Exceptional ocean going aluminium sailing catamaran Squalt Marine CK64 "Adventure", 2019.

A graceful 19.60 m LOA multihull, she offers four principal cabins plus two additional berths and four bathrooms, blending generous liveaboard comfort with purposeful bluewater capability. Twin 140 hp diesel engines and a 20 kVA generator provide reliable power ashore and at sea, while a 25 m<sup>2</sup> solar array, a 240 L/h watermaker and a dedicated diving compressor sustain extended, self-sufficient passages; a 600 kg hydraulic tender lift completes the rugged, seagoing fit out. Meticulously prepared for global cruising and transocean voyages, she is equally at home on long expeditions or comfortable world cruising.

# DETAILED DESCRIPTION

---

## Full description

---

A superb sixty four foot blue water aluminium catamaran of exceptional value, the CK 64 Adventure was built in 2019 by Squalt Marine, a legendary French aluminium catamaran yard with over thirty years of exclusive expertise, and was purpose designed as a serious offshore passagemaker offering genuine liveaboard comfort; Category A offshore certified, she presents as a powerful, self sufficient platform for ocean voyaging. Her hull and structure are executed in marine grade aluminium Sealium 5083, MIG welded inside and out with continuously welded watertight bulkheads to deliver remarkable rigidity and safety, while eight centimetres of sprayed polyurethane foam throughout the vessel provide thermal and acoustic insulation for quiet, comfortable passages in all climates, producing a structural integrity and longevity simply unmatched by any GRP catamaran at this price point. On deck a large protected aft cockpit with a natural teak sole flows seamlessly from the saloon and is appointed with a generous cockpit table and a full bimini for all weather protection, while the flybridge helm station offers a twin helm seat, a Raymarine Axiom fifteen chartplotter and remote engine and windlass controls for effortless manoeuvring; a hydraulic tenderlift rated to six hundred kilograms descends below the waterline for easy dinghy launch and recovery and is complemented by davits for flexible tender handling, and a diving compressor on the flybridge feeds a dedicated tank filling station neatly integrated into the transom to invite exploration beneath the surface wherever you roam. Inside, a bright panoramic saloon with 2.20 m headroom welcomes family and guests, comfortably seating eight to ten around the dining table with wide sliding doors that open directly to the cockpit to create a single social space, and the professional U shaped galley is fully equipped for serious

cruising with a three burner professional gas cooker and oven, a large American style Haier fridge/freezer with 456 L and 229 L capacities, an ice maker, dishwasher, deep double stainless steel sink, stone worktop and an efficient extractor to keep the space fresh. Accommodation is crafted for privacy and comfort on long passages with four grand comfort guest cabins each featuring a 150 × 200 cm double bed, a private ensuite with a separate plexiglass shower, an electric WC, LED lighting and a hull porthole for natural light, while two additional forward crew cabins each with their own head are accessed via deck hatches to keep operations discreet and the guest areas serene. Underway twin 140 hp Scam/Kubota diesel engines drive direct shaft transmissions with Ercem Maucour shaft seals and three blade folding Maxprop propellers for efficient performance under power, and fuel is abundant with two tanks of 2,400 L each for a total of 4,800 L yielding true transatlantic range; the engines show approximately 1,600 hours, reflecting careful, purposeful use. Her onboard systems are configured for robust autonomy with a 240 L/h watermaker running on 400 V supported by a Scam/Kubota twenty kVA generator delivering 400 V three phase power, a service battery bank combining gel and lithium at 24 V / 960 Ah topped up by twenty five square metres of solar panels that provide full energy independence at anchor, Webasto chilled water air conditioning serving all cabins and the saloon paired with an efficient diesel boiler for high latitude comfort, Victron chargers rated at 100 A and 60 A and a Studer inverter supplying 5,000 W of clean AC power, while domestic convenience is elevated by a 400 V washer/dryer and dishwasher. Navigation and communications are anchored by a full Raymarine suite including two Axiom twelve chartplotters, an Axiom fifteen GPS unit, Quantum Q24D radar, AIS700, a DSC VHF Ray 90, autopilot, depth sounder, compass, mast repeaters and fully electronic engine controls for precise fingertip handling. The sailing package is equally seamanlike with an aluminium Maréchal Z2302 mast and canoe boom Z1602, Elvtrom sails comprising a full batten mainsail, a genoa with UV strip on an

electric Profurl furler 850 W/24 V and a gennaker for light air performance, a tidy lazy bag to streamline handling and Andersen winches delivering power and precision across the lines; steering authority is delivered by a carbon wheel helm with an emergency tiller close at hand. For adventures off the mothership a Hypocampe 4.60 m semi rigid RIB with helm console and a Honda thirty hp four stroke outboard stands ready, while the integrated diving compressor and tank charging station broaden the horizons of every anchorage. Safety and certification meet serious blue water standards with Category A offshore rating, a watertight bulkhead separating the engine room from accommodation and a collision bulkhead between crew and guest cabins, and equipment that includes a full flare kit, gas alarm, eighteen lifejackets, EPIRB, horseshoe buoys and 316 stainless steel guardrails for secure movement on deck. Currently lying in Le Marin, Martinique, offers are welcome and a trade in is possible, making this aluminium CK 64 Adventure an outstanding opportunity for those ready to go far.
