter airs. All control lines are run aft to the cockpit, and a lazy bag with lazy jacks makes mainsail stowage neat and efficient, enabling short-handed crews to manage the boat with ease.

Measuring 14.05 m overall with a generous 4.49 m beam, the Sun Odyssey 469 balances interior volume and sailing performance. The performance deep keel with a 2.24 m draft and an optimized GRP hull form provide stiffness and directional stability, producing a smooth, predictable ride. Displacing approximately 10,809 kg, she feels substantial yet responsive under sail, and dual helm stations afford excellent visibility and control whether racing along or easing into an anchorage. Teak on the cockpit sole and side decks enhances

the yacht's premium presence while offering secure footing when moving fore and aft.

Accommodation is fashioned for extended cruising and family use, sleeping up to ten guests across three cabins with two heads fitted with electric toilets. Twin aft cabins to port and starboard provide privacy and convenience, while the forward cabin benefits from the wide beam to create a bright, airy owner's space. The saloon and linear galley are designed for living aboard, with a sociable dining area and practical provisioning capacity, supported by a refrigerator, oven, hot water system and abundant storage. An onboard entertainment suite including TV, Wi-Fi and DVD adds to the comfort and conviviality of life at anchor.

The cockpit functions as an outdoor living room, centered on a convivial table and cushioned seating ideal for alfresco dining or relaxed afternoons between swims. A hot and cold cockpit shower and a transom integrated swim ladder provide easy water access, while a stern controlled anchor system keeps mooring operations within reach of the helm. The well protected cockpit geometry enhances comfort in a range of conditions, from lively sailing days to languid anchorages.

A comprehensive electrical and energy setup underpins independent cruising, with a solar panel array to supplement battery charging and reduce reliance on shore power or a generator. An inverter, battery charger and complete domestic electrics support onboard amenities, and air conditioning combined with well placed ventilation keeps living spaces comfortable in warm climates. Safety features include both electric and manual bilge pumps, ample handholds, safety lines and full navigation lighting for secure operation day and night.

Navigation and communications are well covered by an integrated electronics suite that serves coastal passages and beyond, placing essential information where it's needed. Instruments include compass, depth sounder, log/speed

instrument and wind instruments, while a GPS chartplotter, AIS and radar extend situational awareness. VHF radio and a dedicated navigation station complete the package for confident trip planning and watchkeeping.

Built by Jeanneau in 2015 with a GRP hull, this Sun Odyssey 469 displays the fine build quality and thoughtful detailing expected from the yard, with teak finishes and wide, uncluttered side decks contributing to both safety and aesthetic appeal. The fractional rig geometry and all furling sail inventory — mainsail, genoa and gennaker on a furler — allow the yacht to transition effortlessly between lively performance sailing and relaxed family cruising. Privately owned, regularly serviced, and free from accidents or structural incidents, she represents a turnkey opportunity for discerning buyers searching for an elegant, seakindly cruiser ready for immediate use. 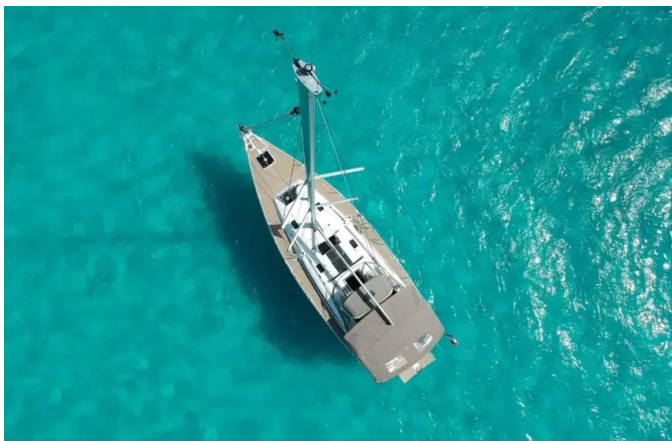

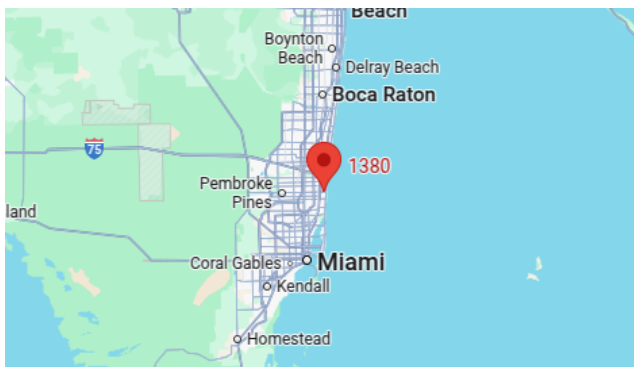
