Accommodations

The galley is positioned along the starboard hull from the companionway to the aft bulkhead in a practical L-shaped arrangement, offering ample workspace and storage. Corian countertops surround a top-loading freezer, a front-opening refrigerator and a Force 10 oven set into the hull side, with overhead lockers and a microwave within easy reach. A door in the aft bulkhead provides direct access to the starboard cockpit locker for extra stowage.

Aft to port, the secondary cabin features a generous double berth and wardrobe, entered via the port aft bulkhead door. Forward of that space is the aft/day head, accessible from both the cabin and the salon. Just forward, a forward-facing navigation station sits opposite the dinette with a comfortable, ergonomic seat and storage underneath.

The salon offers a roomy U-shaped dinette to starboard with a centerline bench (additional storage beneath) and a two-person settee to port. The dining table drops to form an additional double berth and includes a removable leaf for flexible dining layouts.

The owner's stateroom forward is offset slightly to port for improved flow and cabin feel. Built-in lockers line both sides and there is storage under the island-style queen berth, which is accessible from either side at the foot. Three opening hatches bring light and ventilation. The en-suite head to starboard includes a separate shower stall.





