OVERVIEW

Mission is a privately kept 2006 Sunreef 60 sailing catamaran, certified to MCA Category A. Powered by twin Yanmar diesels with generator, watermaker, bow thruster, and a comprehensive sail wardrobe (main and headsail renewed in 2022), this luxury multihull is configured for bluewater, long range cruising. Her layout provides four double ensuite cabins for eight guests, plus two crew forepeak berths. An open concept salon and galley flow to the sheltered aft cockpit, and the yacht is fully air conditioned. The galley is fitted with a fridge/freezer, oven, microwave, and coffee machine. A refined cruising catamaran and capable sailing yacht, she is equally suited to premium charter, family passagemaking, or elegant liveaboard life.





DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Mission Sunreef 60

Mission is a privately owned 2006 Sunreef 60 sailing catamaran, MCA Category A, crafted as a luxury multihull for confident ocean passages. She is a true bluewater cruiser and performance cruising yacht, powered by twin SINCRO SK160CA1 diesel engines (factory installed) and supported by a 13.2 kVA generator showing six hundred thirty-four hours. A bow thruster, shore power with inverter, and a high-capacity watermaker delivering three hundred liters per hour underline her liveaboard and charter yacht readiness. The full sail inventory inspires easy passagemaking, with the mainsail and headsail renewed in twenty twenty-two for reliable, efficient sailing.

Accommodation is designed for comfort and privacy: four double cabins with ensuite facilities welcome eight guests, and two crew forepeaks add practical flexibility. The open-plan saloon and galley flow directly to the aft cockpit, with air conditioning throughout enhancing life on board. The galley is appointed for extended cruising, featuring a two hundred twenty-one liter fridge/freezer, a cooker hood extractor fan, an electric oven paired with a four-ring gas hob, plus a microwave and coffee machine—everything needed for relaxed family cruising or premium charter service on a flybridge catamaran.

Navigation and electronics deliver confident control and clear situational awareness. A Raymarine E80 chart plotter anchors the helm, complemented by a Sailor 7224 VHF DSC with a Navtec NCR receiver. Two Raymarine tri-data readers integrate GPS, fishfinder, and chartplotter functions, while a Raymarine ST60 resides on the flybridge. A portable VHF and an NHR 1500 MF/HF radio expand communication options offshore, and the autopilot, including flybridge control, makes long legs efficient and less demanding.

On deck, the teak-laid aft deck sets a warm, upscale tone. Swim ladders on

both transoms simplify water access, bow pulpits with teak seats invite lingering at anchor, and a Highfield tender with a twenty horsepower Honda outboard extends your range to shore. A composite passerelle, bimini, and protective covers for cockpit, terrace, and flybridge keep the yacht versatile in all seasons, while sun pads, plush cockpit cushions, and a proper dining table elevate everyday moments. An electric anchor windlass with chain and spares completes a trustworthy anchoring package.

Safety and inventory are comprehensive for offshore sailing yacht standards: nine fire extinguishers are distributed throughout, two six-person liferafts are aboard (service due), and fifteen lifejackets provide peace of mind. Remote and manual windlass controls, along with an extensive mooring kit of fenders and warps, simplify harbor routines. For buyers seeking a refined cruising catamaran that blends luxury yacht comfort with bluewater capability, Mission stands ready for your next chapter—family adventures, discerning charter, or a serene life on board.
