DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Calypso is the convergence of exceptional freshwater provenance, obsessive upkeep, and a genuinely rare opportunity: a Gozzard 44 that unmistakably stands apart. There are mass-produced cruising yachts, and then there are Gozzards—vessels whose handcrafted integrity, enduring strength, and commanding presence lift them into a much higher class.

Conceived by the celebrated Canadian designer Ted Gozzard and built in Ontario, the Gozzard 44 has long been regarded as one of the finest semi-custom bluewater cruisers produced in North America. Each hull was individually built with uncompromising attention to detail, producing yachts whose quality, structural robustness, and timeless aesthetic remain benchmarks decades on.

Calypso presents an unusually rare chance to acquire one of these sought-after yachts in exemplary condition. For sixteen years she has been a Great Lakes vessel—seasonally sailed, professionally stored ashore, and maintained to exacting standards. Remarkably, Gozzard Yachts themselves provided ongoing care throughout that entire period, a continuity of factory stewardship rarely seen in brokerage listings. Her current owners bought her directly from the Gozzard facility on Lake Huron and commissioned Gozzard Yachts to refurbish and ready her for Caribbean cruising; an unexpected medical issue prevented the intended voyage, creating an opportunity for the next custodians.

Aboard, the quality of long-term, preventative maintenance is evident everywhere: a beautifully finished cherry interior, an immaculate engine room, and beautifully preserved joinery, cabinetry, and deck hardware. Calypso is among the earliest Gozzard 44s to incorporate Corecell in her hand-laid

fiberglass layup, married to a long-keel hull with a protected rudder, cutter rig, generous tankage, and a seakindly motion offshore—attributes that have earned this design a reputation as a serious and comfortable passagemaker. Equally admired are the warm, handcrafted interior, the thoughtful cockpit layout, and the liveaboard comforts that make extended cruising a pleasure. Because she has spent her adult life in freshwater rather than years in tropical salt, Calypso's systems and finishes retain a level of preservation rarely found in yachts of this vintage. Whether your ambition is the Great Loop, long coastal passages, Caribbean island-hopping, or true offshore adventure, this Gozzard 44 delivers the confidence born of exceptional design, meticulous maintenance, and careful ownership. This is more than another brokerage listing; it is an opportunity to own one of the finest examples of a storied semi-custom cruising yacht. If you have been waiting for the right Gozzard, Calypso may be the one.

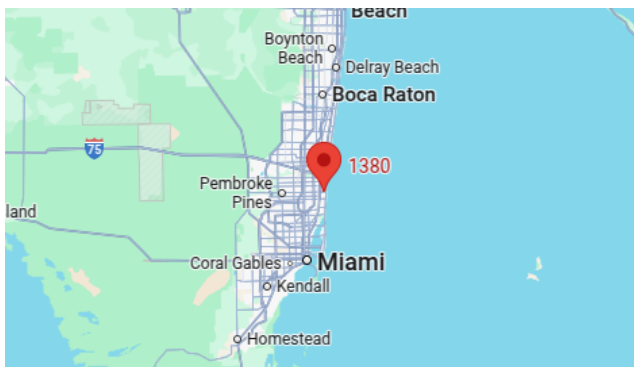
