## OVERVIEW

---

The 2013 Beneteau Oceanis 50 presented here is the desirable two-cabin, two-head Owner's Version, a graceful bluewater cruiser conceived for long passages and comfortable liveaboard life. Professionally maintained by a career yachtsman, her generous interior, thoughtful deck plan and polished systems speak to a level of care well above the ordinary, making her an appealing offshore sailing yacht for couples or small families who prize space, seaworthiness and easy handling.

Configured for self-reliant passagemaking, she carries a substantial energy suite: a 640 W solar array (4 × 160 W) governed by a 60 A charge controller, complemented by 800 W of wind generation provided by two 400 W Silent Breeze turbines, and an 800 Ah AGM house bank (4 × 200 Ah) installed new in 2022. System oversight is simplified with a Victron battery monitor with Bluetooth, and communications for offshore work are supported by an Iridium GO antenna mounted on the bespoke Atlantic arch, which also integrates dinghy davits for the included tender and outboard.

Her spars and sails have been modernized for simple, shorthanded sailing: a new Selden mast with in-mast furling and all-new standing rigging fitted in 2023, a Doyle mainsail for in-mast furling and a Doyle 130% genoa from 2022, plus a mast-mounted spinnaker pole, a Doyle asymmetrical spinnaker with sock and a spare 100% genoa. Most running rigging was renewed in 2023, and the deck hardware—Harken winches including electric winch options—and an in-mast furling system keep sail handling straightforward.

Navigation and electronics are contemporary and capable: Raymarine Doppler radar installed in 2023, a Raymarine 12" Axiom HybridTouch chartplotter with i70s instruments and p70 autopilot control head fitted in 2022, and Raymarine AIS from 2019, all integrated for confident offshore routing and situational awareness. The cockpit arrangement features twin helms aft for excellent

sightlines and fine steering control, while a bow thruster eases close-quarters maneuvering and an expansive social cockpit with an expanding table invites alfresco meals and entertaining.

Comfort and independence are emphasized throughout: a high-output 20 GPH watermaker provides true bluewater autonomy, air conditioning and a dependable Cummins Onan 7.5 kVA generator with 409 hours support onboard systems, and a new 10.5 ft Mercury dinghy with a 9.9 hp 4-stroke outboard (2023) rides on the arch davits. New navy cockpit cushions with white piping were added in December 2024, and safety enhancements include Dyneema lifelines renewed in 2023.

The structural pedigree is proven: a solid fiberglass hull with structural inner liner and a deck built in a glass/balsa sandwich for strength and weight savings underpin her ocean-going capability. Propulsion is a Yanmar 75 hp diesel with service access beneath the companionway, showing 1,971 hours and paired with a new Yanmar saildrive installed in 2022. Recent maintenance readies her for immediate cruising: engine and generator serviced in August 2025, and new bottom paint and hull polish completed August 2025. Ground tackle is robust—a Rocna 73 lb primary anchor with 300' of 3/8" chain and wireless windlass remote, backed up by a Bruce anchor—complemented by practical deck layout and uncluttered walkways.

Below, the interior is warm, bright and arranged for liveaboard comfort. The forward owner's suite offers a centerline double berth, abundant storage including a full hanging locker, a vanity with mirror, two opening ports and two overhead hatches, and a private en-suite forward head with separate shower, electric marine toilet, Corian-counter vanity and an opening hatch. The main salon features a U-shaped dinette to port with a varnished table with inlay and aluminum legs that converts to an additional berth, a two-person bench with folding armrest to starboard, four decorative throw cushions, generous storage along hull sides and under seating, two opening ports, two elongated

hull windows, an additional port each side and three overhead hatches—an ideal arrangement for cruising life.

The gourmet, U-shaped galley to port is appointed with Corian countertops, a stainless steel sink, a three-burner stove with oven, 12V refrigeration including a front-opening refrigerator and a top-loading freezer, abundant drawers and cabinetry and an opening port for ventilation. A dedicated starboard chart table houses the electrical panel and integrated electronics, providing a practical navigation station for offshore routing. Aft, the master cabin contains a lateral queen berth with hanging and gear locker storage and its own head that doubles as a day head, fitted with an electric marine toilet, Corian-counter vanity with sink and mirror.

Additional noteworthy features include the custom Atlantic arch with integrated dinghy davits, the redesigned arch that carries the tender and outboard, and a deck plan geared to shorthanded sailing with Harken winches and ergonomics that favor ease and safety. The vessel is currently cruising the turquoise waters of Barbados and is presented ready for her next adventure; upon closing the owner can arrange delivery to the Southeast U.S. or Gulf Coast and provide a focused 1–2 day handover and systems orientation.

The vessel name “HYDRO THERAPY” does not convey—the seller reserves the right to retain and continue using the name. Exterior photographs are current; select interior images are representative with updated interior photos to be provided. Included with the sale is the Mercury 10.5 ft tender.
