OVERVIEW

C SISTERS stands as an exquisite sailing catamaran where generous interior volume, polished comfort, and genuine adaptability converge into an elegant modern multihull sanctuary. Laid out with a bold open-plan philosophy, she is equally at home with discerning private owners or as a premium crewed charter platform, delivering an artful synthesis of style and practicality for long-distance bluewater cruising.

A luminous, panoramic saloon framed by sweeping glazed panels flows seamlessly into a well-conceived galley and a dining arrangement that seats twelve, while Bali's signature fold-up "garage door" blurs the line between inside and out by joining the salon to the forward cockpit and producing a single, dramatic living expanse with uninterrupted vistas. Above, the flybridge catamaran deck forms the social heart of the yacht: the helm, alfresco dining and broad sun loungers create an inviting arena for entertaining under sail or unwinding at anchor, with a true 360-degree flybridge encouraging relaxed conviviality.

Sleeping accommodations host up to ten guests across four queen suites and one twin cabin, each appointed with a private ensuite and a separate shower to evoke a boutique-hotel standard, while two dedicated crew cabins preserve guest privacy and ensure professional service. With a shallow 1.48 m draft, C SISTERS slips into secluded anchorages and island harbors with ease, perfectly suited to warm-water cruising and exploration. An award-winning design celebrated for comfort and reliability, she offers buyers generous space, refined finishes, and proven seagoing performance in a contemporary charter catamaran.

Her operational credentials are equally compelling: a strong charter history includes six confirmed bookings for 2026 totaling over \$360,000 in revenue. A solid foredeck leads directly to the saloon for effortless circulation across the

main deck, and the Bali OpenSpace concept heightens the sense of connection to sea and sky. A large hydraulic aft platform serves as both tender lift and watersports stage and is complemented by a convenient gangway for easy boarding. Three distinct dining venues—on the flybridge, in the saloon, and forward—provide exceptional flexibility for guests throughout the day, and U.S. Duty paid status adds further appeal to this outstanding multihull that blends the ease of a private villa with the capability of a world-class cruising yacht.

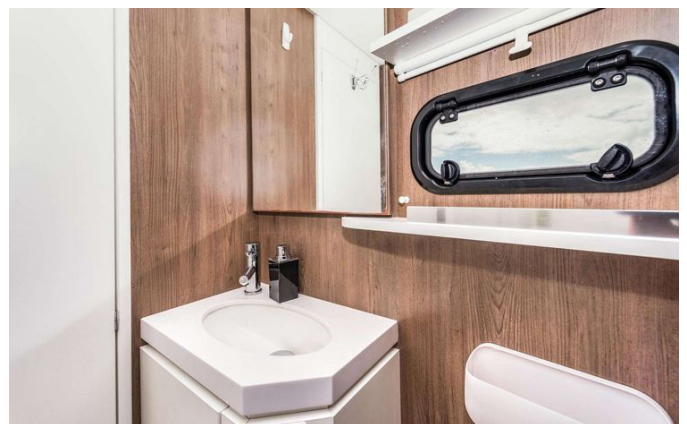

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Construction

Crafted with a robust GRP hull and superstructure, this yacht delivers the reassuring strength, rigidity, and weight efficiency that underpin smooth passages, quiet comfort, and enduring reliability at sea.

Dimensions

Thoughtfully proportioned for performance and comfort, the yacht measures 55.12 feet (16.80 meters) in length overall with a generous molded beam of 28.67 feet (8.74 meters). A shallow loaded draft of 4.86 feet (1.48 meters) opens up pristine anchorages, while a mast height of 81.50 feet (24.84 meters) from the design waterline ensures confident sailing characteristics. The fractional sloop rig balances power and control, with a total sail area of 614 sqft (187m²) comprising a mainsail of 367 sqft (112m²) and a genoa/jib of 246 sqft (75m²) for versatile trim and poised performance.

Capacities

Designed for extended cruising, the yacht carries 317 US gallons (1,200 liters) of fuel and 317 US gallons (1,200 liters) of fresh water, supporting self-sufficiency and long-range comfort. A displacement of 5,856.00 lbs underpins a composed motion, while a sail area to displacement ratio of 27.54 speaks to spirited yet manageable performance. Under power, she reaches a maximum of 10.0 knots and settles into an efficient 8.0-knot cruising speed.

Machinery

Power is delivered by two Yanmar 4JH80 diesel engines rated at 80 hp each with saildrive propulsion, combining quiet efficiency with easy maneuvering. Electrical autonomy is enhanced by a 24 kW system anchored by one 24 kW Honda generator (upgraded option), three 280 AH lithium batteries, and eight 100 W solar panels. Climate control comes via a fully air-conditioned interior with heating and a 230v/60 Hz converter (upgraded option) for versatile shore-power compatibility. For onboard water independence, the Aquabase Aruba Comfort 115/1/60v watermaker delivers 2.4 kW of power and produces 240 l/hr, complemented by a fresh-water system with a purifying filter. Bilge water filtration is supported by four units, electric and manual, for robust redundancy.

Communication, navigation & entertainment systems

Seamless connectivity is assured with SATcom via Starlink and a Ray MIC positioned at the steering station for clear VHF communication. Confident navigation comes from a suite that includes a P70S autopilot, echo sounder, Raymarine GPS, a Raymarine Axiom 7" GPS plotter, and integrated wind and speed instrumentation. Onboard ambiance is enriched by a quality sound system feeding both interior and flybridge speakers for effortless entertainment underway or at anchor.

Galley equipment

The galley is purpose-built for gourmet cruising with a reliable gas oven and stove, a large double-door refrigerator/freezer, and an additional 12v mini fridge on the flybridge to keep refreshments close at hand. A fitted dishwasher

streamlines clean-up, ensuring the culinary experience is as effortless as it is enjoyable.

Tender

A 3.9 m Highfield RIB-style tender powered by 60 hp stands ready for swift, dry, and reliable shore transfers, exploration, and watersports support.

Sailing & deck equipment

Set up for easy, confident sailing, the inventory includes a Dacron full-batten mainsail and solent with lazy bag and lazy jacks, all set on an aluminum mast. Ground tackle is handled by an electric 1700 W windlass, while the aft platform incorporates a hydraulic dinghy lift for seamless tender handling. Electric winches for the solent and mainsail simplify trimming and keep the yacht responsive under all conditions.

Accommodations

Designed for privacy and luxury, accommodations comfortably sleep up to ten guests in four queen staterooms and one twin stateroom, each with a private ensuite head and a separate shower. Crew accommodations for two are thoughtfully placed in two dedicated cabins, ensuring hospitality remains discreet and efficient at all times.

Comments

C SISTERS is a standout luxury cruising catamaran that marries exceptional space, comfort, and versatility—truly a house on the water. An innovative open-plan layout makes her equally compelling for private ownership and charter, with a sunlit salon framed by wraparound windows that flows into a

galley and dining area for up to twelve guests. A signature folding “garage door” unites the interior with the forward cockpit to create a dramatic indoor-outdoor living space, while the flybridge becomes a social hub with the helm, al fresco dining, and generous sun lounging for effortless gatherings underway or at anchor. Sleeping arrangements accommodate up to ten guests in four queen staterooms and one twin stateroom, each with a private ensuite and separate shower, plus crew quarters for two in two dedicated cabins. Thanks to a shallow 1.48-meter draft, C SISTERS slips gracefully into secluded coves and island anchorages. An award-winning model designed for warm-weather cruising, she represents an outstanding opportunity for buyers seeking space, style, and proven performance in a modern catamaran. Notably, she offers a proven charter history with six bookings already secured for 2026 totaling over \$360,000 in revenue, a panoramic 360° flybridge conceived for relaxation and entertaining, a generous solid foredeck with direct saloon access, and the signature Bali OpenSpace saloon featuring the iconic “garage door” that opens the entire main deck to sweeping views. An expansive hydraulic aft platform with a tender lift and gangway access streamlines waterside living, while three distinct dining areas deliver remarkable versatility for guests. U.S. Duty paid further underscores her turn-key appeal.

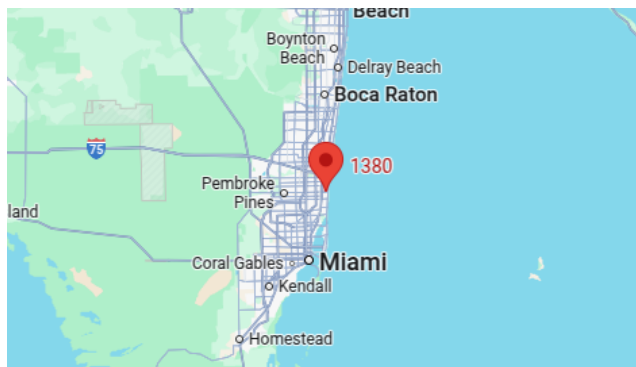
