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OVERVIEW

A 2023 55 foot bluewater catamaran of unmistakable poise, this multihull artfully combines spirited performance with refined comfort. The sweeping 29 foot beam provides exceptional stability and unusually generous living volumes, while an advanced fiberglass composite hull—shaped by Marc Van Peteghem—cuts through a variety of sea states with composed, confident motion.

Twin Nanni diesel engines deliver a comfortable 10 knot cruising speed and can be coaxed to roughly 12 knots when the itinerary demands a quicker passage, ensuring passages are efficient, relaxed, and dependable. The deck layout, from an expansive aft cockpit to broad forward lounging areas, is conceived for lingering sunsets, alfresco dining, and that open air lifestyle synonymous with premium sailing yachts.

Inside, Nauta Design has created a luminous, elegant interior where high quality finishes and clear, modern lines enhance every hour aboard. Wide panoramic glazing floods the salon with light and connects the social center seamlessly to the airy aft terrace, reinforcing the relationship between interior comfort and the surrounding seascape.

Accommodation is arranged to welcome up to eight guests across four well proportioned staterooms, each served by one of four thoughtfully finished heads to maximize privacy and convenience. Generous tankage—ample water capacity and fuel reserves—supports extended autonomy and ambitious cruising plans, marrying practical range with luxurious liveability.

United States based and offered turnkey, this yacht will appeal to discriminating sailors who insist on elegance without concession. Equally suited to a coastal weekend escape or an extended offshore passage, she unites celebrated design pedigree, meticulous craftsmanship, and inviting

living spaces to turn every voyage into a quiet celebration of the sea.

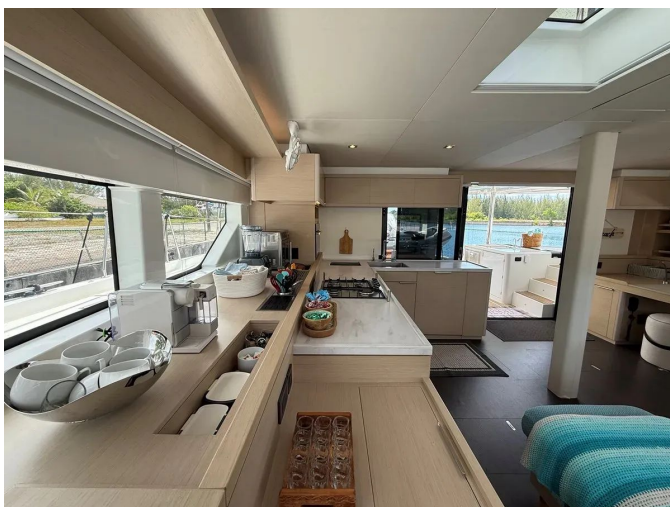

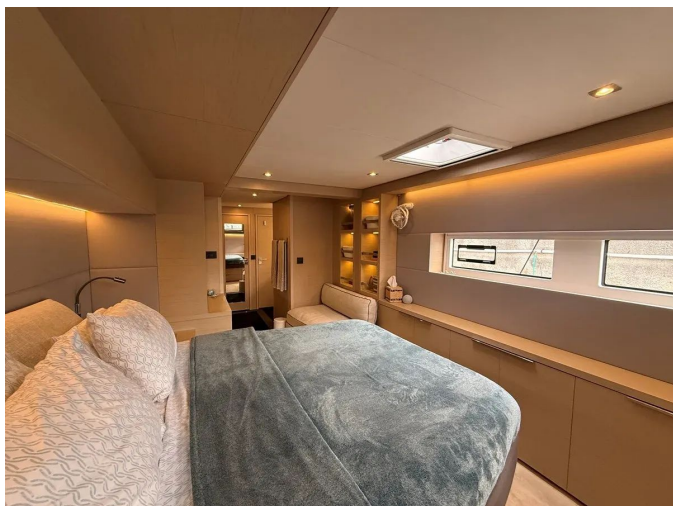
















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

A true blue water sailing catamaran

LLC owned and duties paid, this one-owner, never-chartered Lagoon 55 has been meticulously maintained and is ready to embark on her next ocean passage. Specified as the desirable four-cabin, galley-up owner's layout, she marries refined onboard living with the seaworthiness required for serious blue-water cruising, offering an exceptional opportunity for those seeking a Lagoon 55 that combines luxury and long-range capability. The vessel features a bespoke stern solar tower outfitted with six Maxeon 470 watt glass panels and an additional 920 watts of flexible panels mounted on the flybridge roof, yielding a combined 3,740 watts of solar charging capacity. Lighting and ambiance are fully controllable with eight Lumitec Caprera 3 color changing fixtures, each independently operated over Wi-Fi via a Paco controller from your smartphone. Electrical autonomy is further reinforced by two 5,000 watt inverters wired in parallel to produce 10,000 watts at 230 volts plus 3,000 watts at 110 volts. Tailored enclosures for the flybridge and aft cockpit zip away into discrete housings when not required, and Flexiteek® decking flows across the forward cockpit, aft cockpit, companionway steps and flybridge for a cohesive, low-maintenance finish. Domestic comfort is enhanced with a dedicated 40 liter water heater serving the two port cabins while the starboard owner's suite is serviced by a 60 liter inverter powered water heater, and a redundant freshwater pump system with intuitive control valves allows instant switching should the primary system fail. In addition to the factory 110 volt outlets, four additional convenience 110 volt receptacles have been thoughtfully positioned to simplify appliance use, and a seven step Tracy folding boarding ladder with mounts on both port and starboard ensures safe access in varied dock conditions.

Purposefully outfitted for extended voyaging rather than routine marina reliance, the yacht's 230 volt appliances run from the house battery bank, replenished by the solar array, engines or generator. Key systems including the dishwasher, microwave/convection oven, starboard water heater, watermaker, washer, dryer and the gangway refrigerator are inverter fed so living off grid is exceptionally comfortable. When solar generation falls short, an 18 kW generator restores battery capacity through two Dolphin 100 amp chargers, and underway charging is assured by a 100 amp alternator driven charger. A comprehensive inventory of spare parts and essential components is carried aboard, and all linens, cookware and required U.S. Coast Guard safety gear accompany the yacht, making her genuinely ready for long distance passages from day one.

Her sail plan delivers impressive sail area for performance and versatility, comprising a Square Top Mainsail of approximately 109 m² (1,173 sq ft), a self tacking jib of about 69 m² (742 sq ft), and a gennaker near 154 m² (1,657 sq ft). The Lagoon 55 Premium Package elevates onboard life with an electrically adjustable wooden table in the main salon that rises for formal dining and lowers for casual coffee table use, complemented by three dining tables capable of seating eight across the main salon, other salons and the flybridge. The interior is finished in Alpine white oak with UV varnish as part of the Lagoon Elegance Line, and the same Alpine white oak tones continue through all four cabins. Electrical provisions include American 110 volt outlets at 60 Hz, an electrical circuit 330 Y with CSA shore power compatibility, in addition to 230 Y outlets and multiple USB sockets. Ambient comfort is provided by indirect, dimmable LED lighting throughout with rafter ends on every window for a refined appearance, and cold storage is ample with three refrigerators and two freezers. Audio is handled by a Fusion Apple M5 RA 770 paired with three M5 SRX 400 speakers, enabling synchronized music across four zones or independent selections in each area. Practical systems include a dock wash pump with a sea/fresh water selector for forward and aft areas and

electric freshwater toilets in every cabin, while autonomy is extended by a Legend Blue Water desalination system producing approximately 75 gallons per hour, plus a full size washer and a separate dryer.

Navigation and communications are comprehensive and modern, centering on Raymarine Axiom 16 Pro and Axiom 10 displays with i70 and P70 instruments, an ACU 400 autopilot, speed/log/depth and wind transducers, Ray 90 VHF, and an AIS 700 transceiver, all augmented by a Quantum 3 Doppler radar. Comfort and finish are enhanced with upgraded Sirocco II fans in every cabin, fitted carpeting in the four cabins and salon dining area, interior Grand Comfort Nature upholstery from the Lagoon 70 collection, and upgraded Crevin upholstery on all exterior cushions. Deck operations are simplified with three Lewmar electric winches, an electric halyard and electric furling for a UV protected red gennaker; two white LED lights beneath the transom assist dinghy loading at night while four blue underwater LED spotlights add dramatic evening illumination. Additional refinements include a pulpit bench on the port terrace, a black carbon steering wheel, a custom black mat and canvas covers for the helm, wheel and upper windows. Alfresco living is provided by a gas plancha with compact dining furniture, a hydraulic swim platform aft, and a forward cockpit sun awning with carbon seating. Access to the flybridge is convenient via two staircases, propulsion is managed with four blade folding propellers and bow thrusters, and onboard entertainment includes a retractable 43 inch Vista TV in the main salon operated by remote. The yacht arrives fully outfitted with all galley appliances, tableware and linens, plus complete USCG equipment.

The tender outfit is equally well conceived: a Highfield Sport 420 with white tower and a 70 hp Yamaha outboard stows on the hydraulic platform. Standard tender construction features include ORCA Hydraulics or PVC tube options with welded seams (PVC), flush mount valves, a high tensile chromated and powder coated aluminium hull, a self draining deck, an integrated rear seat with cushion, a low profile console, integrated harness

supports, lifting points and steering eyes, tow bridge points, a brushed foam teak finish deck, heavy duty rubbing strake, a full length keel guard and an electrical pack for boat and console. A selection of optional extras is available including a carbon dash, boat cover, Mantus anchor, tow post, roll bar, Fusion stereo, VHF radio, Garmin 7 inch chartplotter and a black bimini cover.

Offered ready to sail with everything required from day one, this Lagoon 55 represents a turnkey platform for those intent on serious passagemaking in comfort and style.

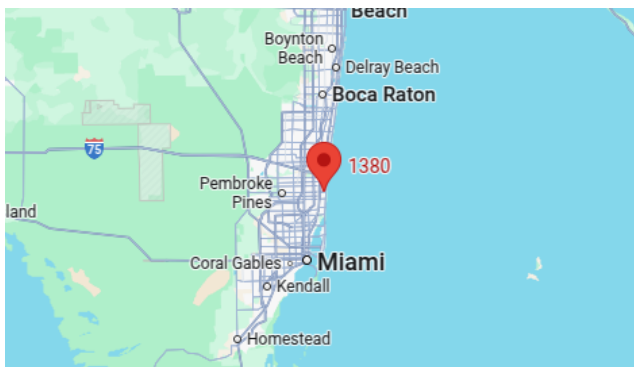
