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OVERVIEW

A rare fusion of timeless seamanship and composed power, this 1978, 57 ft motorsailer offers an elegant introduction to refined sail yachting while resting in Turkey. Built as an authentic wooden yacht with gleaming wood decks that age with character, she marries the romance of canvas with the confidence of engine-driven passagemaking. Her generous 15 ft beam confers a secure, stable platform and an exceptionally roomy interior, while a 6.365 ft draft makes accessing sheltered coves and historic Mediterranean harbors comfortably achievable. Under sail and power the interplay of canvas and a single Ford powerplant gives her the versatile, measured performance sailors prize in a motorsailer—steady, unhurried, and quietly capable.

Below decks the feel is intimately maritime, defined by exquisite timber joinery and the soft rhythm that only wooden construction provides. The layout prioritizes practical seagoing proportions, presenting comfortable accommodation for extended voyages and plentiful storage for provisions and equipment. Fuel and water capacity have been arranged for independence at sea, with approximately 528.34 gallons of fuel and 330.22 gallons of fresh water supporting long passages and relaxed anchoring intervals. Whether slipping between island anchorages or settling into a tranquil evening mooring, she carries herself with the refined grace associated with the finest motorsailers.

For the discerning owner who prizes authenticity, aesthetic refinement, and genuine capability in equal measure, this 57-footer awaits her next chapter. Grounded in tradition yet ready for new horizons, she is an evocative presence among wooden motorsailers, equally suited to intimate family cruising or carefully curated adventures along Turkey's storied coastline and across the wider Mediterranean.

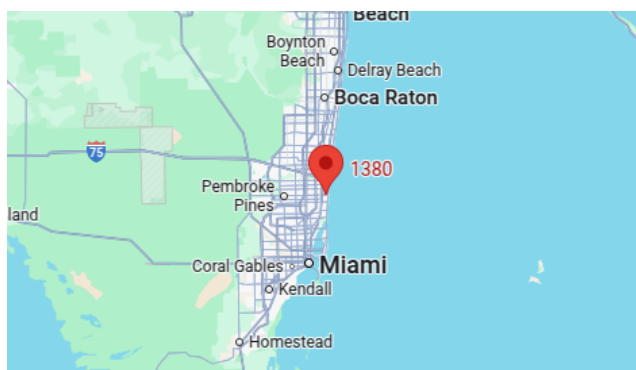
