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OVERVIEW

A rarely available 2025 Bavaria C50, lightly used and retained exclusively as a private-owner yacht, presents an exceptional opportunity for refined Mediterranean cruising and extended stays aboard. Meticulously equipped for comfort and autonomy, she combines contemporary sailing performance with a generous inventory that includes both bow and stern thrusters for effortless close-quarters control, powerful electric winches for simplified sail handling, a 1000W solar array paired to a 2500W inverter for extended off-grid capability, and a thoughtfully configured exterior living area designed for both relaxation at anchor and elegant passages under sail.

Located in Lesvos, Greece and presently berthed at Midilli Setur Marina, this almost-new performance cruiser has accumulated approximately 350 engine hours and has never been offered for charter. Specified to support single- or short-handed operation, the layout and systems of this C50 emphasize ease, safety and responsive performance—attributes that have established the model as one of the most respected monohulls in her category. The inclusion of bow and stern thrusters transforms tight marina manoeuvres into precise, calm routines while electric winches reduce physical strain and maintain crisp sail trim. The upgraded electrical architecture and solar capacity lengthen time away from shore power, allowing serene exploration of secluded bays and quiet anchorages.

The navigation and electronics package is comprehensive and logically arranged to support confident passage-making: GPS, AIS, autopilot, compass, wind instruments, depth sounder, speedometer, VHF radio and a dedicated MOB system are all fitted and positioned for clear visibility and intuitive use. Safety systems are robust and thoughtfully specified, with fire extinguishers, an automatic fire suppression system, a gas detector, bilge pump, MOB equipment and VHF connectivity contributing to a secure cruising platform

suited to owners who prize reassurance and capability.

On deck the Bavaria C50 delivers an exceptionally social and versatile environment. Expansive teak-laid cockpit surfaces and a flexible seating plan invite long days at sea or leisurely evenings at anchor, with two electrically operated cockpit tables that raise for dining and lower to create extensive sun-lounging areas. Factory sunbathing cushions and dedicated stern relaxation pads enhance onboard comfort while a bimini and sprayhood provide adaptable shelter. Audio is catered for by cockpit speakers integrated with the onboard entertainment system, and the electric bathing platform opens directly to the water, complemented by a swim ladder, freshwater deck shower and a gangway for seamless transfers between boat and shore. Practical tender arrangements include a 2.70m aluminium-hull dinghy, an electric outboard and a davit system engineered for straightforward launching and retrieval, and reliable ground tackle completes the deck fit-out.

The interior continues the theme of effortless cruising, presenting a clean, modern aesthetic and practical arrangements for life aboard. The galley is fully equipped with a stove, oven, sink, refrigerator, freezer, extractor hood and a dependable hot water system to support serious provisioning and onboard meal preparation. Accommodation comprises three guest cabins and three heads, each fitted with electric toilets and generous amenities, providing comfortable and private quarters for family and guests. The salon is appointed for both relaxation and entertainment, anchored by a 50-inch Smart TV and supported by radio, MP3, iPod connectivity and Bluetooth for flexible onboard enjoyment. Altogether the interior delivers a premium private-owner atmosphere where design and functionality are in balance.

From a naval architecture and mechanical perspective the fundamentals are exactly what experienced sailors expect from a purpose-built cruiser. Constructed by Bavaria Yachts and flying the British flag, this hull measures 15.43m overall with a 5.00m beam and a 2.30m draft, offering significant

interior volume, form stability and a reassuring offshore presence. The fiberglass hull and a displacement of 15,490 kg underpin composed seakeeping and a solid feel at anchor. Propulsion is provided by a Yanmar 4JH80 diesel engine with approximately 350 hours of use, rated at 80 horsepower for comfortable cruising speeds around 7 knots and a top speed approaching 10; a fuel capacity of 250 supports practical motoring range while the combined thruster and electric winch package simplifies mooring and sail handling.

Electrical and systems installations are arranged to support autonomous cruising and easy marina life: shore power connection, a substantial battery bank with dedicated charger, a 2500W inverter and the 1000W solar array offer flexible power management for extended stays away from shore supplies. Navigation and instrumentation are carefully integrated to create an effective cockpit command centre suitable for coastal hops and offshore legs alike, with clear data presentation and ergonomics designed to suit both seasoned skippers and those stepping up to a larger cruising yacht.

Privately owned since new, never chartered and lightly used, this Bavaria C50 is presented ready for Mediterranean seasons with a specification focused on comfort, autonomy and ease of handling. Offered now with a full photo and video package available on request, she represents a refined, modern luxury sailing yacht for discerning buyers seeking a blend of performance, safety and upscale living afloat.

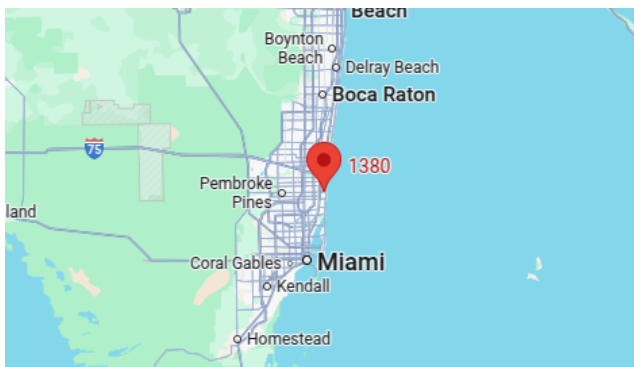
