OVERVIEW

This exquisite Lagoon 55 from the 2026 model year, presented new in a four-cabin, four-head layout and powered by twin Yanmar 110 hp engines, arrives comprehensively specified and ready to sail. Supplied with the Pack Essential, Pack Comfort and Pack Éléance Line, the yacht's navigation and safety suite is complete with Raymarine electronics, Quantum 2 radar, AIS, a reversing camera and a bow thruster, while sail inventory includes a Hydranet square-top mainsail, Hydranet genoa, Code 0 XRP and electric furlers and winches for effortless handling. Exterior spaces have been meticulously executed, featuring a fully appointed aft cockpit, a forward lounge with plush seating and sunshade, a hydraulic Tenderlift platform, a floating passerelle, a gas plancha, blue underwater lights, elegant iroko joinery and a full flybridge equipped with a bar, refrigerator, sunbeds, a wooden dining table and a composite bimini. Interior comforts match the yacht's premium specification with air conditioning in all four cabins, a Mase 15.5 kVA generator, a 5 kVA inverter, a 280 L/h watermaker, dishwasher, washing machine, tumble dryer, freezer, grill microwave, a Fusion RA770 audio system with Bowers & Wilkins speakers, a 43-inch TV in the owner's suite and Starlink connectivity. This superbly equipped, refined catamaran represents a rare opportunity — impeccably appointed and immediately available — ideal for an owner looking for a premium yacht program or for extended bluewater cruising aboard a prestigious sailing vessel.

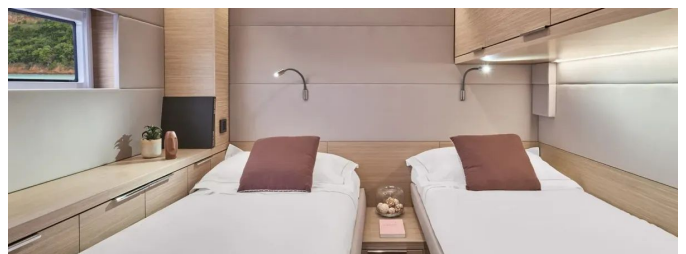

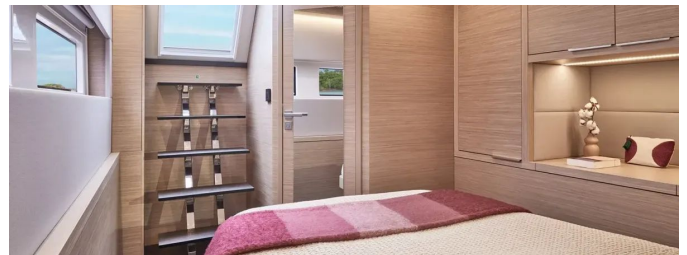
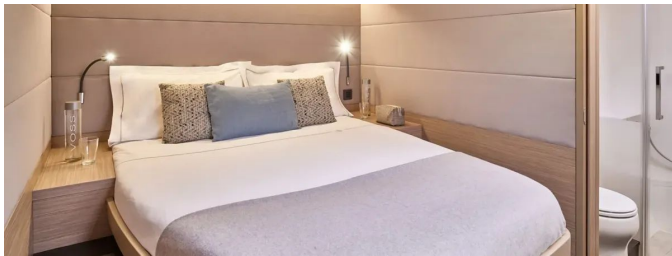

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Options

Presented as a brand-new Lagoon 55 with an overall length of 16.56 meters, this yacht is arranged with four cabins and four heads and is propelled by twin Yanmar 110 CV engines. The interior is refined with UV-treated sand oak joinery set over Fortezza flooring, and the fit-out is enhanced by the Essential + Comfort and Elegance Line option packages. Navigation and onboard electronics are comprehensive, centered on a full Raymarine suite that includes a Quantum 2 radar, an aft camera, AIS and autopilot. The sail inventory features a square-top mainsail and a Hydranet jib, supported by a Code 0 XRP on an electric furler and electric furling for the self-tacking jib; every winch aboard is electric and precise maneuvering is assisted by a bow thruster. A hydraulic Tenderlift aft platform simplifies launching and recovering the tender, while durable iroko decking covers the cockpits, swim platforms, side decks and flybridge, the latter appointed with a bar, refrigerator, generous sunpads, a wooden table and a composite bimini for al fresco living. Long-range self-sufficiency is provided by a Mase 15.5 kVA generator, a 5 kVA inverter, air conditioning serving all four cabins and a 280 L/h watermaker, with domestic appliances including a dishwasher, washing machine, dryer, freezer and microwave grill. Entertainment is delivered to a high standard via a Fusion RA770 system driving Bowers & Wilkins speakers and a 43-inch TV in the owner's cabin, while connectivity is assured with Starlink supplied and installed. The package is rounded out with a Highfield CL 420 tender powered by a 60 CV engine, an offshore safety pack for eight people and a Ready to Sail configuration.

Lagoon 55 – new – four-cabin configuration – highly optioned

This new Lagoon 55 has been specified to an exceptionally high standard for discerning owners who demand comfort, autonomy and refined onboard living for extended passages. At 16.56 metres overall and arranged with four double cabins each with their own en-suite, twin Yanmar 110 hp engines, a fully equipped flybridge and a comprehensive options package, she delivers a rare synthesis of performance, self-sufficiency and understated elegance.

The interior exudes a contemporary warmth thanks to UV sand oak joinery, Fortezza flooring and Nature upholstery, while the Elegance Line pack raises the level of finish throughout. Natural light floods the saloon, accentuated by sliding forward glazing and saloon bay curtains, and the living area is appointed with a modular wood dining table on an electric pedestal, a saloon carpet and carefully positioned indirect lighting that extends into the cabins to create a soft, welcoming ambience.

Accommodation is arranged for four double cabins with four heads, with fitted forward peaks offering single berths, heads and toilets for additional flexibility. The owner's suite is designed for privacy and convenience with a sliding door separating the head from the sleeping area. Each cabin benefits from fitted carpeting, dedicated ventilation and heads equipped with freshwater electric toilets and bidets, reinforcing the yacht's premium fit-out.

Underway the navigation and electronics package is extensive and centred on Raymarine systems: an Axiom Pro 16-inch display at the helm, autopilot and gyrocompass, log-depth and wind instrumentation, VHF Ray90 and AIS transceiver, plus a wireless handset at the helm. i70s multifunction displays are installed at both the helm and chart table alongside a 12-inch Raymarine screen at the chart table, with additional safety and convenience from Raymarine Quantum 2 radar, a Raymarine CAM 220 aft camera, a Raymarine

Smart Control autopilot remote and a Yacht Management System for comprehensive vessel monitoring.

The sail plan has been specified to simplify handling while optimising performance: a white aluminium mast with white aluminium canoe boom, a Code 0 rig with electric furler, an electric furling self-tacking jib, all-electric winches, a Flatwinder system, a square-top mainsail with Hydranet jib and an additional Code 0 XRP. This setup produces efficient, controllable sail power and makes short-handed sailing significantly more manageable.

Deck and cockpit spaces have been lavishly equipped. The aft cockpit features two folding wood tables with protective covers, aft cockpit cushions, two director's chairs and iroko decking across cockpits, transoms and side decks, plus a fold-down seat on the starboard transom, a hydraulic Tenderlift platform, a folding floating gangway with cover, a gas plancha on the transom, LED stern spots and blue underwater lights. Forward, the cockpit is furnished with cushions, serving trays and retractable port and starboard seats, and a carbon pole supported shade awning creates an inviting open air lounge whether at anchor or cruising along the coast.

The flybridge is conceived as a prime living area, with an additional starboard access, a bar unit fitted with sink and a 24V 70L refrigerator, an aft bench with sunpad and a forward sunpad on the coachroof, plus a folding wood table with cover and iroko decking. A composite bimini with windows, integrated lighting and thermal curtains provides protection and flexibility, making the flybridge an ideal platform for summer cruising and onboard entertaining.

Systems for autonomy and comfort have been carefully selected: a Mase 15.5 kVA generator, a 5 kVA inverter, an additional battery charger and extra gel service batteries, air conditioning fitted for the four cabin version, a 280 L/h watermaker and a water purifier. The electrical installation comprises a 230V AC circuit with a 63A shore inlet, a reinforced service battery bank managed by a battery controller and a Navicolor monitoring display for system oversight.

Galley and domestic equipment are comprehensive, supporting long-range cruising in comfort: a 24V 90L freezer in the saloon, a dishwasher for fourteen place settings, a microwave oven with grill, a 9 kg washing machine, a 7 kg tumble dryer, an aft cockpit refrigerator, a flybridge refrigerator and generous galley storage with full accessory fit-out.

The specification is completed by a Highfield CL 420 tender powered by a 60 hp engine, an offshore safety pack for eight persons +6M – 24H, Starlink supplied and installed, a Ready to Sail optimization pack, handling of administrative formalities, name lettering and launching including mast stepping and antifouling.

This rare, highly-optioned new Lagoon 55 — four cabins and four heads, twin 110 hp Yanmar engines, bow thruster, hydraulic Tenderlift, generator, air conditioning, watermaker, full Raymarine suite, Code 0 rig, a fully equipped flybridge with composite bimini, Starlink, Highfield 420 tender with 60 hp and an extensive list of comfort and safety features — is a turnkey owner's yacht, ready to cruise and immediately available to those seeking a modern, elegant and self-sufficient catamaran.

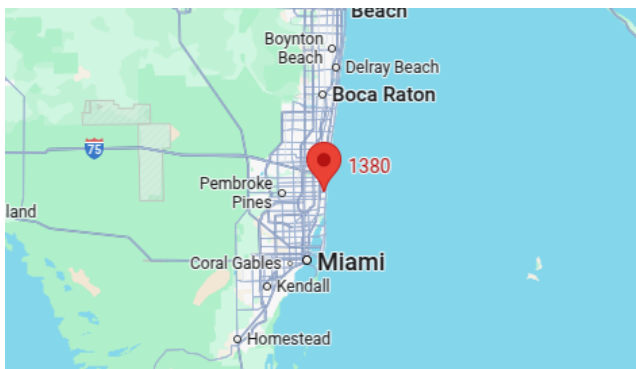
