OVERVIEW

A refined combination of timeless lines and purposeful engineering, this 65-foot aluminum sailing yacht—conceived by Andre Hoek with interiors by Ruth Lockley—presents itself as a graceful, ocean-capable cruiser for owners who prize strength, poise, and subtle luxury. Built in the Netherlands in 2002 and maintained in excellent condition, her monohull silhouette is slender and efficient, stretching 65 feet overall with a beam configured to preserve an easily driven, performance-oriented profile. Constructed of aluminum for exceptional rigidity and offshore safety, hull and deck promise long-term integrity with minimal upkeep, while a near 10-foot draft provides sure-footed stability and rewarding upwind performance when seas are demanding.

Under sail she feels balanced and responsive; under power a single Yanmar diesel provides quiet, dependable thrust, carrying her at an effortless cruise of around 10 knots and allowing a top speed near 12 knots—ideal for slipping between anchorages with composure. Systems are laid out with practicality in mind for shorthanded passages or a full watch: power management, generous storage and considered access are all arranged to simplify life at sea and make sustained voyaging straightforward.

Inside, Ruth Lockley's interior treatment emphasizes warmth, light and harmonious proportion. The salon welcomes with clean joinery, abundant natural light and seating configured for both conviviality and passage-making comfort. A well-equipped galley supports extended cruising, while ample stowage and thoughtful ergonomics make daily routines onboard smooth and pleasurable. Accommodation is arranged to sleep up to six guests in tranquil privacy, complemented by two well-appointed heads, and a dedicated crew cabin with two berths provides comfortable quarters for crew or additional family members, permitting either private family cruising or lightly crewed voyages as preferred.

On deck the purposeful arrangement encourages easy movement and safe handling: wide aluminum side decks, intelligently positioned deck hardware and robust fittings attest to a yacht built for real miles—secure under challenging weather yet refined enough for relaxed coastal daysail. The cockpit functions as both command station and social space: sheltered, ergonomically planned and ready for long watches or evening gatherings.

Offered in the Netherlands, this yacht embodies Hoek design purity, aluminum strength and a welcoming Lockley interior—an inspired choice for connoisseurs of classic-modern style seeking confident, effortless bluewater cruising where every mile affirms good taste.
